

- connect other databases and collections of information (Linked Data)













Six ways academics can contribute to Wikipedia





- 1. Check three Africa-related Wikipedia entries. Correct mistakes or add a source.
- 2. Write an article about an important subject still missing in Wikipedia.
- 3. Give your students an assignment including writing a draft Wikipedia article.
- 4. Check the Wikipedia article of your favourite African university or institute.
- 5. Check https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Category:Africa-related_lists and see what's missing.
- 6. Donate the Africa photographs from you or your institute to Wikimedia Commons.








Call for action
