

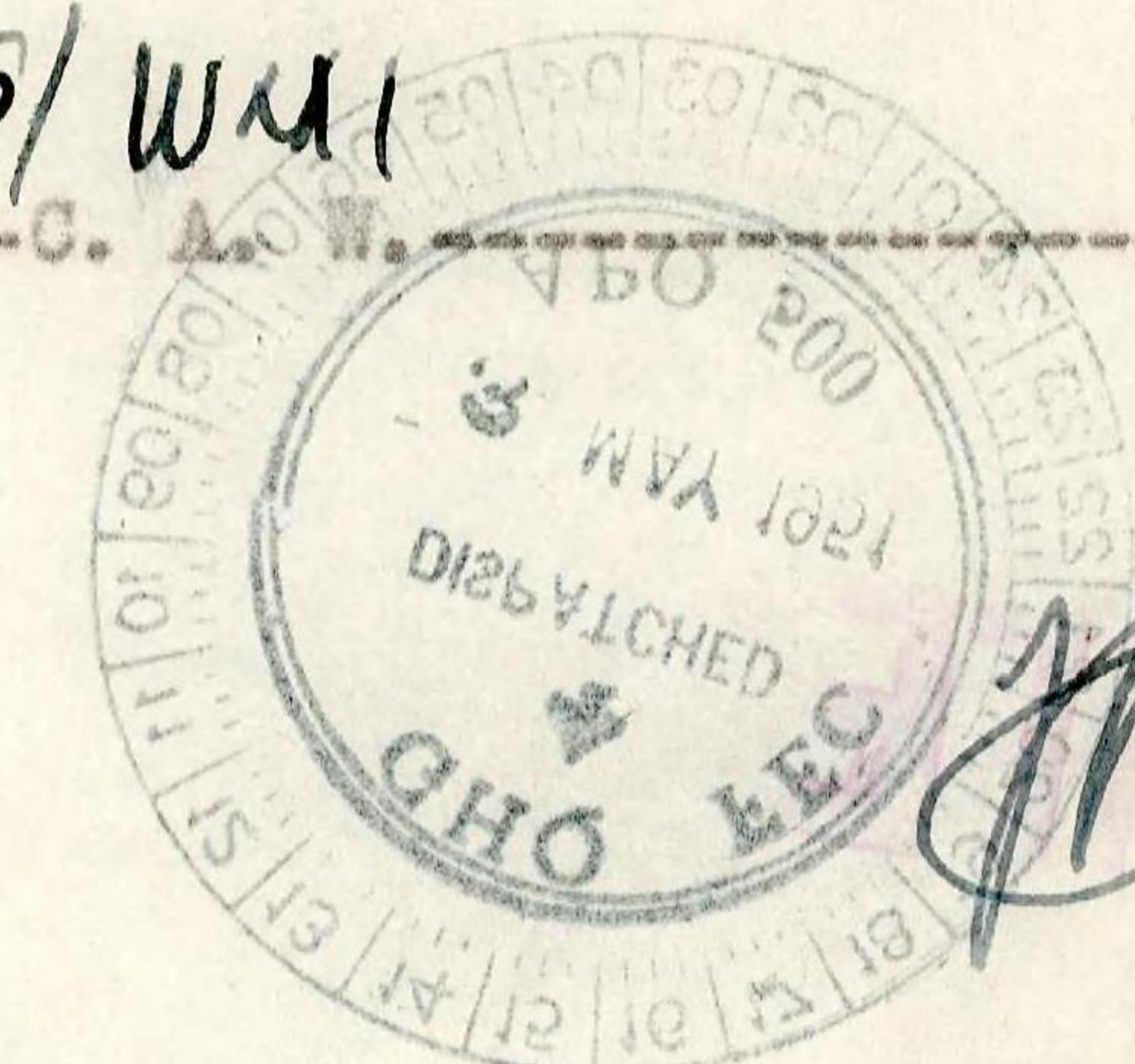

1. Reference paragraph A, Section I, Part II, DA, T/A 21 (Mbl), subj: "Clothing and Equipment", 26 Jan 50. (Incl 1) 1.

2.
