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10. GUNN's main agents included George H. G. G., Samuel G. G., Toby D. G., H. G. G. (an editor of Signal), W. G. G. (export consultant), P. G. G. (former executive assistant to H. G. G.), I. G. G. (influential member of the government), and J. G. G. (Chief of Cabinet of H. G. G.).

11. During this period GUNN received 1,000 lei per month. Half of his air agents received 2,000-10,000 plus one 60,000-100,000 lei to be used as payments to sub-sources. The sub-sources collected the information from their contacts, passed it on to the main agents, who in turn informed GUNN. The latter edited the reports, evaluated them, and transmitted them by courier (over the Bucharest-Berlin air line).

12. In the fall of 1944, GUNN received an order to leave the equivalent rank of Kaptein in the Luftwaffe. However, GUNN never officially admitted into the Luftwaffe.

15. Another informant in Bucharest also stated that GUNN married a woman, the name of whom is not recalled. She was still in Bucharest. GUNN had two children, a girl and a boy, who were captured by the Luftwaffe during the occupation of Rumania.

16. According to Ernst KALTENBRUNNER, AUNER was the liaison officer of the Iron Guard and MUNIU was personally in touch with the Iron Guard through AUNER. KALTENBRUNNER also stated that AUNER had once been in Austrian territory and was also a prisoner in the Reich after the Iron Guard putsch. We can find no information in Karl files to confirm or refute this allegation.

17. AUNER, with H. TIL, surrendered to CIC Kirchdorf and sent to Freysing Interrogation Center. He was involved with H. TIL in the Goo-proposed Operation Mount (Latin cover of HUSTON's spy network). This was disapproved by UNSAT and AUNER was returned to the Interrogation Center for formal questioning. He was later interned in Camp 4000, Salzburg.

18. According to H. TIL, as of 1943, AUNER was Hauptsturmführer, planted as a representative of German interests in Romania. At the same time he belonged to the office of the German officer of the Legion of German Nationals. According to H. TIL, AUNER was a member of the Landsleitende German minority organization in Bucharest, headed by H. TIL.

19. AUNER is the liaison officer of the Iron Guard in Romania. He was concerned primarily with the gathering of political and economic intelligence, though he did handle some other types of intelligence.

20. AUNER is a former member of the Iron Guard in Romania. He was active in the Iron Guard in Romania and was active in the Iron Guard in Austria. UNSAT, Headquarters CIC Region IV, 970th CIC Detachment, subject: French intelligence agents in U.S. zones of Austria and Germany, dated 18 December 1947, evaluated D-3, states: "AUNER (AUNER), fnu, address SALZBURG, Sigmundhoefnerstrasse 1, is a former Sturmbannfuhrer of the SD. During the war subject was liaison officer between the Reichssicherheitsamt and the Roumanian IC. Subject is presently alleged to be working for an American intelligence agency in SALZBURG. At the end of October, subject met the chief agent runner of the French, GUYALVSKY. Subject is suspected of working now for French intelligence inasmuch as he was introduced to Captain GUYALVSKY (allegedly running an agent network for the French in Austria) by GUYALVSKY."

b. Another CIC report, dated 10 November 1948, evaluated D-3, states substantially as follows: "An fnu AUNER, a former Sturmbannfuhrer of the SD, presently living on Sigmundhoefnerstrasse, SALZBURG, is an important employee of an American intelligence agency or service operating in SALZBURG. AUNER is a 'go between' for the IC and the Roumanian. During the last

war, he was the leader of a group of individuals working in the Balkans. According to SIG's source, AUM is presently attending a school operated by Americans in a large mansion near Sofjangeec. Physical description of AUM is given as follows: Height: 1.70 meters; blue eyes, blond hair, fair complexion, and muscular build. He speaks Russian, and a little French."

5. According to SIG, AUM has not nor ever has been in the employ of the U.S. Government.

Am 2.8.60 meldete er sich im Grenzdurchgangslager Schalding bei Passau und bat um Notaufnahme in der Bundesrepublik.

Seinen Auführungen zufolge war er während des Krieges in Deutschland dienstverpflichtet. Bei seiner Rückkehr nach der CSR im Juni 1945 stellte er fest, daß seine Ehefrau und Tochter sich in den letzten Kriegstagen nach Westdeutschland abgesetzt hatten. Im Herbst 1945 ermittelte ULLMANN deren Aufenthalt in Erding bei München, konnte sie aber im April 1946 nicht zur Rückkehr in die Heimat bewegen, sumal die Frau Umgang mit Besatzungssoldaten am Flugplatz in Erding pflegte. Auf Betreiben der Ehefrau wurde im Jahre 1950 die Ehe geschieden. Erneute Verbindungsaufnahme zu seiner Ehefrau suchte ULLMANN in den Jahren 1954, 1956 und 1958. Anträge auf Ausstellung eines Besuchspasses zur Fahrt nach Erding wurden aber durch die tschechoslowakischen Behörden abschlägig beschieden. Nach erneuter Antragstellung im Frühjahr d. Js. wurde ULLMANN Anfang Mai 1960 zur SNB nach Troppau wegen Erledigung der Passformalitäten vorgeladen. Diese Dienststelle befindet sich in Troppau (Opava) in der Gottwald-Straße. Auf die Erklärung, er wolle in Erding bei München seine Tochter besuchen, erwiderte der SNB-Mann, er könne Erding sehr gut, da er im Jahre 1957 mit einem tschechosl. Flugzeug unfreiwillig dort gelandet sei. Der Pilot soll sttl von den Passagieren gezwungen worden sein, den Kurs des in der CSR gestarteten Flugzeuges zu ändern. Der SNB-Mann sei mit den meisten anderen Fluggästen nach 3wöchigen Aufenthalt in Deutschland wieder in die CSR zurückgekehrt.

Nach seiner Einreise am 21.7.60 begab sich ULLMANN sofort zu seinen Angehörigen nach Erding. Mit seiner Ehefrau will er übereingekommen sein, gemeinsam wieder zusammenleben zu wollen, weshalb er beabsichtigt, nicht mehr in die CSR zurückzukehren.

die oben-erwähnten Gründe zum Verbleiben im Bundesgebiet bewegen, zumal er mit seiner 17jährigen Tochter auch nach der Scheidung im Briefwechsel stand. Er bestritt, irgendwelche nachrichtendienstlichen Aufträge erhalten zu haben, doch dürfte die Möglichkeit gewisser Kontakte zum StB nicht von der Hand zu weisen sein.

Obengenannter wurde seinen Angaben zufolge am 1.6.60 durch tschechische Grenzorgane bei Hundsbach/Waldsassen aus der GDR über die grüne Grenze in die Bundesrepublik abgeschoben. Nach dem Grenzübertritt ging er zu Fuß über Hundsbach nach Waldsassen und fuhr von dort aus mit dem Autobus nach Selb und anschließend nach Schönwald zu seiner Familie, wo er gegen 23.00 Uhr angekommen sei.

Am 2.6.60 meldete er sich bei der Landpolizeistation Schönwald, da er bei dieser Dienststelle als Abgänger erfaßt war. Von dort aus wurde er einer weiteren polizeilichen Überprüfung in Neuhausen zugeführt.

Diese ergab, daß der Genannte am 15.4.60, gegen 15.00 Uhr, angeblich bei einem Spaziergang von Schönwald in Richtung Neuhausen in Unkenntnis der Grenzverhältnisse auf tschechisches Gebiet kam. Er will unterhalb der "Rauhen Schänke" die Staatsstraße Rehau - Neuhausen überquert und, seinen Weg im Hochwald fortsetzend, unbemerkt die Landesgrenze überschritten haben. Die Landesgrenze verläuft an dieser Stelle parallel mit dieser Straße bis kurz vor Neuhausen. An der Nordseite der Straße sind mehrere Schilder mit der Aufschrift "Landesgrenze" angebracht, die offenbar von HLADIK nicht gesehen werden konnten, als er im Hochwald seinen Weg fortsetzte. Plötzlich stieß er auf eine tschechische Grenzpostierung. Er wurde festgenommen, zunächst zur Militärunterkunft nach Schildern und anschließend mit einem Kraftwagen nach Eger transportiert. Vom Kreisgefängnis Eger wurde er am 16.4.60 nach Pilsen gebracht und bis zum 1.6.60 ohne gerichtliche Verurteilung inhaftiert, obwohl ihm eine Bestrafung wegen illegalen Grenzübertritts angedroht worden war.

Während der Haftzeit wurde er nicht zur Arbeit herangezogen und befand sich angeblich in Einzelhaft.

Am 1.6.60 fuhr er gegen 09.30 Uhr, von zwei Zivilisten begleitet, im Kraftwagen von Pilsen über Eger zur Grenze. Seine Abschiebung sollte offensichtlich unbemerkt vor sich gehen, denn bei der vorgesehenen Grenzübertrittsstelle befand sich auf bayer. Seite ein Grenzbeamter mit Diensthund, worauf die Tschechen (2 Zivilisten und ein Offizier, der kurz vor dem Stacheldrahtzaun in den Wagen zu-

stieg) von ihrem Vorhaben schließen und HLADIK ca. 4 km weiter in der Nähe von Hundsbach/Waldsassen über die Grenze nach Bayern schleusten.

HLADIK kam angeblich gegen 15.00 Uhr auf Bayer. Gebiet, begab sich zu Fuß über Hundsbach nach Waldsassen und fuhr von dort aus mit einem Lkw-Bus nach Selb. Den Weg nach Schönwald mußte er zu Fuß zurücklegen und ist gegen 23.00 Uhr in seiner Wohnung angekommen.

Gegen HLADIK wurde bei der Staatsanwaltschaft Hof/S. am 8.6.60 wegen Vergehens gegen das Paßgesetz Anzeige erstattet.

Im Hinblick auf die vorerwähnten Umstände schien HLADIK verdächtig, vom esl. Nachrichtendienst zur Mitarbeit verpflichtet worden zu sein, was er auf Vorhalt jedoch entschieden in Abrede stellte. Gegenteiliges konnte ihm nicht nachgewiesen werden.
