Mr. [redacted] an employee of this Base, reported seeing an unidentified flying object while at work at 0107Z on 12 September 1952.

Mr. [redacted] described the object as a bright, white light which looked like an automobile headlight at a considerable distance. The light moved in a straight line from the southwest to the northwest and disappeared behind a tree. Its speed was described as "slower than an airplane".

The light was visible for "three or four" minutes, but Mr. [redacted] reported that during this time it dimmed "considerably" for a period of approximately five seconds, after which it regained its former brilliance. No exhaust or sound was noted.

There were no local aircraft in the air at the time. Weather was clear with twelve miles visibility, winds calm.

This office can offer no definite explanation of the sighting. Mr. [redacted] estimate of the length of his observation would discount astronomical phenomena such as meteors, but although no sound was heard and he maintained that the object did not resemble an aircraft, the object's speed and level flight strongly suggest the possibility of an aircraft.

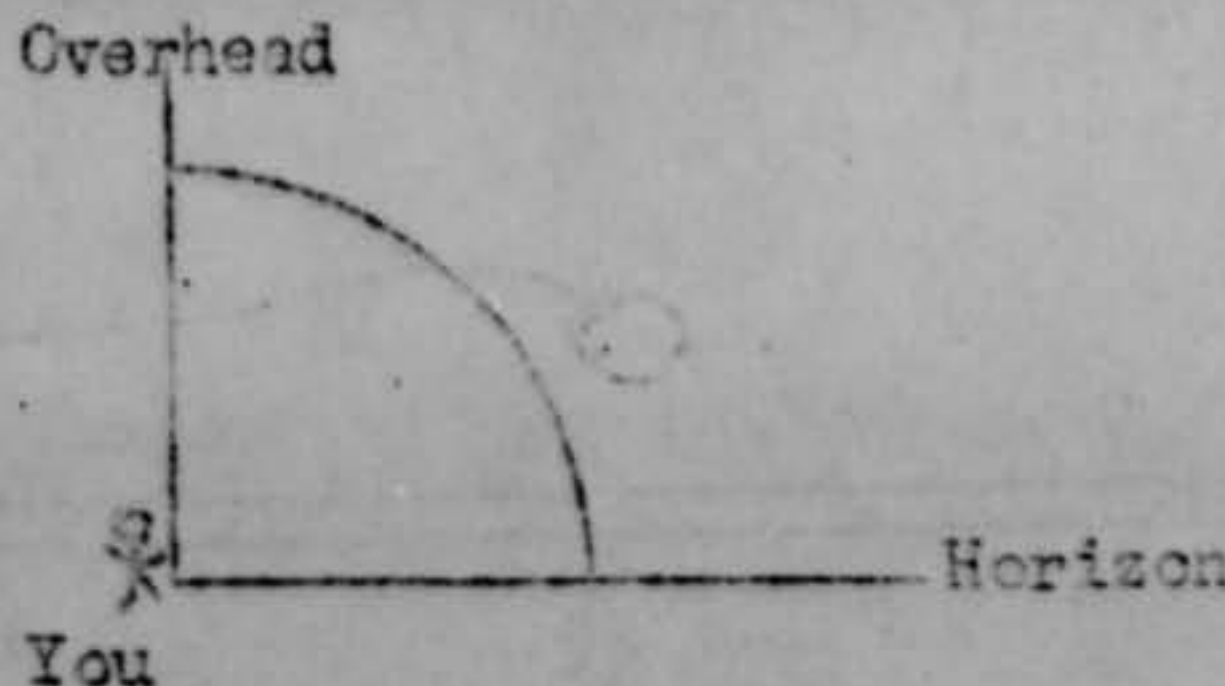

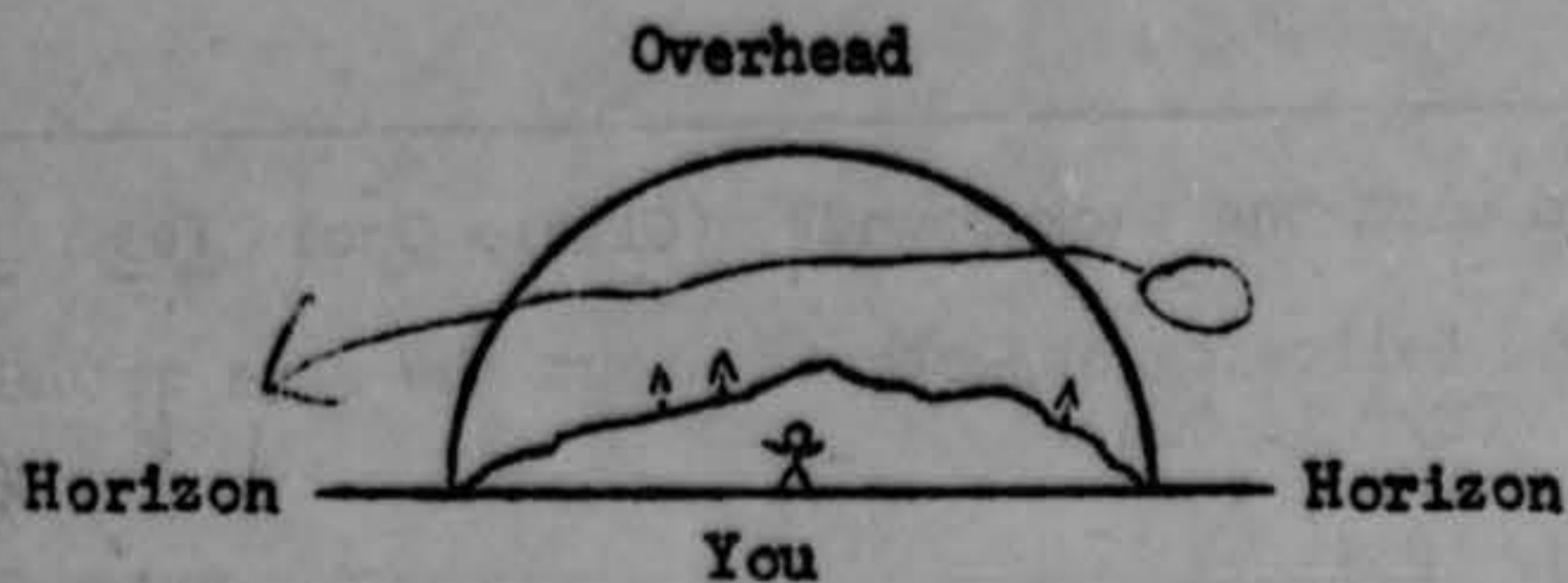

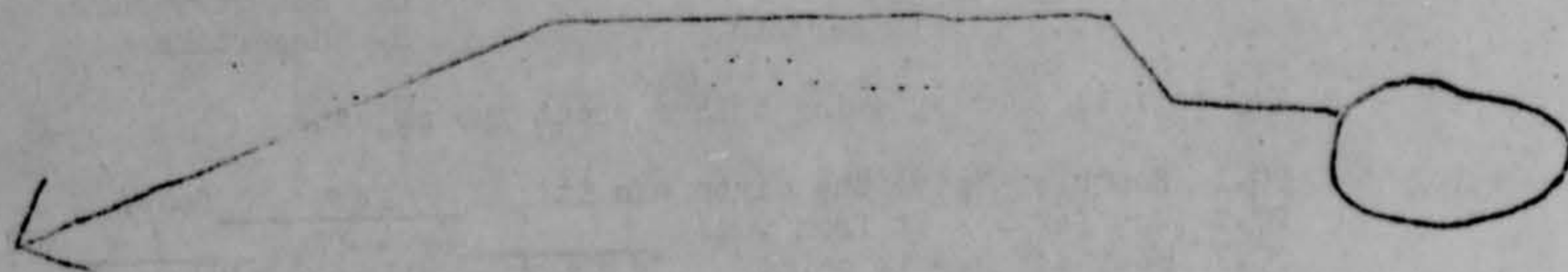
