





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## Practices of Linked Open Data in Archaeology and Their Realisation in Wikidata

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## Abstract

In this paper, we introduce Linked Open Data (LOD) in the archaeological domain as a means to connect dispersed data sources and enable cross-querying. The technology behind the design principles and how LOD can be created and published is described to enable less-familiar researchers to understand the presented benefits and drawbacks of LOD. Wikidata is introduced as an open knowledge hub for the creation and dissemination of LOD. Different actors within archaeology have implemented LOD, and we present which challenges have been and are being addressed. A selection of projects showcases how Wikidata is being used by archaeologists to enrich and open their databases to the general public. With this paper, we aim to encourage the creation and re-use of LOD in archaeology, as we believe it offers an improvement on current data publishing practices.




- An extension of the SPARQLing Unicorn QGIS Plugin

### Background [edit]



This is part of the funded Open Science Fellow Program, where I would like to create a semantically described, Linked Open Data<sup>[1]</sup> (LOD) collection of Irish Ogham stones<sup>[2]</sup> and to freely accessible to all in the spirit of Knowledge Equity. This collection is built on existing published research and can thus serve as another important research tool in the field of early medieval inscriptions. On private journeys through Ireland, especially in the western part of the green Isle, in the counties of Kerry and Cork, I have come across a mysterious script and stones as its original inscription carriers in various places. After initial research, these turned out to be Ogham stones with an early medieval Ogham script, one of Ireland's most remarkable national treasures. Ogham stones were placed in Ireland and the western part of Britain between the 4th and 8th century. The inscriptions carved on the stones show in particular kinship or tribal relationships and also may have served as gravestones or area demarcations. They are an important source for historians, but also for linguists and archeologists. In order to bring this rich treasure of a small manageable corpus of inscriptions and stones as free knowledge to a large research community, the idea of the Ogl Ogham Project<sup>[3]</sup> was born. This idea was initiated with friends in a spare time working group, the Research Squirrel Engineering<sup>[4]</sup>. This has already resulted in the first modelling and publications of stones after Macalister in Wikidata<sup>[5]</sup>.

The semantic modelling will be done in two ways. On the one hand, the data (stones, sites, words, people, etc.) will be stored in Wikidata in order to integrate the data into the Linked Data Cloud and to offer the community the opportunity to participate in Free Knowledge in the field of Ogham inscriptions. This can be done, for example, by adding images of Ogham stones to Wikimedia Commons and by adding to and translating the explanatory Wikipedia pages. On the other hand, the data will be stored in a separate Ogham ontology, made available via a SPARQL endpoint and linked to the stones available in Wikidata. This enables a deeper semantic modelling of the Ogham stones and their inscriptions and can thus contribute to an open and free scientific discourse. In addition, the Ogham stones will be made searchable on Wikidata and other Triplesstores in a community-friendly web platform. Filter options for specific topics, such as words used, material or persons, as well as for geographically definable areas should be possible. In addition, integration into free GIS software is to be made possible so that scientists can carry out further analyses in their own software world.





## Location and history:

According to [Brash, JRSAI 10, 1869](#), 260, the stone was found in a structure called *Rath Lisheenagreine*, in the townland of Gurranes (sic!), parish of Templemartin, 1 mle. north of the parish church (the village in question is named "Gurranes" in the Cork U.C. too). A detailed map of the rath (in connection with the larger *Rath Lisnacaheragh*) is available in S.P. [O' RÝordain's article in PRIA 47-C, 1941-42](#), 77 ff. - According to Brash, the stone was discovered by one farmer Crowley 17 years before (the publication of [his article in JRSAI 10, 1869](#)); Macalister states in [CIIC](#) that it "has been known since the sixties" and "appears to have come from a souterrain in the group" of "earth-works" on the townland of Gurranes. The first report was made by John Lyons, C.C., Newcestown, Enniskeane; Brash's visit took place on 16.12.1868.

The stone was moved to the Museum of the U.C., Cork after Macalister first visited it (at that time it was still "standing loosely in one of the ditches": [CIIC 1, 84](#)). In the collection of the U.C., it is assigned no. 17.





FIG. 2.—Portion of 6" Ordnance Survey Sheet, Co. Cork, No. 84 (Revision 1900-01), showing site of excavation (A) and neighbouring area. Based on the Ordnance Survey by permission of the Minister for Finance of Ireland.

H. "Lisheennagreine" Small fort, remains shown here are semi-circular but not marked in 1842. The portion here marked has since been cleared away, as has the fence shown across it. A hollow in the field may be seen and evidently marks the site. An ogham stone was found here and is now in University College, Cork. (*J.C.H.A.S.*, XXVI (1931), 67).






Figure 1. Geographic distribution of the Campanian Ignimbrite deposits, including archaeological and sampling sites mentioned in the paper. Solid squares: CI tephra occurrences and related thickness in cm (in italics if reworked) [modified from Cornell *et al.*, 1983; Amirkhanov *et al.*, 1993; Cini Castagnoli *et al.*, 1995; Narcisi and Vezzoli, 1999; Fedele *et al.*, 2002; Upton *et al.*, 2002]. Dotted area in central Italy: distribution of the CI-derived paleosol (CI-PS [Frezzotti and Narcisi, 1996]). Solid triangles: archaeological sites with CI ash layer. Blank triangles: archaeological sites with ash layer attributed to the CI on the basis of cultural-stratigraphic position and  $^{14}\text{C}$  dating (Fedele *et al.*, 2002; Giaccio and Isaia, on file). Solid circles: selected European Palaeolithic sites within the area potentially affected by the CI air-fall.







There is only the information that the **hoard was found on the river Esaro**, without specifying exactly where on the river course. In the literature, there is information that it was **found "in Crotone"**, by which **the city rather than the province** is meant, otherwise it would have been formulated differently. The urban area of the river course ends shortly after the "Strada Statale 106 Jonica". **The most likely location for the find is along the course of the river between the section just before the motorway and the mouth of the river in the sea.** Since the find was made in 1967, the course of the river at that time probably corresponds fairly closely to the course of the river today. 

**Background** [edit]

As a result of a cooperation agreement between the universities of Reading and Leeds together with the Römisches-Germanisches Zentralmuseum Mainz, the life-long study made by Brian Hartley and Brenda Dickinson of the stamps and signatures on samian became available as a database. They were originally published as a series of books (Institute of Classical Studies, London, from 2008 onwards).

The Samian Research Database<sup>1</sup> comprises a suite of databases concerned with samian ware. Their aim is to standardize the recording and publishing of samian ware in such a way that the data is available both for comparative identification, and more significantly for scientific analysis using statistical and mapping tools. All have their individual search facilities appropriate to the questions likely to require resolution. The databases comprise the following:

- Names on Terra Sigillata / Corpus Vasorum Aretinorum (merged into one database)
- Name marked decorated vessels
- Oval Vessels

Location data (discovery sites, kiln regions and production centres) are integrated into Wikidata using OpenRefine and Quick Statements. The mapping schemes in OpenRefine can be seen at [ds\\_schema.json](#), [kr\\_schema.json](#) and [pc\\_schema.json](#).

For each category we created a specific identifier in Wikidata Samian Ware Discovery Site, Samian Ware Productioncentre and Samian Ware Kilnregion. All entries are instances (P31) of a category and part of (P361) Samian Research. In Wikidata we used the exact match (P2885) property to link to the Linked Open Samian Ware resource. In the Samian LOD dataset we used our `lido:exactMatch` property to create a bidirectional link.

Due to its striking decoration, the so-called African Red Slip Ware (ARS) is central to the understanding of Late Antique imagination. The collaborative project between i3mainz and the RGZM opens up the artefact in an innovative and sustainable way through 3D digitisation.

Characteristic of the North African bowls, plates, and jugs are their pictorial decorations applied mainly by appliqués and stamps. As mass-produced image carriers and everyday objects, the ARS spread throughout the empire. The range of motifs includes mythological scenes as well as scenes from the Old and New Testament, circus, arena and hunting scenes as well as fish and plant motifs. The appliqués-decorated pottery thus provides insights into Late Antique imagination and its changes, as well as into the economic history of the period between the 3rd and 5th centuries AD in North Africa. Previous documentation methods were not able to capture the objects and their decoration in an adequate way. The digital recording of the RGZM's collections by 3D scans allows to compare potentially identical appliqués and to assign them to their negative forms and the corresponding stamps. Whereas vessel curvature previously falsified the assignment of appliqués and models, 3D analysis and visualisation tools now allow a comparison. Metadata created for each object increases the effectiveness and accuracy of determining image context and content. Issues related to the production of the ARS and the process flows within the workshops can be investigated through the analysis of the 3D data.


