~~no particular~~ Allocation of electricity for the first quarter of the fiscal 1950 was figured out putting the base on the real consumption in the first quarter of 1949 fiscal year. This method doesn't match meet the actual status of the production in this plant, and a big curtail of 7,914 KWH was figured out. When this plant needs 31,000 KWH at least, they were allocated only 21,888 KWH. More reasonable accounting method is desired. Consumption is not limited but the fare is 73sen/1KW for allocated power, and 94sen/135sen/1KW for exceeding consumption.
