- Effective 6 February 1946, Marine Aircraft Group Fifty-Three is transferred from the U. S. Marine Corps Air Station, Eagle Mountain Lake, Texas, to the Marine Corps Air Station, Cherry Point, North Carolina, in accordance with reference (a), and will proceed in two (2) echelons (air and ground), where upon arrival, the Commanding Officer, Marine Aircraft Group Fifty-Three, will report to the Commanding General, Ninth Marine Aircraft Wing. for quarters and messing
- (a) Air echelon will proceed via government aicraft to the U. S. Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, N. C. (b) Ground echeion will proceed via commercial rail transportation.
- This transfer involves a change of station for all Group personnel and equipment.
- The Commanding Officer, Marine Aircraft Group Fifty-Three, or his authorized representative, will countersign a copy of this order and deliver it by endorsement to each officer and enlisted man entitled to transportation of dependents, which shall constitute the original change of station order for individuals concerned.
- This being a movement of troops, commercial rail transportation is authorized and will be requested from the Quartermasser, U. S. Marine Corps Air Station, Eagle Mountain Lake, Texas.
- 6. Officers and enlisted men in the air echelon will be allowed a per dien of \$7,00 while in an air travel status.
- The Commanding Officer, Marine Aircraft Group Fifty-Three, is authorized to grant officers and enlisted men permission to travel by their privately owned conveyances.
- Flight orders for personnel concerned are continued in 8. force.
- Three (3) copies of all orders and rosters issued in connection with this transfer will be furnished this Headquarters.
- At the earliest practicable date, a certified copy of this order and a complete roster of personnel involved will be furnished the Paymaster handling pay accounts.
