LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

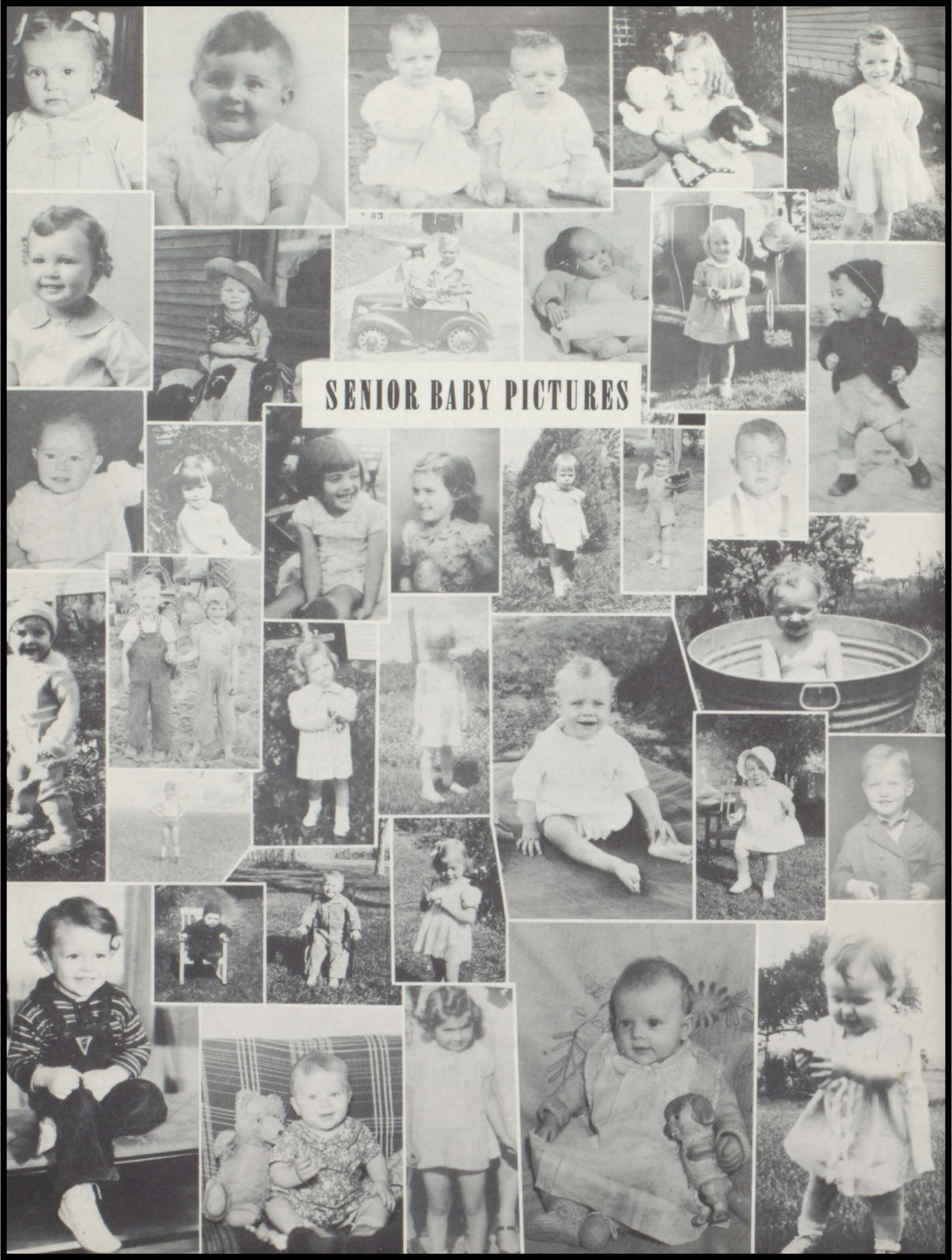
