Lieut. (jg) J. F. BATES in a PB4Y-1P aircraft of Fleet Air Photographic Squadron Five took off from Iwo Jima airstrip on 28 April 1945 at 0830 King to photograph enemy installations on Kikai Island of the Nansei Shoto chain. He arrived over the target at 1230 King and obtained 70.7 per cent photographic coverage of the island. Four friendly VF were strafing the target during his runs. No antiaircraft fire or enemy interception was encountered. Lieut. (jg) BATES landed at Iwo at 1700 King.
