Reported to the 2nd bn p.c. which had been established  
near By. there assisted the 2nd bn section in keeping  
communication with Reg: p.c. till the morning  
of the 12th we started forward as the enemy left in a  
hurry. we advanced to the isone River. our p.c.  
was about 1 kilo and 6 hectometer south of the River  
in a little patch of trees which was sheltered almost  
every night. the night before we was relieved  
by the 1st bn. we moved to St Kauberg about 1 kilo  
east. of our old position. my section then moved  
to coulommies till the night of Oct 24th when  
the Division was relieved. and started to  
the Rear: Itikal to omachault. that night.  
next morning taken a Truck train sweepke.
