MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Construction of Steel and Wood Vessels

✓ 1. Rescission. Memorandum for the Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, AG 561.4(22 Aug 46)ESS/IND, SCAPIN 1148, dated 22 August 1946, subject: Construction of Steel and Wood Vessels.

2. The construction and conversion of all steel vessels regardless of size or tonnage and any wood vessel of over 100 gross tons is prohibited without the specific approval of the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

3. Conversion shall be defined as the alteration of the principal dimensions, and/or the design of the vessel.
