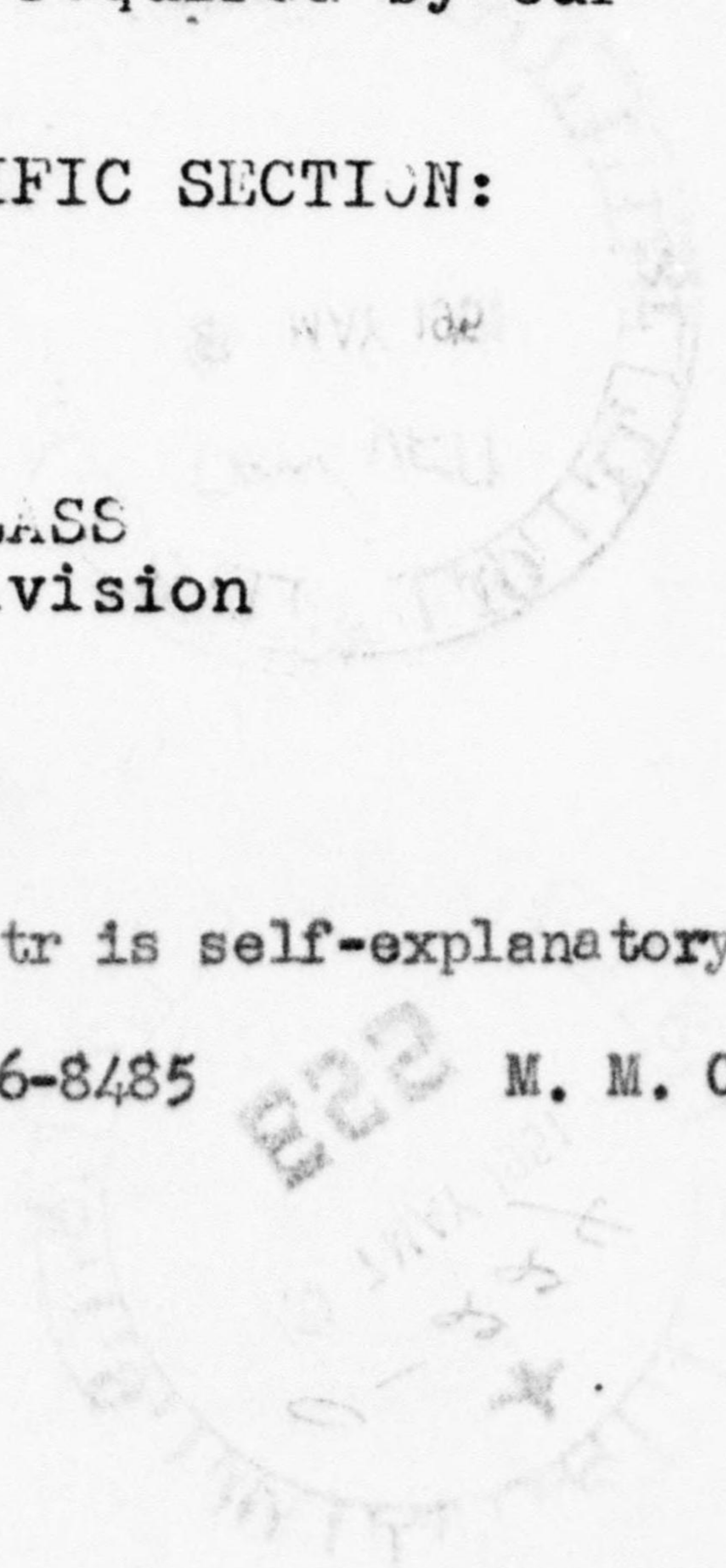

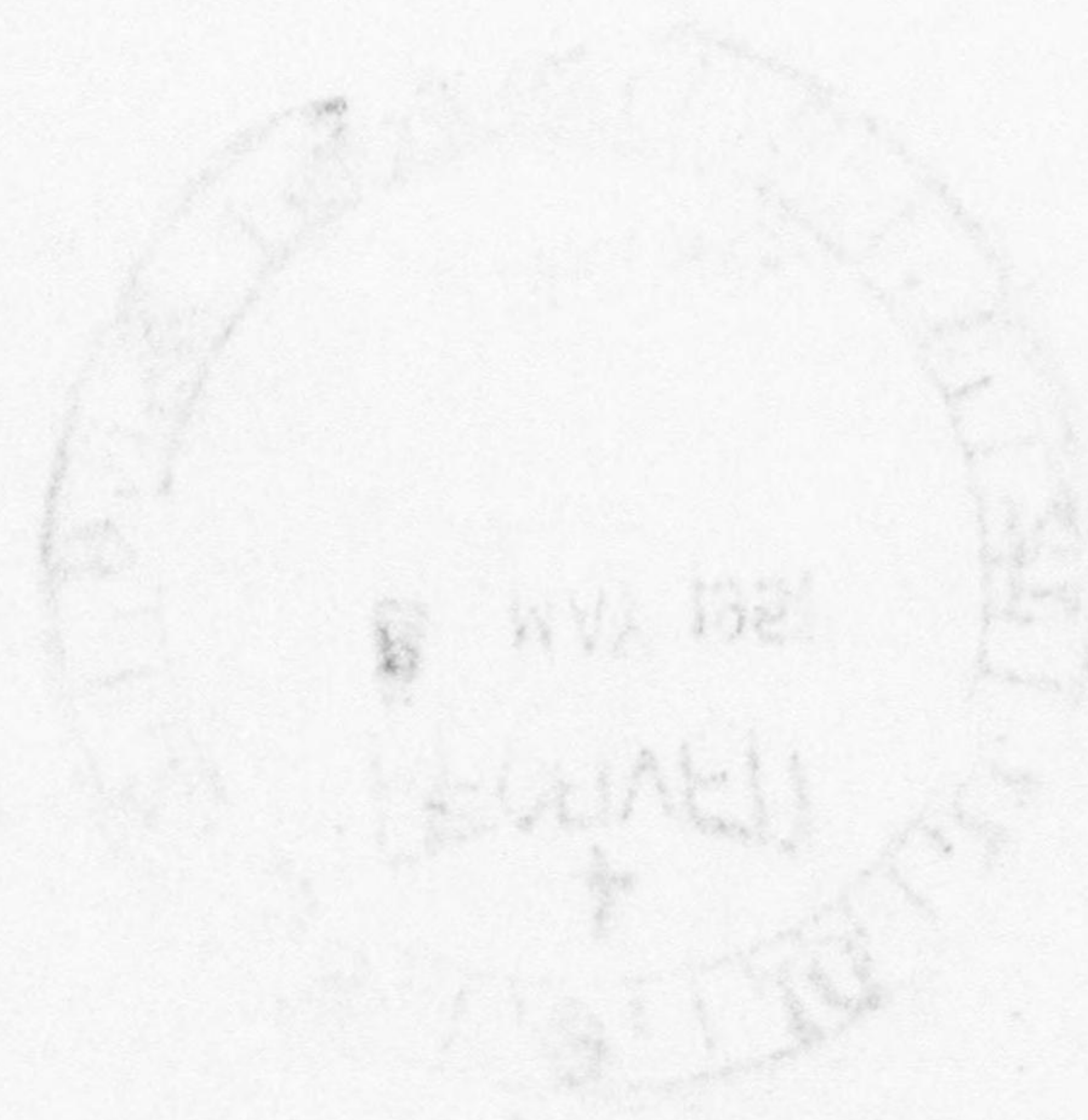

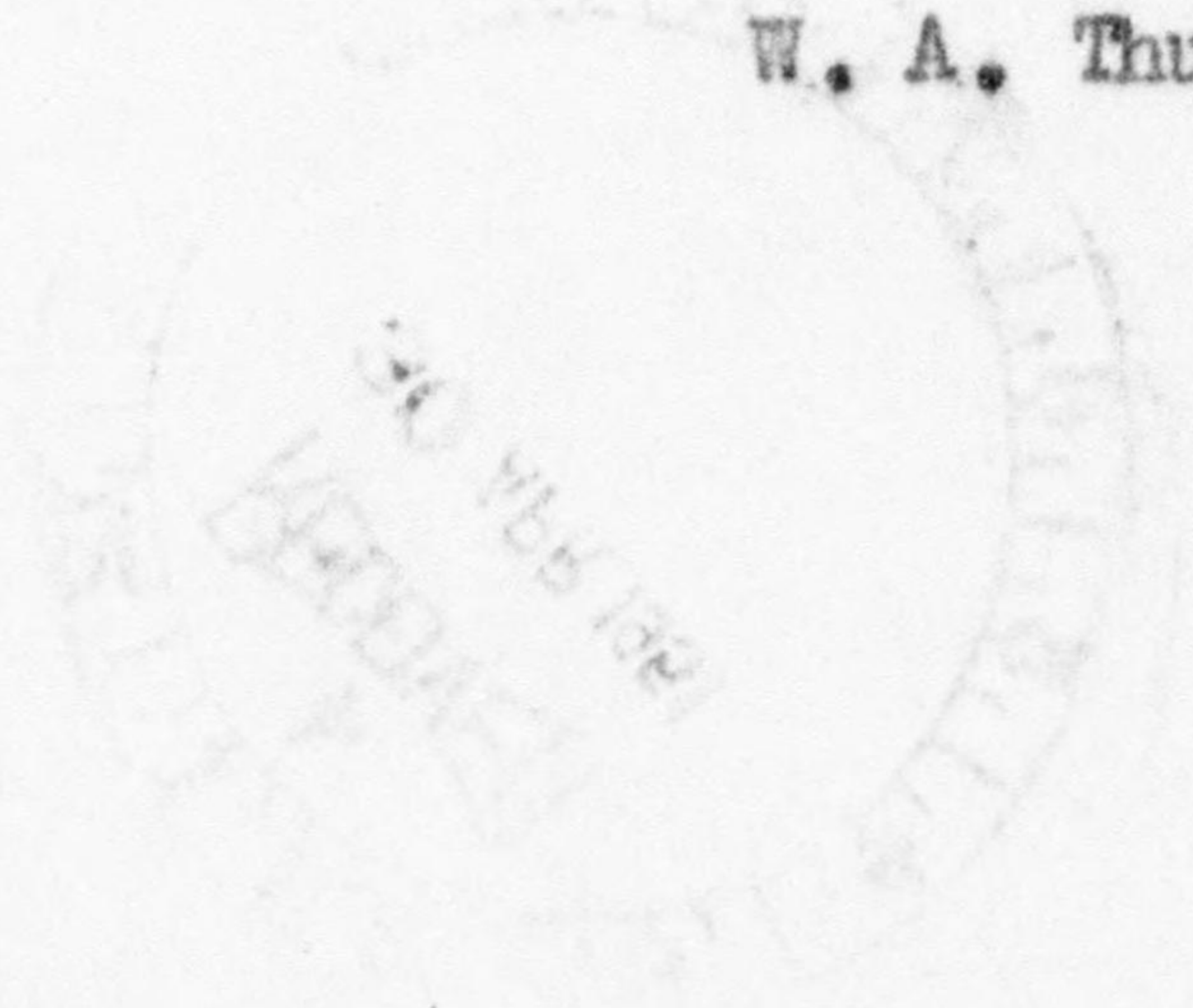

We therefore, must equip seven more precision lathes. Thou we are in need of clutch part machining 400 pieces per month, we have no milling machine in the plant at present. So that we wish to equip one milling machine with eight workers.

3. The effect of the listed machine tools have been equipped.

The applied lathes are precision and efficient machine tools. By using those lathes, we can treble the monthly output which means all ordered gears from the parent plant can be finished in our plant. In addition to that, the articles can be expected their precision finishing. One of milling machine applied is specially suitable to machine claw clutch parts that is to fill the request of the parent plant. These applied machine tools are necessary to enable an increased production plan requested by the parent plant and urgently needed.

4/ Reasons, the application submitted for.

In order to get the listed machine tools at the market, we are unable on the stand point of capital and requested time limit for they are very expensive and hard to find adequate machine tools. We therefore, wish to borrow and use the listed reparations machinery laying idle in the stated reparation plant.



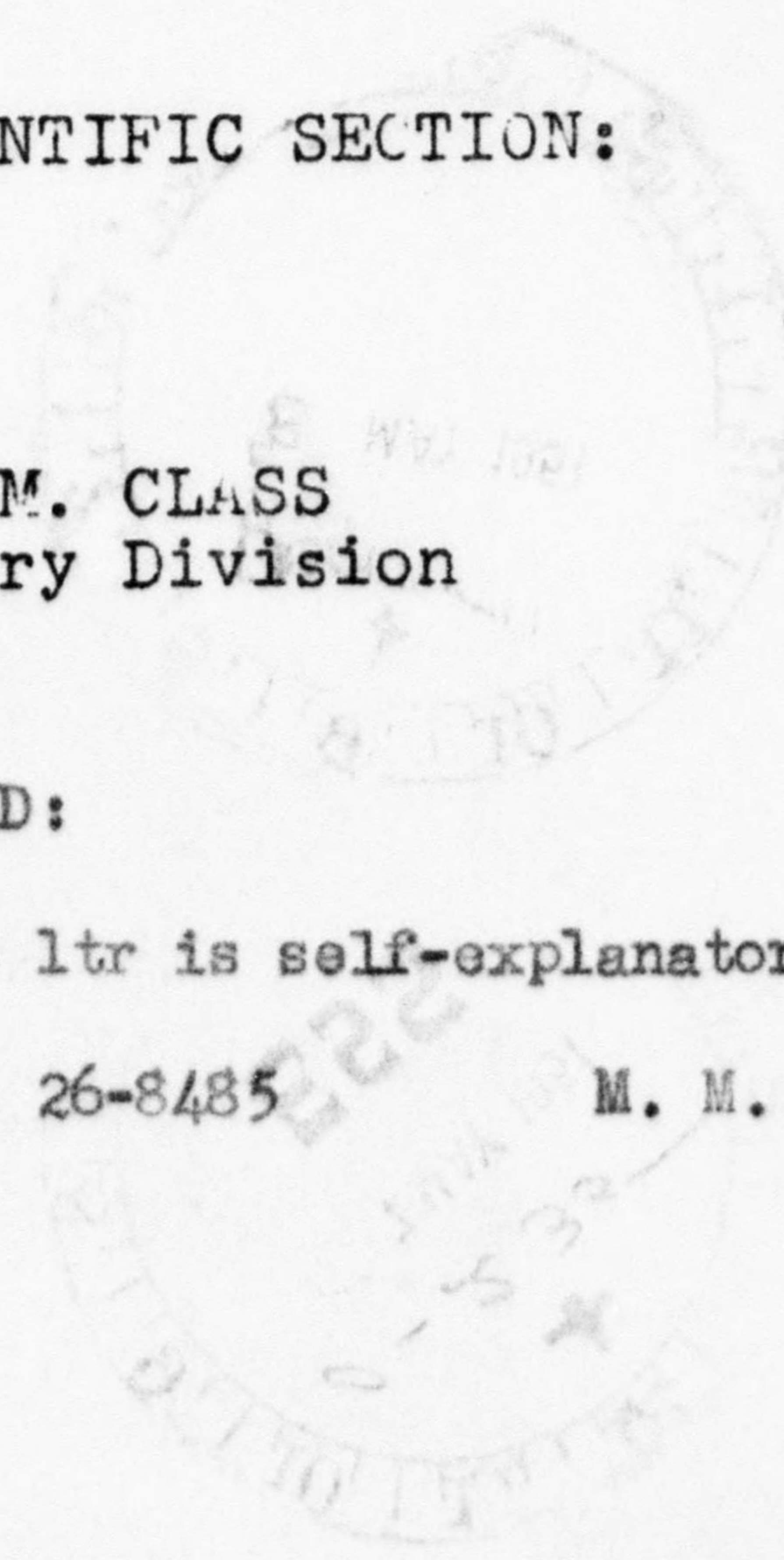
