This publication is a continuation of "An Annotated List of Generic Names of the Scale Insects (Homoptera: Coccoidea)" by Harold Morrison and Emily R. Morrison and its Supplement, entitled "Additions and Corrections to an Annotated List of Generic Names of the Scale Insects (Homoptera: Coccoidea)" by Louise M. Russell (U.S. Dept. Agr. Misc. Pub. 1015, 1966 and 1970).

This second supplement contains 110 names proposed between January 1, 1964, the cutoff date of the previous lists, and December 31, 1972. In addition, it includes eight generic names from a 1962 article, which was not available to the authors of the previous lists, and two names published in 1973 as replacements for preoccupied 1967 names. Two of the 120 names are subgeneric and the remainder are generic. Misspellings that we have noted and nomina nuda are included.

The format is similar to that of the earlier publications. The entries are arranged alphabetically and each one is followed by its original, and a few by a second, validating citation. Typespecies are cited in their original name combinations. Relationships of genera and their assignments to higher groups of the Coccoidea are indicated by describers of the genera.

We extend our appreciation to the numerous coccidologists who have assisted us in obtaining much literature used in this publication and to Matilda P. Kosztarab for her technical assistance.

- Achionaspis Takagi, 1969, Insecta Matsumurana 32: 24, nomen nudum; 1970, Insecta Matsumurana 33: 33, 67.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Achionaspis kanoi Takagi, 1970, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, *Fiorinia* group of genera, close to *Pseudaulacaspis* MacGillivray.

- Adiscaspis Gómez-Menor Guerrero, 1967, Eos 43: 102, 108.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Diaspis (Adiscaspis) barrancorum* Lindinger, 1911, by original designation and monotypy.

The author proposed *Adiscaspis* as a subgenus of *Diaspis* Costa in the Diaspidinae.

- Afiorinia Takagi, 1969, Insecta Matsumurana 32: 24, nomen nudum; 1970, Insecta Matsumurana 33: 33, 118.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Afiorinia hirashimai Takagi, 1970, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, *Chionaspis* group of genera, close to *Fiorinia* Targioni Tozzetti.

Afrodrosicha Vayssière, 1968, Inst. Fondamental d'Afrique Noire Bul. Ser. A, Sci. Nat. 30: 1493, 1500.

TYPE-SPECIES: Afrodrosicha nimbae Vayssière, 1968, by monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Margarodidae and indicated that it has several characters in common with the "Drosochini."

- Albertinia De Lotto, 1970, Portici Lab. di Ent. Agr. "Filippo Silvestri" Bol. 28: 245-246.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Albertinia apiculata De Lotto, 1970, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and stated that its relationship to other genera was obscure.

Anastomoderma Beardsley, 1966, Bernice P. Bishop Mus. 6 (7): 507.

TYPE-SPECIES: Anastomoderma palauensis Beardsley, 1966, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidinae, Aspidiotini, allied to Aspidiotus Bouché.

Anopulvinaria J. P. da Fonseca, 1972, Sao Paulo Inst. Biol. Arq. 39: 195.

TYPE-SPECIES: Anopulvinaria cephalocarinata J. P. da Fonseca, 1972, by monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pulvinariini, close to Acanthopulvinaria Borchsenius.

Anthelococcus McKenzie, 1964, Hilgardia 35: 214-215.

TYPE-SPECIES: Anthelococcus simondsi McKenzie, 1964, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, near Trionymus Berg.

Arivonimaspis Mamet, 1962, Nat. Malgache 13: 192.

TYPE-SPECIES: Arivonimaspis vernoniae Mamet, 1962, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidinae, Diaspidini, close to *Hulaspis* Hall.

Buchnericoccus Reyne, 1965, Tijdschr. v. Ent. 108: 167, 173.

TYPE-SPECIES: Buchnericoccus javanus Reyne, 1965, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Margarodidae, Monophlebinae, Monophlebini, related to *Nietnera* Green.

Cajalecanium Gómez-Menor Ortega, 1965, Eos 41: 108.

TYPE-SPECIES: Cajalecanium salicorniae Gómez-Menor Ortega, 1965, by original designation and monotypy.

The author assigned this genus to the "Lecanidae," "Lecaninae," and he stated that it was near *Eulecanium* Cockerell.

Capricornaspis Balachowsky, 1971, Ent. Soc. France Bul. 76: 102, 104.

TYPE-SPECIES: Capricornaspis armineae Balachowsky, 1971, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspidinae, Aspidiotini, Aonidina, related to *Cryptoparlatoreopsis* Borchsenius.

Cerostegia De Lotto, 1969, Portici Lab. di Ent. Agr. "Filippo Silvestri" Bol. 27: 210-211.

TYPE-SPECIES: Ceroplastes rufus De Lotto, 1966, by original designation.

The author included this genus in the Coccidae, related to *Ceroplastes* Gray. He also included *Ceroplastes floridensis* Comstock and *C. japonicus* Green in it.

- Chimania Munting, 1970, Novos Taxa Ent. (Sup. Rev. Ent. de Moçambique) 84: 3-4.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Chimania ferrugina Munting, 1970, by original designation and monotypy.

The describer placed this genus in the Diaspididae and stated that it resembled *Tenuiaspis* MacGillivray.

- Chlorococcus Beardsley, 1971, Hawaii. Ent. Soc. Proc. 21 (1970): 50.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Chlorococcus longipes Beardsley, 1971, by original designation.

The author included this genus in the Pseudococcidae, close to *Tympanococcus* Williams. He also included four additional species in it.

Cirnecoccus Mamet, 1967, Mauritius Inst. Bul. 6: 98.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Pseudococcus pollicis* Mamet, 1940, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae.

- Clavaspidiotus Takagi and Kawai, 1966, Insecta Matsumurana 28: 115.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Clavaspidiotus abietis Takagi and Kawai, 1966, by original designation and monotypy.

The authors placed this genus in the Diaspididae, related to *Quadraspidiotus* MacGillivray and *Clavaspis* MacGillivray. They stated, "Aspidiotus tayabanus Cockerell and *Quadraspidiotus cryptus* Ferris may be referable to the new genus."

Collubia Munting, 1968, Ent. Soc. South. Africa Jour. 31: 209.

TYPE-SPECIES: Collubia dentata Munting, 1968, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, and he indicated that it came closest to *Moraspis* Hall.

- Conicosoma De Lotto, 1970, Portici Lab. di Ent. Agr. "Filippo Silvestri" Bol. 28: 248.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Conicosoma gracile De Lotto, 1970, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, related to *Strandanna* De Lotto.

Crassaspidiotus Takagi, 1969, Insecta Matsumurana 32: 22, 89.

TYPE-SPECIES: Crassaspidiotus takahashii Takagi, 1969, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Aspidiotini, close to *Metaspidiotus* Takagi.

- Cyperia De Lotto, 1964, Brit. Mus. (Nat. Hist.) Ent. Bul. 14: 348-349.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Pseudococcus percrassus* De Lotto, 1961, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, related to *Planococcoides* Ezzat and McConnell.

Densispina Ter-Grigorian, 1964, Ent. Obozr. 43: 861. (Transl., Ent. Rev. 43: 440.)

TYPE-SPECIES: *Densispina graminea* Ter-Grigorian, 1964, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, close to *Trabutina* Marchal.

Diaspiditis J. P. da Fonseca, 1969, Sao Paulo Inst. Biol. Arq. 36: 31.

A lapsus for *Diaspidistis* Hempel.

Diplacaspis Jacobson of Mann, 1969, U.S. Natl. Mus. Bul. 256: 150.

The name *Diplacaspis* Jacobson (1924, Rev. Russe d'Ent. 18: 239), representing a genus of the Coleoptera, was interjected into Coccoidea literature by Mann, who published the new combination "*Diplacaspis echinocacti* (Bouche)." *Diplacaspis* Jacobson of Mann presumably was a lapsus for *Diaspis* Costa.

According to Neave (1939, Nomencl. Zool. 2: 105), Jacobson proposed *Diplacaspis* as a new name for *Diaspis* Lacordaire, 1848, the latter being preoccupied by *Diaspis* Costa, 1828, in the Hemiptera.

- Diversicrus De Lotto, 1970, Portici Lab. di Ent. Agr. "Filippo Silvestri" Bol. 28: 250.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Diversicrus longulum* De Lotto, 1970, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae.

Eastia De Lotto, 1964, Brit. Mus. (Nat. Hist.) Ent. Bul. 14: 350.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Eastia jouberti* De Lotto, 1964, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, related to Puto Signoret.

Electrococcus Beardsley, 1969, Psyche 76: 271-273, 278.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Electrococcus canadensis* Beardsley, 1969, by original designation and monotypy.

The author stated that this fossil genus, described from a single male, probably is a specialized type of Margarodidae, possibly related to modern Pityococcinae.

- Endernia Danzig, 1971, Akad. Nauk. S.S.S.R. Zool. Inst. 50: 1414.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Endernia despoliata Danzig, 1971, by original designation and monotypy.

The describer assigned this genus to the Asterolecaniidae and suggested close relationship with *Asterodiaspis* Signoret.

- Epifiorinia Takagi, 1969, Insecta Matsumurana 32: 24, nomen nudum; 1970, Insecta Matsumurana 33: 33, 52-53.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Epifiorinia tsugae* Takagi, 1970, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, *Diaspis* group of genera, close to *Fiorinia* Targioni Tozzetti.

Erimococcus Ezzat, 1966, Soc. Ent. d'Egypte Bul. 49 (1965): 169-170.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Phenacoccus limoniastri* Priesner and Hosny, 1935, by original designation and monotypy.

The describer placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae.

- Eriocorys De Lotto, 1967, Repub. So. Africa Dept. Agr. Tech. Serv. Ent. Mem. 12: 1-2.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Eriocorys hystrix De Lotto, 1967, by original designation and monotypy.

The author included this genus in the Pseudococcidae and suggested relationship with the *Phenacoccus* group, particularly with *Centrococcus* Borchsenius and *Rastrococcus* Ferris.

Eucleaspis Munting, 1968, Ent. Soc. South. Africa Jour. 31: 423.

TYPE-SPECIES: Eucleaspis echinata Munting, 1968, by original designation.

The describer placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, with affinities to *Mancaspis* Ferris, *Situlaspis* MacGillivray, and *Protodiaspis* Cockerell. He also included *Chionaspis imbricata* Brain.

Eumashona Hodgson, 1973, Ent. Monthly Mag. 109: 63.

TYPE-SPECIES: Mashona tachardia Hodgson, 1967, by substitution of Eumashona for Mashona Hodgson.

A new name replacing Mashona Hodgson, 1967, preoccupied by Mashona Pate, 1944.

- Eumirococcus Ter-Grigorian, 1964, Ent. Obozr. 43: 858. (Transl., Ent. Rev. 43: 439.)
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Eumirococcus borchsenii* Ter-Grigorian, 1964, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, close to *Mirococcus* Borchsenius.

Faureaspis Munting, 1968, Ent. Soc. South. Africa Jour. 31: 425-427.

TYPE-SPECIES: Gymnaspis faurei Brain, 1919, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, with affinities to *Paraleucaspis* Mamet.

Ferrisidea Borchsenius, 1965, Ent. Obozr. 44: 368. (Transl., Ent. Rev. 44: 211.)

TYPE-SPECIES: Aspidiotus (Pseudodiaspis) dentilobis Cockerell, 1898, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, and in his new subtribe Howardiina.

- Gallacoccus Beardsley, 1971, Hawaii. Ent. Soc. Proc. 21 (1970): 31-32.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Gallacoccus anthonyae Beardsley, 1971, by original designation.

The proposer incorporated this genus in the Eriococcidae, close to *Reynvaania* Reyne, and also included in it *Gallacoccus secundus* Beardsley, 1971.

- Gallulacoccus Beardsley, 1971, Hawaii. Ent. Soc. Proc. 21 (1970): 47.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Gallulacoccus tenorioi Beardsley, 1971, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and indicated possible relationship to *Pseudotrionymus* Beardsley.

Gigantococcus Pesson and Bielenin, 1966, Soc. Ent. de France Ann. (n.s.) 2: 219, 246-248.

TYPE-SPECIES: Icerya maxima Newstead, 1914, by monotypy.

The authors assigned this genus to the "Margaroidae," and they stated that it was in part intermediate between *Steatococcus* Ferris and *Crypticerya* Cockerell.

Gossypina Salazar, 1972, Rev. Peruana Ent. 15: 293-295.

TYPE-SPECIES: Gossypina glauca Salazar, 1972, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and stated that it resembled *Palaucoccus* Beardsley.

Habibius Ezzat and Hussein, 1969, Soc. Ent. d'Egypte Bul. 51 (1967): 360-361, 402.

TYPE-SPECIES: Lecanium acuminatum Signoret, 1873, by original designation and monotypy.

The authors proposed *Habibius* as a new name to replace *Platycoccus* Takahashi, 1959, which was preoccupied by *Platycoccus* Stickney, 1934, in the Phoenicococcidae. De Lotto (1965, Brit. Mus. (Nat. Hist.) Ent. Bul. 16: 206, 208), however, had previously proposed *Kilifia* as a replacement for *Platycoccus* Takahashi. *Habibius* therefore becomes a junior synonym of *Kilifia*.

Heimaspis Balachowsky and Ferrero, 1967, Cahiers de la Maboké 5: 37-39.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Heimaspis centrafricanus* Balachowsky and Ferrero, 1967, by original designation and monotypy.

The authors placed this genus in the Diaspidini, Chionaspidina. They indicated similarities with *Tecaspis* Hall, *Phenacaspis* Cooley and Cockerell (s. str.), *Rolaspis* Hall, and *Voraspis* Hall.

Heteromargarodes Jakubski, 1965, A Critical Revision of the Families Margarodidae and Termitococcidae (Hemiptera, Coccoidea), p. 85-88.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Heteromargarodes americanus* Jakubski, 1965, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Margarodidae, Margarodinae, Dimargarodini, close to *Dimargarodes* Silvestri.

Ichthyaspis Takagi, 1969, Insecta Matsumurana 32: 24, nomen nudum; 1970, Insecta Matsumurana 33: 120.

TYPE-SPECIES: Adiscofiorinia ficicola Takahashi, 1931, by original designation and monotypy.

The describer placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, *Chionaspis* group of genera, close to *Adiscofiorinia* Leonardi.

Indococcus Ali, 1967, Oriental Insects 1: 35.

TYPE-SPECIES: Indococcus pipalae Ali, 1967, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, close to *Planococcus* Ferris and *Anaparaputo* Borchsenius.

Inopicoccus Danzig, 1971, Ent. Obozr. 50: 369-371. (Transl., Ent. Rev. 50: 208.)

TYPE-SPECIES: Inopicoccus setariae Danzig, 1971, by original designation and monotypy.

The describer included this genus in the Pseudococcidae, close to *Neotriony*mus Borchsenius and *Metadenopus* Sulc. Japaspidiotus Takagi and Kawai, 1966, Insecta Matsumurana 28: 118.

TYPE-SPECIES: Japaspidiotus cedricola Takagi and Kawai, 1966, by original designation and monotypy.

The authors placed this genus in the Diaspididae, close to Acanthaspidiotus Borchsenius and Williams. They noted that J. cedricola might be identical with Aspidiotus corticispini Lindinger, 1909, but they could not certify this identity.

- Kilifia De Lotto, 1965, Brit. Mus. (Nat. Hist.) Ent. Bul. 16: 206, 208.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Lecanium acuminatum Signoret, 1873, by original designation.

The author proposed this new name in the Coccidae as replacement for *Platycoccus* Takahashi, 1959, since the latter was preoccupied by *Platycoccus* Stickney, 1934. He also included *Kilifia deltoides* De Lotto, 1965, and *Coccus diversipes* Cockerell in *Kilifia*.

Lecaniococcus Danzig, 1967, Akad. Nauk S.S.S.R. Zool. Inst. Trudy 41: 148-149.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Lecaniococcus ditispinosus* Danzig, 1967, by original designation and monotypy.

The describer included this genus in the Coccidae, close to *Eulecanium* Cockerell and *Parthenolecanium* Sulc.

- Lenania De Lotto, 1964, Brit. Mus. (Nat. Hist.) Ent. Bul. 14: 353.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Lenania prisca De Lotto, 1964, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and suggested relationship with *Mirococcus* Borchsenius and *Mollicoccus* Williams.

- Londiania De Lotto, 1964, Brit. Mus. (Nat. Hist.) Ent. Bul. 14: 354.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Londiania obesa De Lotto, 1964, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and suggested relationship with *Trionymus* Berg and *Cryptoripersia* Cockerell. Macropulvinaria Hodgson, 1968, Ent. Soc. South. Africa Jour. 31: 155.

TYPE-SPECIES: Pulvinaria jacksoni Newstead, 1908, by original designation.

The author placed this genus in the Coccidae and included in it a total of five species.

Madagasia Mamet, 1962, Nat. Malgache 13: 167.

TYPE-SPECIES: Madagasia ankaratrae Mamet, 1962, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae.

Madaparlaspis Mamet, 1962, Nat. Malgache 13: 194.

TYPE-SPECIES: Madaparlaspis bosseri Mamet, 1962, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidinae, Diaspidini, related to *Parlatoria* Targioni Tozzetti.

Magnospinus Munting, 1970, Novos Taxa Ent. (Sup. Rev. Ent. de Moçambique) 84: 6.

The author placed this genus in the Chionaspidini but could not suggest a nearest relative.

Mahafalyaspis Balachowsky, 1971, Soc. Ent. de France Bul. 76: 221, 223.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Mahafalyaspis teteforti* Balachowsky, 1971, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspidini-Rugaspidiotina, near Discodiaspis Koroneos.

Mammata Munting, 1969, Cimbebasia 1, Ser. A: 128.

TYPE-SPECIES: Mammata lueckorum Munting, 1969, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Chionaspidini, Augulaspidina, very similar to *Tecaspis* Hall.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Magnospinus anneckei* Munting, 1970, by original designation and monotypy.

Maniaspis Borchsenius, 1964, Ent. Obozr. 43: 864, 869-872. (Transl., Ent. Rev. 43: 443.)

TYPE-SPECIES: Maniaspis manii Borchsenius, 1964, by original designation.

The describer placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Leucaspidini, related to *Anamaspis* Leonardi and *Lopholeucaspis* Balachowsky. He also transferred *Leucaspis gigas* (Maskell) to his new genus.

- Marendeliea De Lotto, 1967, Repub. So. Africa Dept. Agr. Tech. Serv. Ent. Mem. 12: 10.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Pseudococcus rhodesiensis* Hall, 1937, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and suggested relationship with genera of grass-infesting mealybugs, centering on *Trionymus* Berg, and in one feature with *Peliococcus* Borchsenius.

Mashona Hodgson, 1967, Arnoldia (Rhodesia) 3 (5): 8-9.

TYPE-SPECIES: Mashona tachardia Hodgson, 1967, by original designation.

The author placed this genus in the Coccidae and also included *Coccus* msasae (Hall) in it. The name was preoccupied by Mashona Pate, 1944, in the Hymenoptera and was replaced by *Eumashona* Hodgson.

Mauricoccus Mamet, 1967, Mauritius Inst. Bul. 6: 100-102.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Ripersia pileae* Mamet, 1940, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae.

- Megacoccus Kosztarab and Kennedy, 1971, Ent. Soc. Amer. Ann. 64: 343-346.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Megacoccus tasmaniensis* Kosztarab and Kennedy, 1971, by original designation and monotypy.

The authors included this genus in the Eriococcidae but stated, "future studies on related genera and on the limits of coccid families should provide further evidence for the final placement of the genus."

Mesoselenaspidus J. P. da Fonseca, 1969, Sao Paulo Inst. Biol. Arg. 36: 16.

TYPE-SPECIES: Mesoselenaspidus andersoni J. P. da Fonseca, 1969, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Selenaspidina.

Messinea De Lotto, 1966, Linn. Soc. London, Proc. 77: 147.

TYPE-SPECIES: Messinea conica De Lotto, 1966, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Coccidae.

- Metadenopsis Matesova, 1966, Vest. Selsk. Khoz. Nauk. (Alma Ata) 9 (4): 98.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Metadenopsis halogetonis* Matesova, 1966, by original designation and monotypy.

The author included this genus in the Pseudococcidae.

Mombasinia De Lotto, 1964, Brit. Mus. (Nat. Hist.) Ent. Bul. 14: 356.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Pseudococcus pulcherrimus* De Lotto, 1961, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and suggested relationship with *Puto* Signoret.

Multispinaspis Munting, 1969, Cimbebasia 1, Ser. A: 131.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Multispinaspis monechmae* Munting, 1969, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, Howardiina.

Nairobia De Lotto, 1964, Brit. Mus. (Nat. Hist.) Ent. Bul. 14: 356-357.

TYPE-SPECIES: Nairobia bifrons De Lotto, 1964, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, related to *Phenacoccus* Cockerell.

Namaquea Munting, 1969, Cimbebasia 1, Ser. A: 132.

TYPE-SPECIES: Namaquea simplex Munting, 1969, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Leucaspidini, resembling Anotaspis Ferris.

Namibia Munting, 1969, Cimbebasia 1, Ser. A: 133.

TYPE-SPECIES: Formosaspis karroo Munting, 1967, by original designation.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, with some affinities to *Formosaspis* Takahashi. Two additional species, *Namibia quadriloba* Munting, 1969, and *N. spinosa* Munting, 1969, were also included.

Neoischnaspis J. P. da Fonseca, 1969, Sao Paulo Inst. Biol. Arq. 36: 18.

TYPE-SPECIES: Neoischnaspis orthosoma J. P. da Fonseca, 1969, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, related to *Ischnaspis* Douglas and *Fulaspis* Balachowsky.

Nesopedronia Beardsley, 1971, Hawaii. Ent. Soc. Proc. 21 (1970): 41-44.

TYPE-SPECIES: Pedronia hawaiiensis Ferris, 1948, by original designation.

The describer placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, resembling *Pedronia* Green. He included five species in the new genus, all transferred from *Pedronia*.

- **Ohiacoccus** Beardsley, 1971, Hawaii. Ent. Soc. Proc. 21 (1970): 44-45.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Ohiacoccus cryptus Beardsley, 1971, by original designation and monotypy.

The proposer incorporated this genus in the Pseudococcidae, closest to *Nesopedronia* Beardsley.

- Orococcus De Lotto, 1964, Brit. Mus. (Nat. Hist.) Ent. Bul. 14: 357.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Pseudococcus cryophilus* De Lotto, 1961, by original designation and monotypy.

The describer placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, suggesting some relationship with genera of the *Trionymus* series.

Orstomicoccus Mamet, 1962, Nat. Malgache 13: 154.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Pseudococcus ankaratrae* Mamet, 1951, by original designation.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and noted relationship to Planococcini. He also included Orstomicoccus madecassus Mamet, 1962, in it.

Oxyacanthus De Lotto, 1970, Portici Lab. di Ent. Agr. "Filippo Silvestri" Bol. 28: 252-253.

TYPE-SPECIES: Oxyacanthus incohatus De Lotto, 1970, by original designation.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, with relationship to *Phenacoccus* Cockerell. In addition to the type-species he included in it *Spinococcus captiosus* De Lotto and *Tylococcus chrysocomae* Brain.

Palauaspis Beardsley, 1966, Bernice P. Bishop Mus. 6 (7): 548.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Palauaspis multiductus* Beardsley, 1966, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidinae, Diaspidini, allied to the *Lepidosaphes* group of genera (subtribe Lepidosaphedina of Balachowsky, 1954), particularly *Coccomytilus* Leonardi.

Palaucoccus Beardsley, 1966, Bernice P. Bishop Mus. 6 (7): 421.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Palaucoccus gressitti* Beardsley, 1966, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and indicated that its affinities with other genera were unclear.

Pandanaspis Mamet, 1967, Mauritius Inst. Bul. 6: 92.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Mytilaspis greeni* de Grandpré and de Charmoy, 1899, by original designation and monotypy.

The author assigned this genus to the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, *Lepidosaphes* group of genera, somewhat allied to *Opuntiaspis* Cockerell.

Pandanicola Beardsley, 1966, Bernice P. Bishop Mus. 6 (7): 427-428.

TYPE-SPECIES: Trionymus pandani Takahashi, 1939, by original designation.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and also included *Pseudococcus esakii* Takahashi in it.

Parandaspis Mamet, 1967, Mauritius Inst. Bul. 6: 89.

TYPE-SPECIES: Lepidosaphes vinsoni Mamet, 1940, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, *Lepidosaphes* group of genera, with close relationship to *Andaspis* MacGillivray and possibly to *Caia* Williams.

- Parandaspis Balachowsky, 1968, Rev. de Zool. et de Bot. Africaines 78: 53, 55, 61.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Parandaspis castelbrancoi* Balachowsky, 1968, by original designation and monotypy.

The author included this genus in the Diaspididae, Lepidosaphedini, new subtribe Andaspidina, related to Andaspis Maskell, Caia Williams, and Metandaspis Williams. The name is a junior homonym of Parandaspis Mamet, 1967. Its replacement name is Saotomaspis Balachowsky, 1973, Ent. Soc. France Bul. 78: 225.

Parapaludicoccus Mamet, 1962, Nat. Malgache 13: 179-180.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Parapaludicoccus isaloensis* Mamet, 1962, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, close to *Paludicoccus* Ferris.

Parapandanaspis Mamet, 1967, Mauritius Inst. Bul. 6: 95.

TYPE-SPECIES: Parapandanaspis reunioniensis Mamet, 1967, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, *Lepidosaphes* group of genera, very close to *Pandanaspis* Mamet.

- Parapudaspis Borchsenius, 1964, Ent. Obozr. 43: 152, 167. (Transl., Ent. Rev. 43: 77-79.)
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Parapulvinaria cassariae* J. P. da Fonseca, 1969, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, close to Pudaspis Hall.

- Parapulvinaria J. P. da Fonseca, 1969, Sao Paulo Inst. Biol. Arg. 36: 9.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Parapulvinaria cassariae* J. P. da Fonseca, 1969, original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the "Lecanidae" and indicated relationship to *Pulvinaria* Targioni Tozzetti and *Ceronema* Maskell.

- Pararaoaspis Borchsenius, 1967, Ent. Obozr. 46: 724, 730. (Transl., Ent. Rev. 46: 429, 432.)
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Lepidosaphes meliae Green, 1919, by original designation and monotypy.

The author included this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, close to Andaspis MacGillivray.

Pararhodania Ter-Grigorian, 1964, Ent. Obozr. 43: 860-861. (Transl., Ent. Rev. 43: 439-440.)

TYPE-SPECIES: Pararhodania armena Ter-Grigorian, 1964, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, close to Rhodania Goux.

Parastictococcus Richard, 1971, Soc. Ent. de France Ann. (n.s.) 7: 583, 585–587.

The author proposed *Parastictococcus* as a subgenus of *Stictococcus* Cockerell in the Stictococcinae and transferred six species from the nominate subgenus to her new subgenus.

Penthococcus Danzig, 1972, Insects of Mongolia 1: 327-329.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Penthococcus nartshukae* Danzig, 1972, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, close to *Neotrionymus* Borchsenius.

Phacelococcus Miller, 1970, Austral. Ent. Soc. Jour. 9: 157.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Phacelococcus brookesae* Miller, 1970, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Eriococcidae, with superficial resemblance to *Ovaticoccus* Kloet.

Pleistocerarius Matile-Ferrero, 1970, So. African Animal Life 14: 179–182.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Pleistocerarius capensis* Matile-Ferrero, 1970, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, Planococcini, close to *Planococcoides* Ezzat and McConnell.

Prorhizoecus Miller and McKenzie, 1971, Hilgardia 40: 583.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Prorhizoecus atopoporus* Miller and McKenzie, 1971, by original designation and monotypy.

The authors placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, with some relationship to *Rhizoecus* Künckel d'Herculais and *Pygmaeococcus* McKenzie.

- Pseudotrionymus Beardsley, 1971, Hawaii. Ent. Soc. Proc. 21 (1970): 44.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Trionymus multiductus Beardsley, 1959, by original designation.

The describer placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, near *Trionymus* Berg, and also included in it *Trionymus refertus* Ferris.

Pstudotargionia Munting, 1969, Cimbebasia 1, Ser. A: 159.

Lapsus for Pseudotargionia Lindinger.

Raoaspis Borchsenius, 1967, Ent. Obozr. 46: 724-725, 729. (Transl., Ent. Rev. 46: 429-430.)

TYPE-SPECIES: Andaspis mori Ferris, 1952, by original designation.

The author included this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, close to Caia Williams. He assigned a total of six species to it.

Reclavaspis Komosinska, 1965, Frustula Ent. 8 (2): 1.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Reclavaspis australicus* Komosinska, 1965, by original designation.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Aspidiotini, close to *Diaspidiotus* Leonardi. She also included *Reclavaspis evexus* (Brimblecombe) in the genus.

Relhaniaspis Munting, 1970, Novos Taxa Ent. (Sup. Rev. Ent. de Moçambique) 84: 10.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Relhaniaspis acuminata* Munting, 1970, by original designation and monotypy.

The describer included this genus in the Diaspididae, Chionaspidini, and Sclopetaspidina of Borchsenius, with some resemblance to *Phaulomytilus* Leonardi and *Moraspis* Hall.

- **Roonwalaspis** Borchsenius, 1967, Ent. Obozr. 46: 724, 734. (Transl., Ent. Rev. 46: 429, 432-433.)
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Roonwalaspis quercicola Borchsenius, 1967, by original designation.

The describer included this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, related to *Raoaspis* Borchsenius. He transferred *Andaspis retrusa* (Green) to the new genus.

- Rosebankia De Lotto, 1967, Repub. So. Africa Dept. Agr. Tech. Serv. Ent. Mem. 12: 18-19.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: *Pseudococcus caffra* Brain, 1915, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and suggested relationship with *Misericoccus* Ferris.

Sangicoccus Reyne, 1965, Ent. Ber. 25: 180.

The author proposed *Sangicoccus* as a new name to replace *Haematococcus* Reyne, 1961, which was preoccupied in the Protozoa.

- Saotomaspis Balachowsky, 1973, Soc. Ent. de France Bul. 78: 225.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Parandaspis castelbrancoi Balachowsky, 1968, by substitution of Saotomaspis for Parandaspis Balachowsky.

The author proposed *Saotomaspis* as a new name to replace *Parandaspis* Balachowsky, 1968, which was preoccupied by *Parandaspis* Mamet, 1967.

Scaptococcus McKenzie, 1964, Hilgardia 35: 267.

TYPE-SPECIES: Scaptococcus californicus McKenzie, 1964, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, somewhat related to Amonostherium Morrison and Morrison.

Selenaspudus Mamet, 1962, Nat. Malgache 13: 157; Mamet, 1967, Mauritius Inst. Bul. 6: 61.

A lapsus for Selenaspidus in 1962 but corrected in 1967.

Smilacicola Takagi, 1969, Insecta Matsumurana 32: 22, 55.

TYPE-SPECIES: Smilacicola apicalis Takagi, 1969, by original designation.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Rugaspidiotini, and included, in addition to the type-species, *Rugaspidiotus heimi* Balachowsky and an unnamed species.

- Sphaeroceraspis Balachowsky and Ferrero, 1965, Soc. Ent. de France Ann. (n.s.) 1: 995–996.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Sphaeroceraspis saccasi Balachowsky and Ferrero, 1965, by original designation and monotypy.

The authors assigned this genus to the Diaspidini, with certain affinities to "Protodiaspis Ferris," an error for Protodiaspis Cockerell.

Spiroporococcus Miller, 1967, Hilgardia 38: 481, 528-529.

TYPE-SPECIES: Fonscolombia yuccae Ferris, 1919, by original designation.

The author included this genus in the Eriococcidae, close to *Ovaticoccus* Kloet. He also assigned to it *Ovaticoccus braggi* (Cockerell and Robinson) and *O. ruber* (Parrott and Cockerell).

- Strandanna De Lotto, 1969, Repub. So. Africa Dept. Agr. Tech. Serv. Ent. Mem. 20: 27.
 - TYPE-SPECIES: Strandanna pristina De Lotto, 1969, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae, with affinities to *Trionymus* Berg and *Cryptoripersia* Cockerell.

Taiwanaspidiotus Takagi, 1969, Insecta Matsumurana 32: 22, 72.

TYPE-SPECIES: Aspidiotus shakunagi Takahashi, 1935, by original designation.

The describer placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Aspidiotini, close to Aspidiotus Bouché and also included Taiwanaspidiotus yiei Takagi, 1969.

Takahashiella Borchsenius, 1964, Ent. Obozr. 43: 164, 168. (Transl., Ent. Rev. 43: 81-82.)

TYPE-SPECIES: Chionaspis vermiformis Takahashi, 1930, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Lepidosaphidini. He stated that in one respect the scale resembled *Xiphuraspis* Borchsenius and Williams, a member of the Diaspidini.

Tanaparlatoria Mamet, 1962, Nat. Malgache 13: 195-197.

TYPE-SPECIES: Tanaparlatoria erythroxyloni Mamet, 1962, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidinae, Diaspidini, related to *Parlatoria* Targioni Tozzetti.

Telocorys De Lotto, 1967, Repub. So. Africa Dept. Agr. Tech. Serv. Ent. Mem. 12: 21.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Ripersia longisetosa* Green, 1924, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and suggested some resemblance to *Anthelococcus* McKenzie.

Tomentocera Beardsley, 1964, Hawaii. Ent. Soc. Proc. 18 (1963): 365.

TYPE-SPECIES: Tomentocera haleakala Beardsley, 1964, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and suggested affinities to *Nesococcus* Ehrhorn and *Pedronia* Green.

Tsimbazaspis Mamet, 1962, Nat. Malgache 13: 199-200.

TYPE-SPECIES: Tsimbazaspis euphorbiae Mamet, 1962, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidinae, Diaspidini, related to MacGillivray's Africaspis, Angulaspis, and Inchoaspis.

Turbinococcus Beardsley, 1966, Bernice P. Bishop Mus. 6 (7): 477–479.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Trionymus pandanicola* Takahashi, 1941, by original designation and monotypy.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae with affinities to *Trionymus* Berg.

Tympanococcus Williams, 1967, Biol. Soc. Wash. Proc. 80: 27-29.

TYPE-SPECIES: *Pseudococcus tympanistus* Ferris, 1948, by original designation.

The author included this genus in the Pseudococcidae and indicated relationship with *Dysmicoccus* Ferris and *Trionymus* Berg. He also assigned to it *Trionymus gardeniae* Williams, 1967.

Umwinsia Hodgson, 1968, Roy. Ent. Soc., London, Proc. Ser. B: Taxonomy 37: 118.

TYPE-SPECIES: Umwinsia cavernosa Hodgson, 1968, by original designation.

The author placed this genus in the Coccidae and also included Akermes nitidulus De Lotto in it.

Vryburgia De Lotto, 1967, Repub. So. Africa Dept. Agr. Tech. Serv. Ent. Mem. 12: 21-22.

TYPE-SPECIES: Pseudococcus bechuanae Brain, 1915, by original designation.

The author placed this genus in the Pseudococcidae and indicated close relationship to *Chorizococcus* McKenzie. He included seven species in the genus.

Waxiella De Lotto, 1971, Nat. Hist. Jour. 5: 148.

TYPE-SPECIES: Ceroplastes subdenudatus Newstead, 1917, by original designation.

The author placed this genus in the Coccidae. He assigned 13 species or subspecies previously included in *Ceroplastes* Gray to the genus.

Yomaspis Munting, 1968, Ent. Soc. South. Africa Jour. 31: 431.

TYPE-SPECIES: Yomaspis ventropora Munting, 1968, by original designation and monotypy.

The describer placed this genus in the Diaspididae, Diaspidini, with some resemblance to Salaspis Hall.
