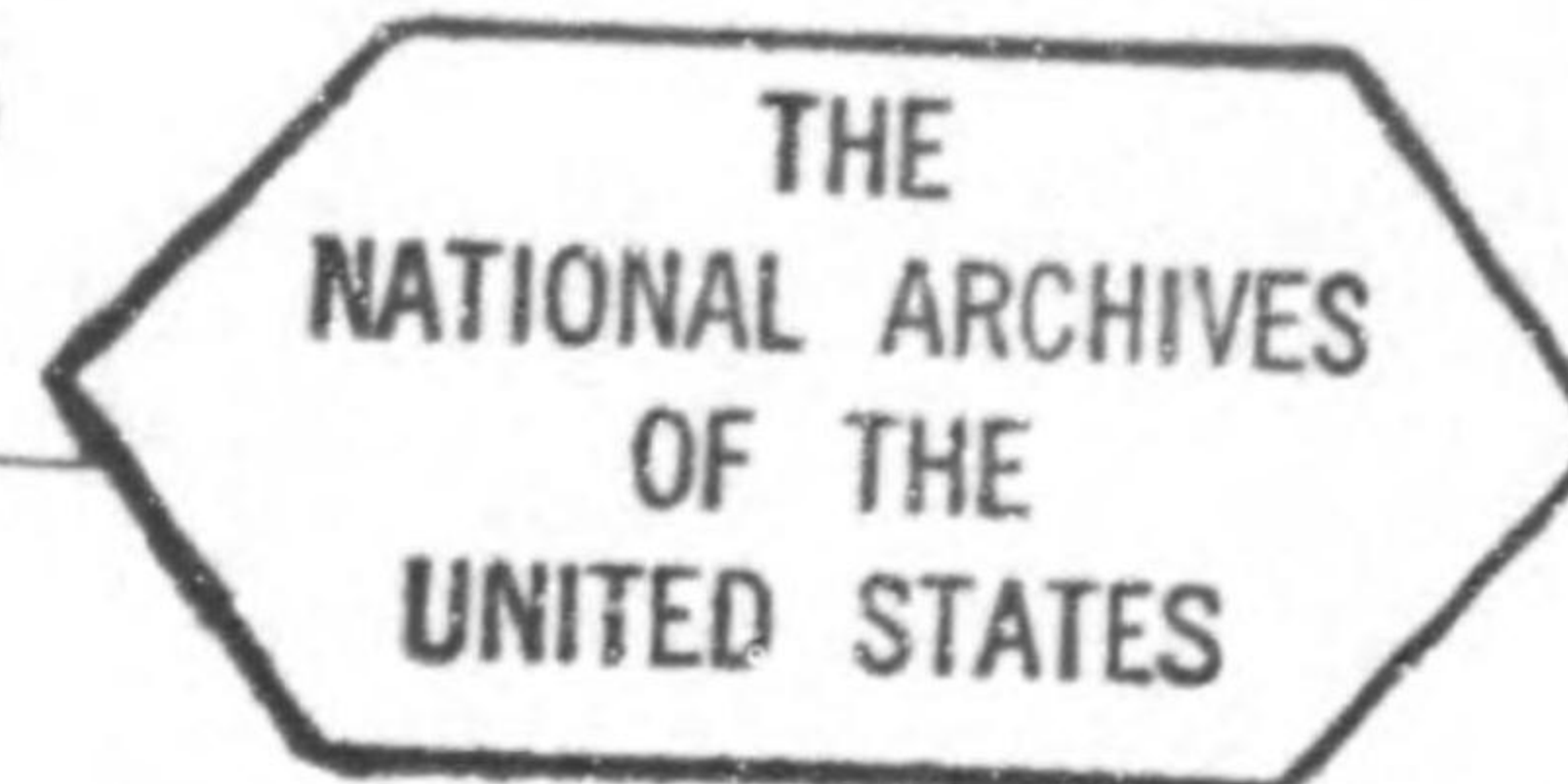

1. Inclosed communication evidently refers to the two Tokyo University students sentenced on 13 June 1951 by a Provost Court to six months at hard labor for engaging in anti-Occupation propaganda during the Tokyo gubernatorial campaign last April. Sentence was suspended and they were released in the custody of their mothers pending final action by the reviewing authority. They had served two months while awaiting trial. A third student charged with the same offense was acquitted.

2. The initials IUS stand for International Union of Students. In May 1950 this same organization sent to CIA&E Section, GHQ a similar message claiming 3.6 million students in 60 countries and protesting against Professor Eels' "fascist interference" in Japanese universities. CIA&E Section in a note dated 29 May 1950 to DC/S referred to an article by Vic Reinemer in the Saturday Evening Post of 11 February 1950 on the Second World Youth Student Federation held in Budapest in 1949 under the joint auspices of IUS and World Federation of Democratic Unions in which the assembly was described as Communist dominated. According to CIA&E the IUS has a branch in the United States with a program of cultural exchange and administering assistance to needy students. It once worked in relation to the World Student Relief Federation which collects funds for needy students but friction was reported between the two on account of a "leftist tinge" in the IUS and their present relationship is not known.

3. The previous protest message from IUS was ignored. Recommend the same be done with the inclosed.
