1 AN ACT concerning

2 ~~Community Colleges~~ **Institutions of Higher Education – State Funding –**
3 **Revision**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the University of Maryland School of Medicine to provide
5 certain clinical care at the University of Maryland Capital Region Medical Center
6 and certain rural hospitals by assigning certain faculty to the Center and certain
7 rural hospitals who specialize in certain areas; requiring the Governor, for certain
8 fiscal years, to include in the annual budget bill an appropriation to implement
9 certain requirements regarding the provision of certain clinical care; providing that
10 certain funding is supplemental and may not supplant existing funds; specifying that
11 a certain appropriation calculated under the Senator John A. Cade Funding Formula
12 ~~and~~, a certain appropriation for Baltimore City Community College, and a certain
13 appropriation for certain private nonprofit institutions of higher education include
14 appropriations, regardless of where they are budgeted, designated for the general
15 operation of 4-year public institutions of higher education in the State; and generally

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **(A) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF MEDICINE SHALL PROVIDE**
 23 **CLINICAL CARE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND CAPITAL REGION MEDICAL**
 24 **CENTER BY ASSIGNING TO THE CENTER FACULTY WHO SPECIALIZE IN THE**
 25 **FOLLOWING:**

- 26 **(1) NEUROSCIENCE;**
- 27 **(2) OBSTETRICS AND GYNECOLOGY;**
- 28 **(3) ONCOLOGY; AND**
- 29 **(4) VASCULAR NEUROLOGY.**

30 **(B) (1) FOR FISCAL YEARS 2023 THROUGH 2025, THE GOVERNOR SHALL**
 31 **INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF AT LEAST \$5,000,000**
 32 **TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.**

1 **(2) FUNDS PROVIDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION**
2 **SHALL SUPPLEMENT AND MAY NOT SUPPLANT ANY OTHER FUNDING PROVIDED TO**
3 **THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF MEDICINE.**

5 **(A) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF MEDICINE SHALL PROVIDE**
6 **SPECIALIZED CLINICAL CARE AT RURAL HOSPITALS OPERATED BY THE UNIVERSITY**
7 **OF MARYLAND MEDICAL SYSTEM BY ASSIGNING FACULTY WHO SPECIALIZE IN**
8 **ESSENTIAL AREAS TO EACH RURAL HOSPITAL.**

9 **(B) (1) FOR FISCAL YEARS 2023 THROUGH 2025, THE GOVERNOR SHALL**
10 **INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF AT LEAST \$2,000,000**
11 **TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.**

12 **(2) FUNDS PROVIDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION**
13 **SHALL SUPPLEMENT AND MAY NOT SUPPLANT ANY OTHER FUNDING PROVIDED TO**

16 (a) The formula used for the distribution of funds to the community colleges in
17 the State shall be known as the Senator John A. Cade Funding Formula.

18 (c) (1) (i) Except as provided in subparagraphs (iii), (iv), and (v) of this
19 paragraph, the total State operating fund per full-time equivalent student to the
20 community colleges for each fiscal year as requested by the Governor shall be:

21 11. In fiscal year 2021, not less than an amount equal to 25%
22 of the State's General Fund appropriation per full-time equivalent student to the 4-year
23 public institutions of higher education in the State as designated by the Commission for
24 the purpose of administering the Joseph A. Sellinger Program under Title 17 of this article
25 in the same fiscal year;

26 12. In fiscal year 2022, not less than an amount equal to 27%
27 of the State's General Fund appropriation per full-time equivalent student to the 4-year
28 public institutions of higher education in the State as designated by the Commission for
29 the purpose of administering the Joseph A. Sellinger Program under Title 17 of this article
30 in the same fiscal year; and

31 13. In fiscal year 2023 and each fiscal year thereafter, not less
32 than an amount equal to 29% of the State's General Fund appropriation per full-time
33 equivalent student to the 4-year public institutions of higher education in the State as
34 designated by the Commission for the purpose of administering the Joseph A. Sellinger
35 Program under Title 17 of this article in the same fiscal year.

1 (ii) For purposes of this subsection, the State's General Fund
2 appropriation per full-time equivalent student to the 4-year public institutions of higher
3 education in the State for a fiscal year shall include [noncapital]:

4 1. **NONCAPITAL** appropriations from the Higher Education
5 Investment Fund; AND

6 2. **APPROPRIATIONS, REGARDLESS OF WHERE THEY**
7 **ARE BUDGETED, DESIGNATED FOR THE GENERAL OPERATION OF 4-YEAR PUBLIC**
8 **INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE, INCLUDING**

11 (a) (1) The total State operating fund per full-time equivalent student
12 appropriated to Baltimore City Community College for each fiscal year other than fiscal
13 year 2013, as requested by the Governor shall be:

14 (xii) In fiscal year 2021, not less than an amount equal to 64.5% of the
15 State's General Fund appropriation per full-time equivalent student to the 4-year public
16 institutions of higher education in the State as designated by the Commission for the
17 purpose of administering the Joseph A. Sellinger Program under Title 17 of this article in
18 the same fiscal year;

19 (xiii) In fiscal year 2022, not less than an amount equal to 66.5% of the
20 State's General Fund appropriation per full-time equivalent student to the 4-year public
21 institutions of higher education in the State as designated by the Commission for the
22 purpose of administering the Joseph A. Sellinger Program under Title 17 of this article in
23 the same fiscal year; and

24 (xiv) In fiscal year 2023 and each fiscal year thereafter, not less than
25 an amount equal to 68.5% of the State's General Fund appropriation per full-time
26 equivalent student to the 4-year public institutions of higher education in the State as
27 designated by the Commission for the purpose of administering the Joseph A. Sellinger
28 Program under Title 17 of this article in the same fiscal year.

29 (2) For purposes of this subsection, the State's General Fund appropriation
30 per full-time equivalent student to the 4-year public institutions of higher education in the
31 State for a fiscal year shall include [noncapital]:

32 (I) **NONCAPITAL** appropriations from the Higher Education
33 Investment Fund; AND

34 (II) **APPROPRIATIONS, REGARDLESS OF WHERE THEY ARE**

4 (d) For purposes of this section, the State's General Fund appropriation per
5 full-time equivalent student to the 4-year public institutions of higher education in the
6 State for a fiscal year shall include [noncapital]:

8 Fund; AND

9 (2) APPROPRIATIONS, REGARDLESS OF WHERE THEY ARE
10 BUDGETED, DESIGNATED FOR THE GENERAL OPERATION OF 4-YEAR PUBLIC
11 INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE, INCLUDING
12 PERSONNEL-RELATED APPROPRIATIONS.

14 1, 2021.
