1. In compliance with verbal instructions, Hqs Tokai-Hokuriku MGR, APO 710, the following report is submitted.
2. On or about 1000 hours, 9 October 1948, upon receipt of verbal order Tokai-Hokuriku MGR, APO 710, all police forces in Aichi Prefecture, the Aichi CIC, the office of the Nagoya Provost Marshal, the Aichi Headquarters of the League of Korean Resident in Japan and the Aichi Headquarters of the Korean Settlement Corporation were notified by this headquarters that the public display of the North Korean flag was illegal and that all such flags would be confiscated.
3. On 10 October 1948, at about 1100 hours, a mass public demonstration of about 10,000 Koreans was held by the Korean League in Nagoya City "to congratulate (the) Korean Democratic People's Republic." At the time of this demonstration it was found that a large group of Korean children carried flags of the Republic of North Korea. Demonstration officials were admonished on-the-spot and ordered to collect and turn over to representatives of this headquarters and the Japanese police all North Korean flags. About 250 flags were confiscated. This confiscation was conducted in good order. No other actions were taken.

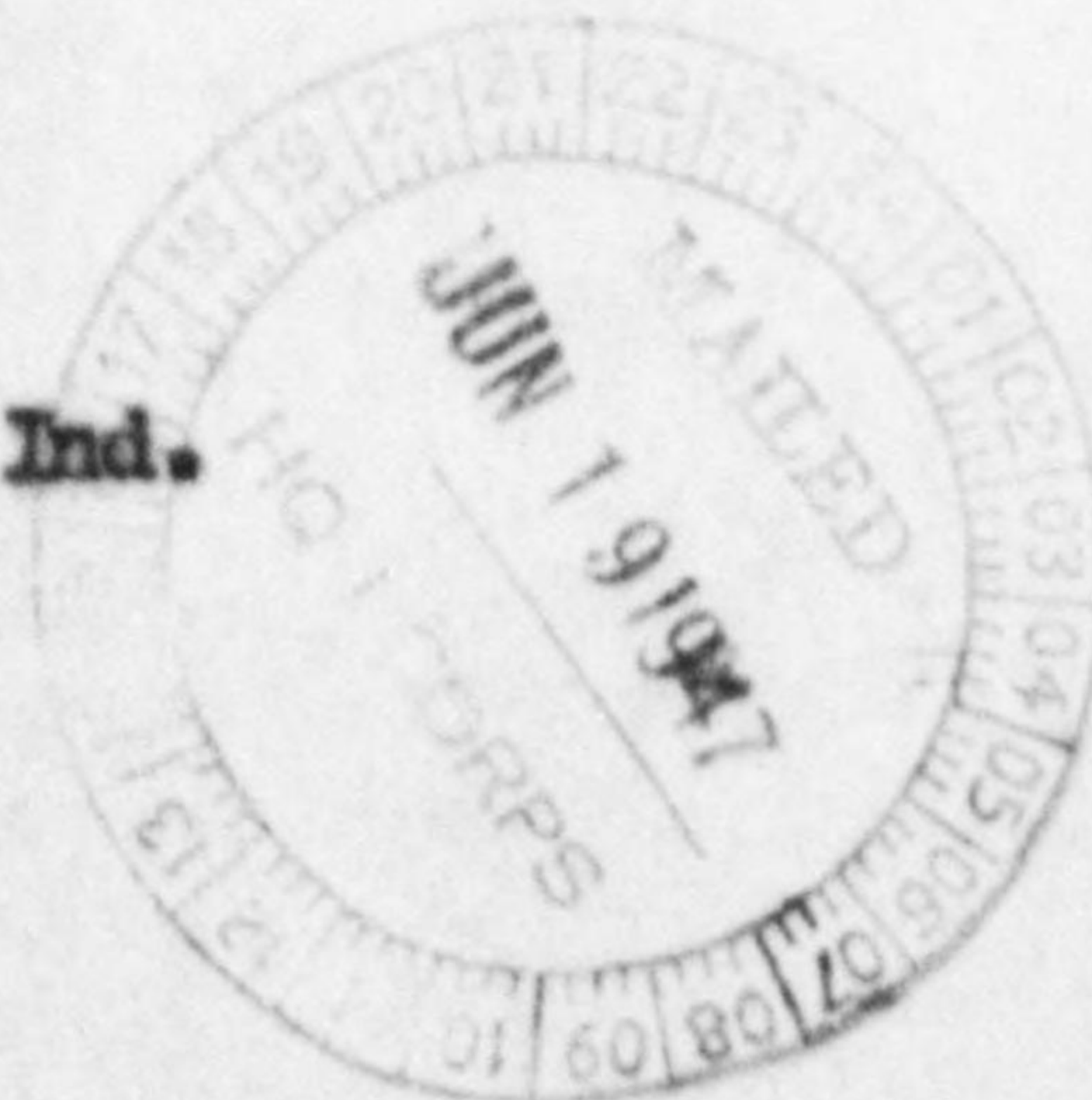

But all salaried persons are allowed a 25% reduction of gross income before figuring taxable income, so $36,000 \times 75\% = 27,000$ income before basic deduction.

Father and son's income before basic deductions: 70,000 + 27,000 = 97,000.

Subtract basic deduction of 10,325 per taxpayer. There are two taxpayers, father and salaried son.

The taxable income is taxed piecemeal as follows:

SUBJECT: Yamamura, Yoshio's Case

TO: COMMANDER GENERAL I COLDS APO 301

1. Through a series of conferences with Chief Procurator, Kuricka, Chief Judge, Ohnishi of Kyoto-fu and Doc. of Miura, psychiatrist, University of Kyoto; the following plan is recommended for disposition of the case:

a. The mental condition of the patient precludes trial by Provost Court and since the Occupation Forces do not have an institution for confining such cases, Yamamura should be turned over to the Japanese for administrative disposition under Japanese laws. The pertinent laws are Law No. 38, 1900 "Protection law for mentally deranged person" and Law No. 25, 1919 "Hospital law for mentally diseased."

2. Under these laws, the Governor becomes responsible for the institutionalizing of the individual. In this case we would turn the matter over to Mr. Tsuchiya, Chief of the Public and Welfare Section, Kyoto-fu.

3. Through Japanese administrative procedures, they will send Yamamura, Yoshio to a Japanese institution.

4. In view of the importance of this case, it is deemed desirable to obtain a report on the disposition of Yamamura, and further, the military government team should conduct at least a monthly inspection to ascertain the status of the confined person.
