## AN ACT

To reorganize and promote the efficiency of the Medical Department of the Army.

- 1 Section 1. The Congress of the Confederate States of
- 2 America do enact, That the rank, pay and allowances of
- 3 a brigadier-general in the Army of the Confederate
- 4 States be, and the same are hereby, conferred on the
- 5 surgeon-general of the same.
- 1 Sec. 2. Be it further enacted, That there shall be ap-
- 2 pointed in the Provisional Army of the Confederate
- 3 States two assistant surgeons-general, with the rank, pay
- 4 and allowances of colonels of cavalry; one medical in-
- 5 spector-general with the rank, pay and allowances of a
- 6 colonel of cavalry, and such number of medical inspec-
- 7 tors, not exceeding twelve, with the rank, pay and allow-
- 8 ances of lieutenant-colonels of cavalry.
- 1 SEC. 3. Be it further enacted, That there may be

- 2 assigned to each army in the field or military depart-
- 3 ment one surgeon as medical director, who, for the time
- 4 so occupied, shall be entitled to the rank, pay and allow-
- 5 ances of a lieutenant-colonel of cavalry; that there may
- 6 be assigned to each division one surgeon as division-sur-
- 7 geon, and to each brigade one surgeon as brigade-sur-
- 8 geon and two assistant surgeons for staff or other duty.
- 1 Sec. 4. Be it further enacted, That to each regiment
- 2 of cavalry or infantry, there shall be assigned one surgeon
- 3 with the rank of major, and two assistant surgeons, each
- 4 with the rank of captain.
- 1 Sec. 5. Be it further enacted, That there shall be en-
- 2 listed and mustered into service an infirmary corps of
- 3 able-bodied men, to be composed of fifty men to each
- 4 brigade of an army in the field, and said infirmary corps
- 5 shall be organized into companies of fifty and officered
- 6 with one first lieutenant and one second lieutenant, two
- 7 sergeants and two corporals, and paid in like manner as
- 8 commissioned officers, non-commissioned officers and sol-
- 9 diers of the Confederate service.
- 1 Sec. 6. The appointment of a medical officer of the
- 2 regular army to any office created by this act shall not
- 3 affect his rank in the regular army.
