
# FOREWORD

Though the Midwest is not clearly definable, there is a general common character to the region lying between the Mississippi River and the Rocky Mountains. The Art Institute sent entry blanks for the Midwestern Artists' Exhibition to artists in this region, but drew no strict political boundaries and accepted a few works from artists beyond the Mississippi who considered themselves Midwesterners. Three distinguished artists of Kansas and Missouri, now resident in New York, Thomas Benton, John Steuart Curry and Henry Varnum Poor, were invited to exhibit, not in competition, together with the members of the jury.

The jury comprised Grant Wood, of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, Birger Sandzen, of Lindsborg, Kansas, and Oscar B. Jacobson, of Norman, Oklahoma, three men highly honored as painters and teachers, inspiring the confidence of the artists of the region.
