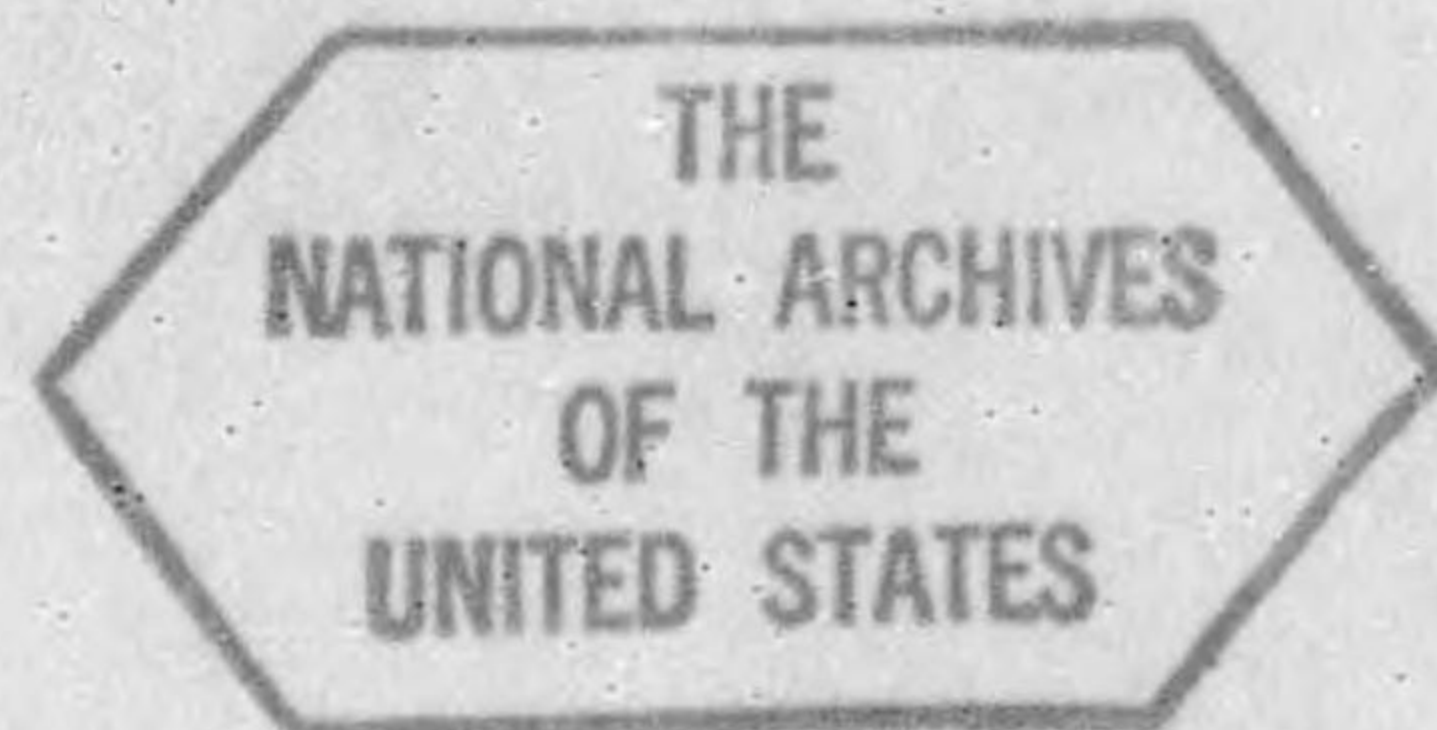

Expression "Eyes only" no longer authorized. SR being issued containing fol current instruction governing "Limited distribution" of messages:

1. "General. The originator of an exceptionally important message may prescribe limited distribution when the info should be disclosed only to the persons whom he names and no others.

2. "Limited distribution. Within the HQ of the originator and the addressee (s), copies of a limited distribution msg initially are furnished only to the persons named by the originator except that copies also may be furnished to the commander or the head of an agency in accordance with his instructions when a subordinate member of his staff is named to receive the msg. Conversely, communications personnel are not authorized to disclose the contents of a limited distribution msg to the "Addressee" when neither the commander nor a subordinate member of his staff has been designated by name to receive the msg. For example: It may be necessary to use a theater commander as the "Addressee" for a limited distribution msg intended only for the Chief of Staff, United States Army, other top level officials, or their representatives when they are present in an overseas theater.

3. "Replies. All limited distribution msgs in reply to such a msg are assigned exactly the same distribution as the msg being answered except that distribution may be further limited in accordance with specific instructions from competent authority.

4. "Additional distribution. The commander or staff officer responsible for the action on an incoming msg, as well as the originator, subsequently may prescribe such further distribution as may be appropriate and necessary.

5. "Personal for." When necessary, the words "Personal for" (followed by the surname (s)) may be used as the first element of the internal instructions. Any local distribution within the originators hq should be indicated by entering the surname (s) in the prescribed space on the messageform.

6. "Eyes only. This expression is no longer authorized.

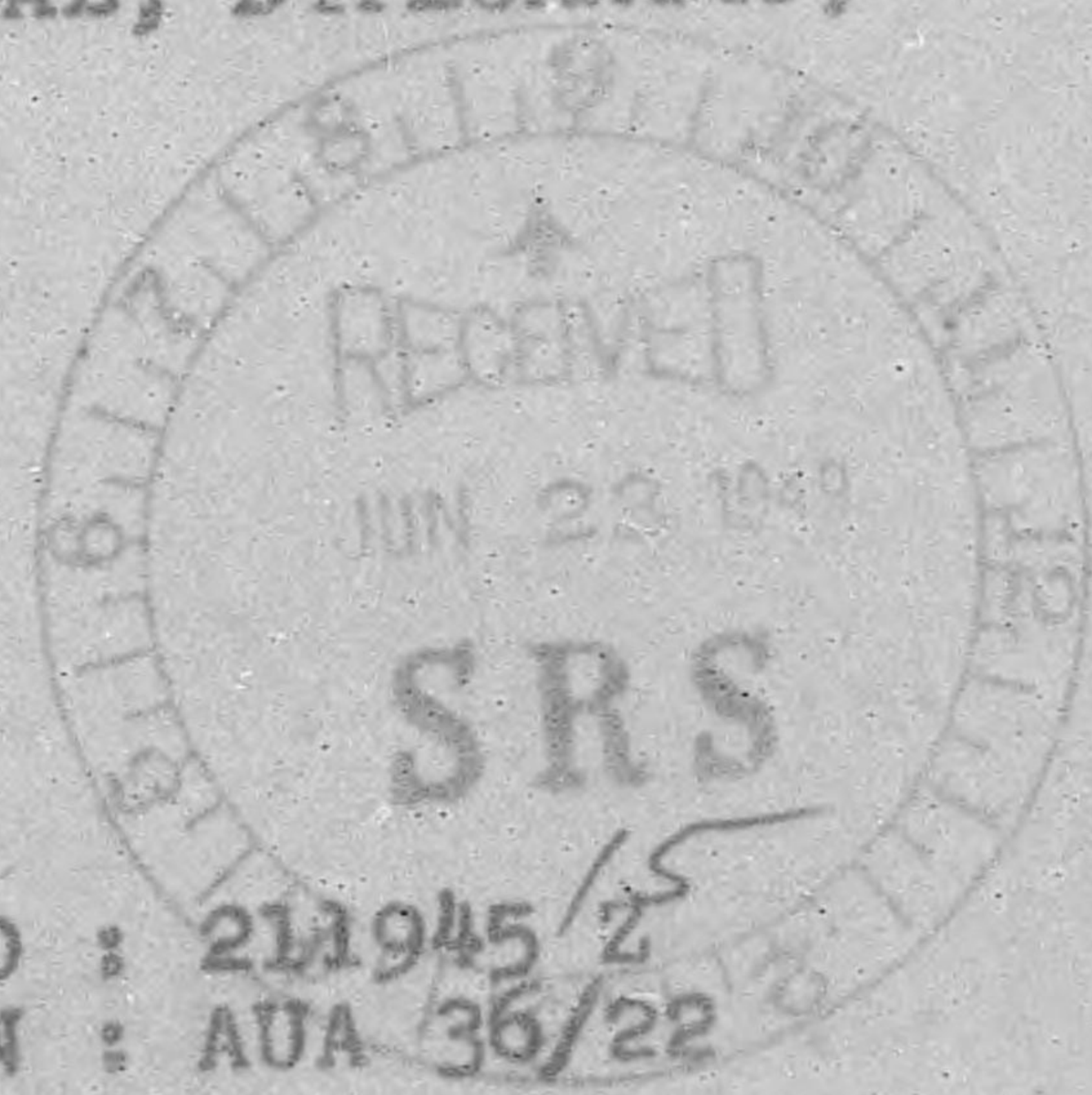
7. "Normal distribution. Limited distribution should not be prescribed when members of the staff of the addressee should received copies of the msg for info. coordination, or action, particularly when the msg pertains to operations or intelligence. When limited distribution is unnecessary, the word "for" followed by the office symbol (s) or surname (s) may be used when specific distribution to some agency (IES) or individual (I) is desired. The words "Personal From" followed by the surname of the commander may be used to indicate that he personally authorized transmission of the msg, or that he personally would have signed the communication if forwarded as a letter.



3. Justification fwded Army Comptroller for concurrence and return.
4. Sp representative app or disapproves program or makes recommendation to Sec Army as he finds appropriate. When program is app or disapproved Sp Representative notifies SCAP by official cable.
5. If program is app, SCAP, in name Boeki Cho, announces for; receives; negotiates, if nec; and accepts bids.
6. Meanwhile, Sp representative, or his Fis Control Officer, prepares and fwds for signature Sec Army's note to Sec of Treasury.
7. Sp representative, or his Fis Control Officer fwds signed Sec of Army note to Treasury thus establishing acct of fund.

14. US vendor deals direct with SCAP on any modifications of contract or ltr of credit.
