

(1) During the month of January, the Battalion was resupplied in the field with helicopters. Helicopter support was generally good. The biggest problem area existed in obtaining Class II and I items to send to the field. Hert of this problem was due to non-availability of certain Class II items at FIC and part to difficulty in transporting these items from Danang to An Hoa, It is also felt that a Class IV dump should be established at the LSU An los to eliminate the time lag involved in obtaining Class IV items to fly to the field.

- (2) Melaria ceses increased in Company W. It is believed this west caused from searching an enemy hospital that treated melaria.

d. Transportation



PART II

NAPRAPIUE SUMMARY

During the month of January, Operation Taylor Common continued. The Bettelion continued its assigned mission of Rearch and Destroy. The commonies continued to patrol from company size petrol bases, making point contact numerous times with small units of 4-5 ****I/**C. everal but and bunker complexes were found and destroyed. Also a fairly large amount of enemy equipment and supplies were captured and/or destroyed.

As the Operation continues, it is evident that the large enemy force has departed from the area. Towever, one instance confirmed that the enemy was still capable of operating in this area in other than small size units. An estimated 20 TV4/VG did spring a well organized ambush on a Marine Combat Patrol resulting in moderate Marine casualties. Toint contacts did however remain the most common form of engagement.



1 Jan 60 1100H In the area of 20130362, elements of Co L discovered 1 hut 15x10x8 feet containing fire wood, chairs, and a picnic table believed to have been a carpenter's hut. The hut had a trap door. The hut was destroyed.

1133H In the area of ZC142382, *elements of Co M discovered 3 new RPG 2 rounds with 6 boosters. They were of Chinese origin and were destroyed.

12009 In the area of 20128347, elements of Co L discovered 5 huts. 3ketches were made by S-2 personnel. The first hut was a messhall 12x20x12 feet. The second hut was 10x16x18 feet with a 6 foot cellar and a fireplace. The third hut was 8x6x10 feet and had a 3x3x3 feet bin believed used to hold rice. The fourth hut was 12x16x8 feet and had a K44 rifle buried outside. The fifth hut was 12x12x12 feet. All the huts had thatched roofs and no wall . The area was estimated to have been deserted 5 days previous. The construction was estimated to be 1-3 months old. A trail ran to a stream which was used as a water point. Logs lead across the stream to a gravel road with bamboo underneath. The road was approximately 5 feet wide and ran parallel to the stream. It was followed for 175 meters and 5 huts were discovered. Three of which were 2 story with living quarters on ton and a kitchen and storage area on the bottom. Each but contained 27 rifle racks and clothes lines. One but had bamboo piping with running water. The huts were destroyed.

3 Jan 60 0945% In the area of 70138380, elements of Co E made contact with an unknown number of enemy. Artillery and mortar fire was called in with unknown results.

1030H In the area of 20129344, elements of Co L discovered 4 huts; 3 were living huts and the other was a messhall. Search of the area resulted in finding shirts, trousers, and a few documents which were turned into 1-2. The huts were destroyed.

1200% In the area of 20,152361, elements of Co. K discovered ? bunkers, one on each side of the trail. Detimated to be 2 wasks old. The bunkers were destroyed.

1200 In the area of 60152332, elements of Co I discovered 30 fighting heles appare mately 3 months ole. They were destroyed.

12001 In the area of C141356, elements of Co. L discovered 17
MA packs, 106, rounds of Ak 47 ammunition, 3 Chicom grandes,
1 M25 grande, 3 gas masks, various documents, black pajanas,
and green utilities. The documents were turned in to 3-2 and
the rest destroyed.

1230H. In the area of 20138380 elements of Co H made contact with an unknown number of enemy. Called in artillary with unknown results.

1445% In the area of 20153319, elements of Co L observed A enemy sitting behind some rocks. They were taken under fire with small arms and artillary. The enemy fled to the southwest leaving behind 1 4K 47 rifle with 4 magazines, 50 bounds of rice, 3 pots, 4 packs, 4 rifle belt, for of bloody sendals.

13154 In the area of **C126343, elements of Co I were taken under fire by 2 %K's and a machine gun. The fire was returned an' the contact was broken. Called in artillary, checked area and found 1 NVA KIA with 2 Chicom granades, 1 moncho, 1 canteen, 1 cartridge belt, 1 first air mouch with documents. The documents were given to \$-2.

4 Jan 69 11157 In the area of 70161351, elements of Co M made contact with 1 MM 1/VC wearing black rejemes and armed with an 1 47 with magazines, and 1 Chicom granade. The enemy was killed.

Search of the area resulted in finding 1 3746 mechine gun, 1 Chicom granede, 2 rolls of rubber, 1 toothbrush, 1 tube of toothbraste, 1 bottle of lubricant, 151 mounds of rice, 2 shirts, 1 bottle of seasoning, 2 tablets of plain paper, 1 hammock, 7 trousers, 4 undershirts, 1 medical bag, 1 bottle of blue ink, 1 bar of TUX cap, 1 1-tool, and 123 NVA maps.
