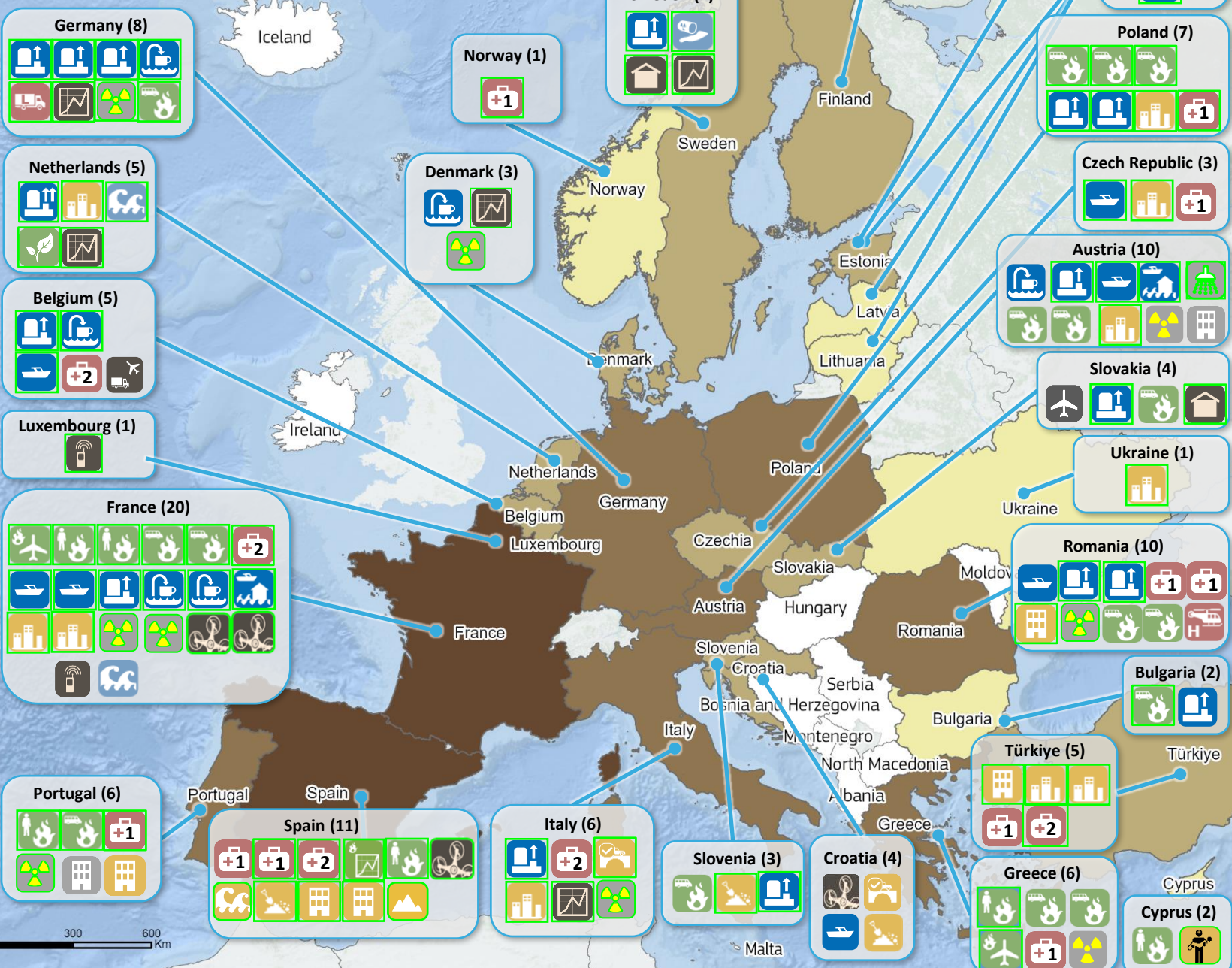

The **European Civil Protection Pool** consists of a range of emergency response capacities that countries participating in the **EU Civil Protection Mechanism** make available for EU emergency response operations. Since the establishment of the pool in October 2014, 27 countries have brought together 134 civil protection capacities which are now available (or will eventually become available) for EU operations worldwide.



¹ Registered Capacity is an offered capacity -made by a UCPM country- that has successfully passed both an application process and then a certification process.
