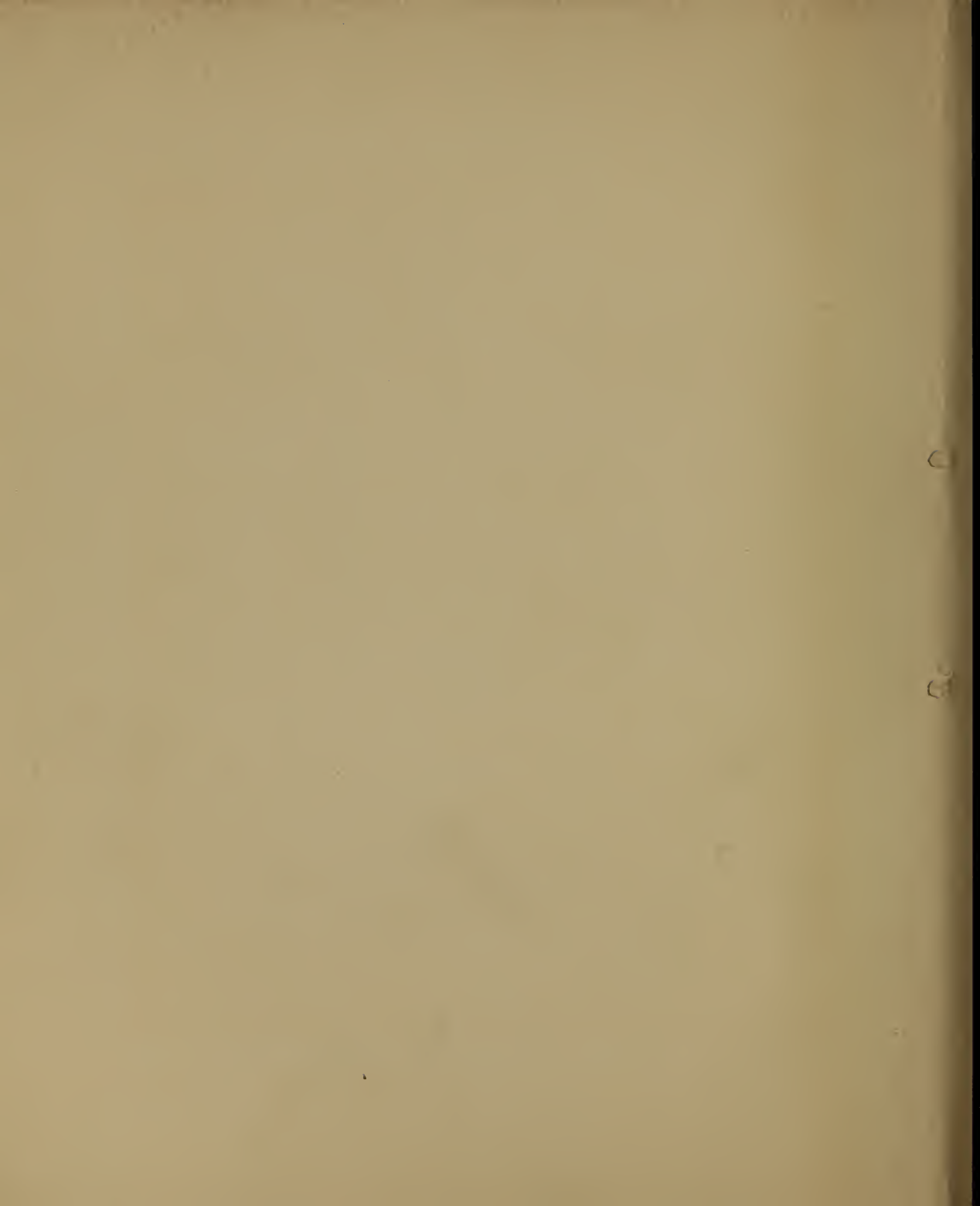

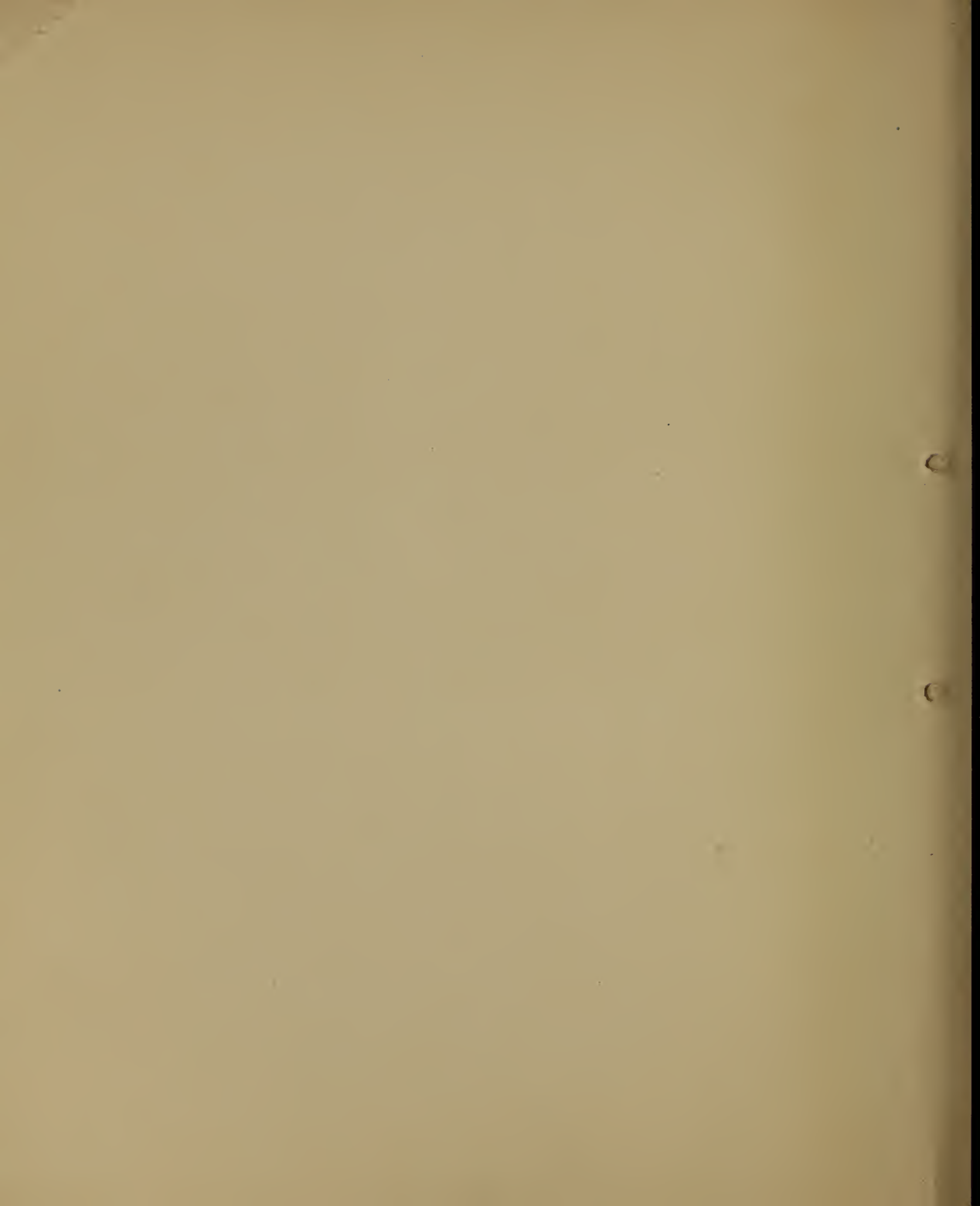

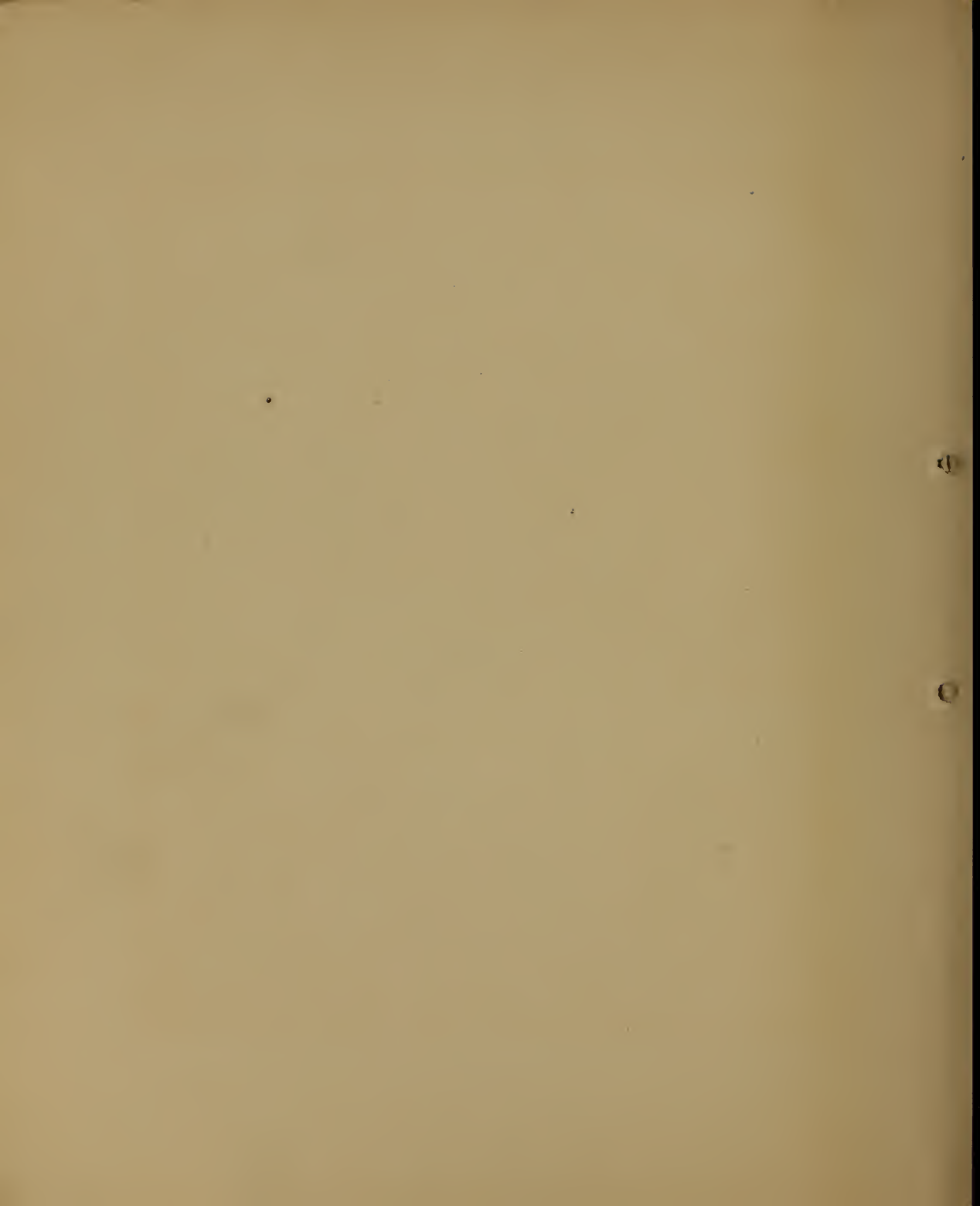


Hark! hark, my soul! Angelic songs are swelling

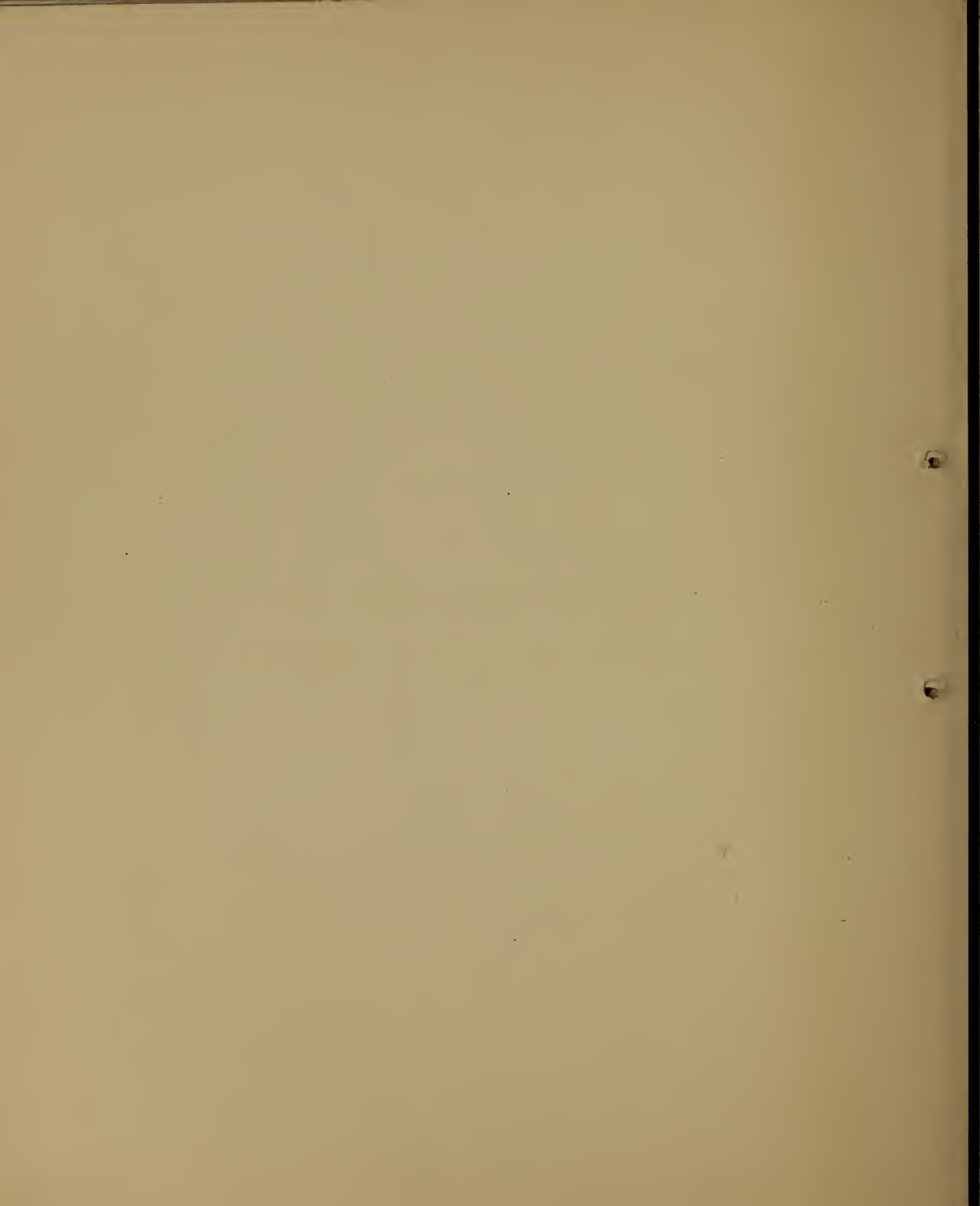
Far, far away, like bells at evening pealing,

The pilgrims of the night.

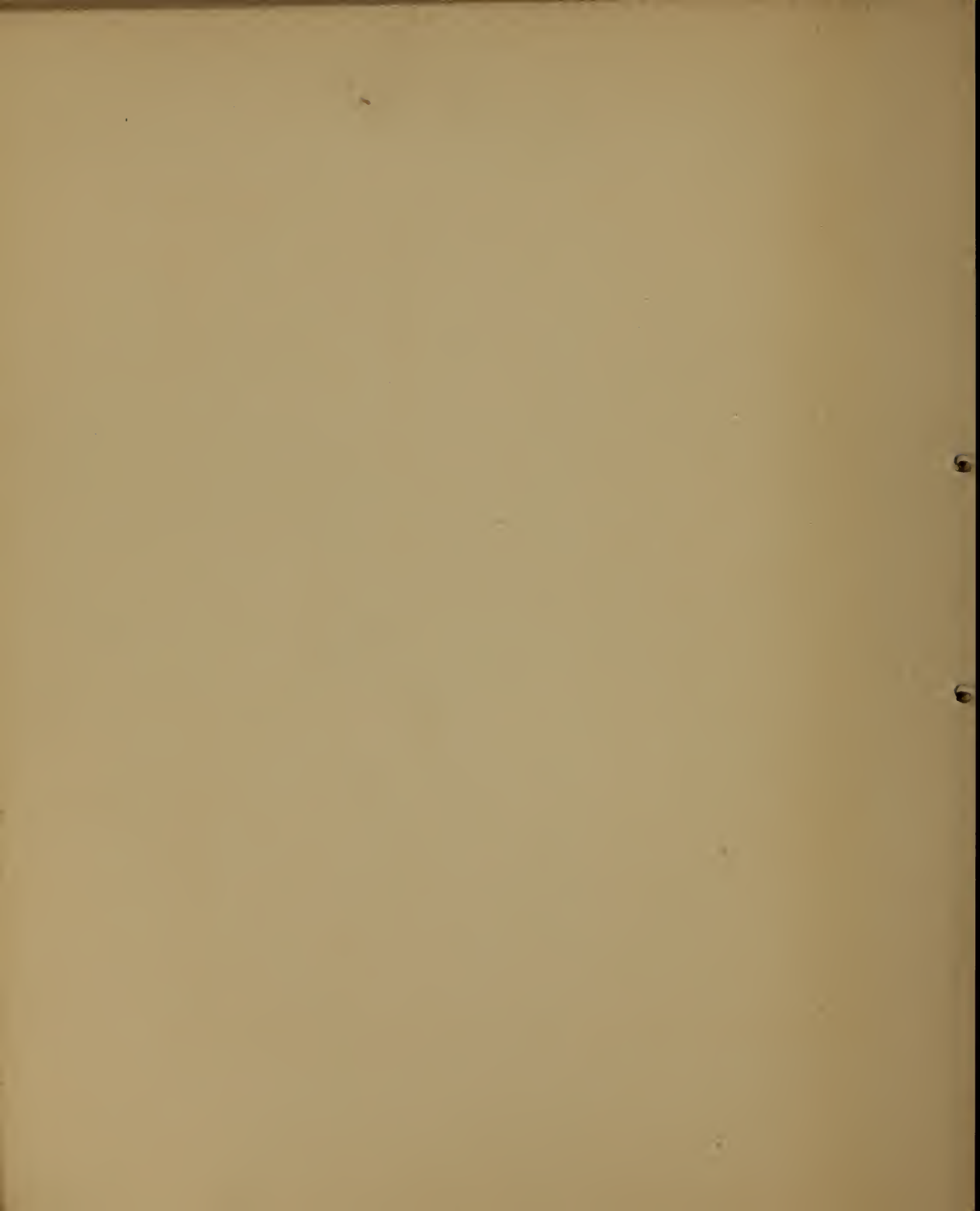


Onward we go, for still we hear them singing,

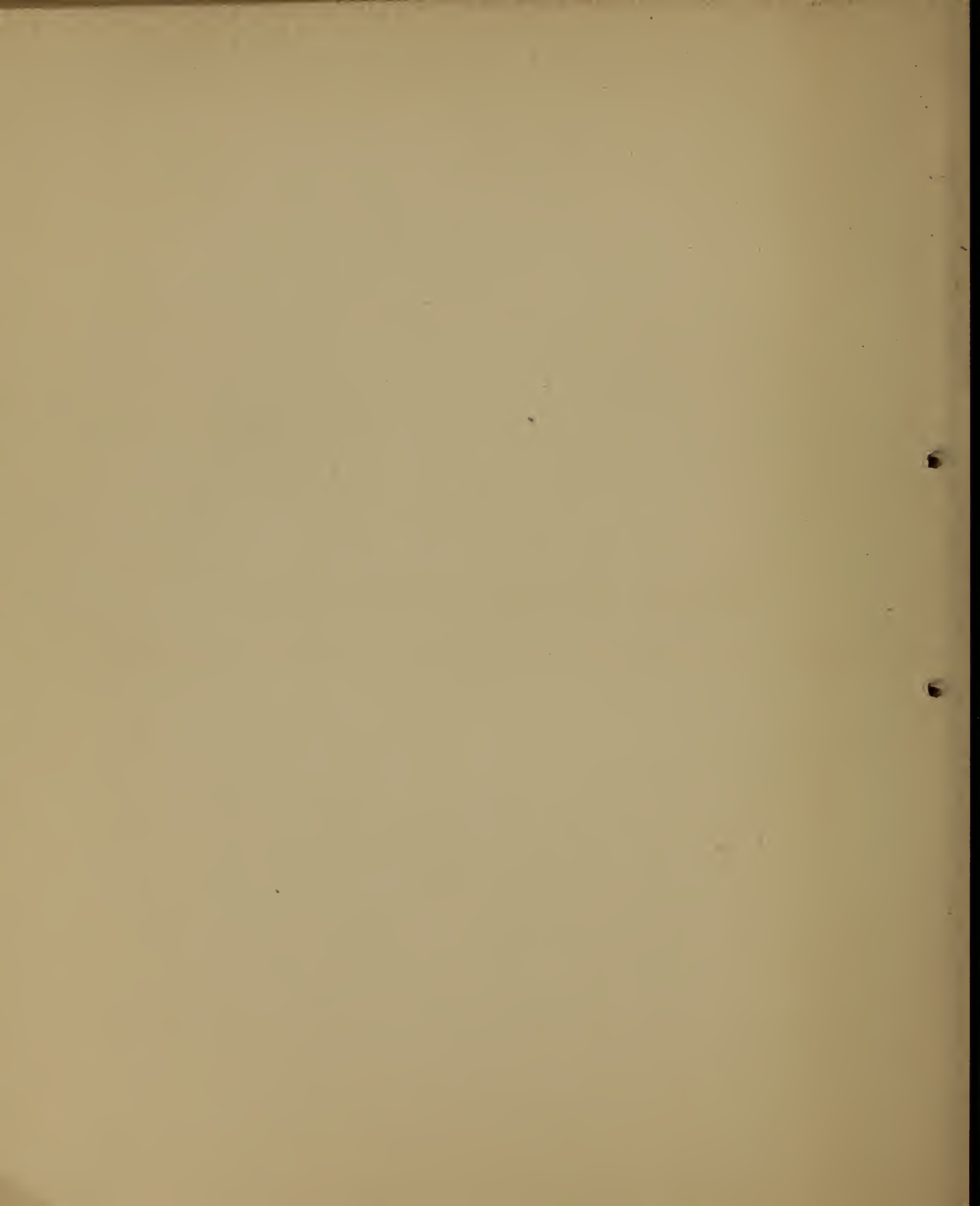

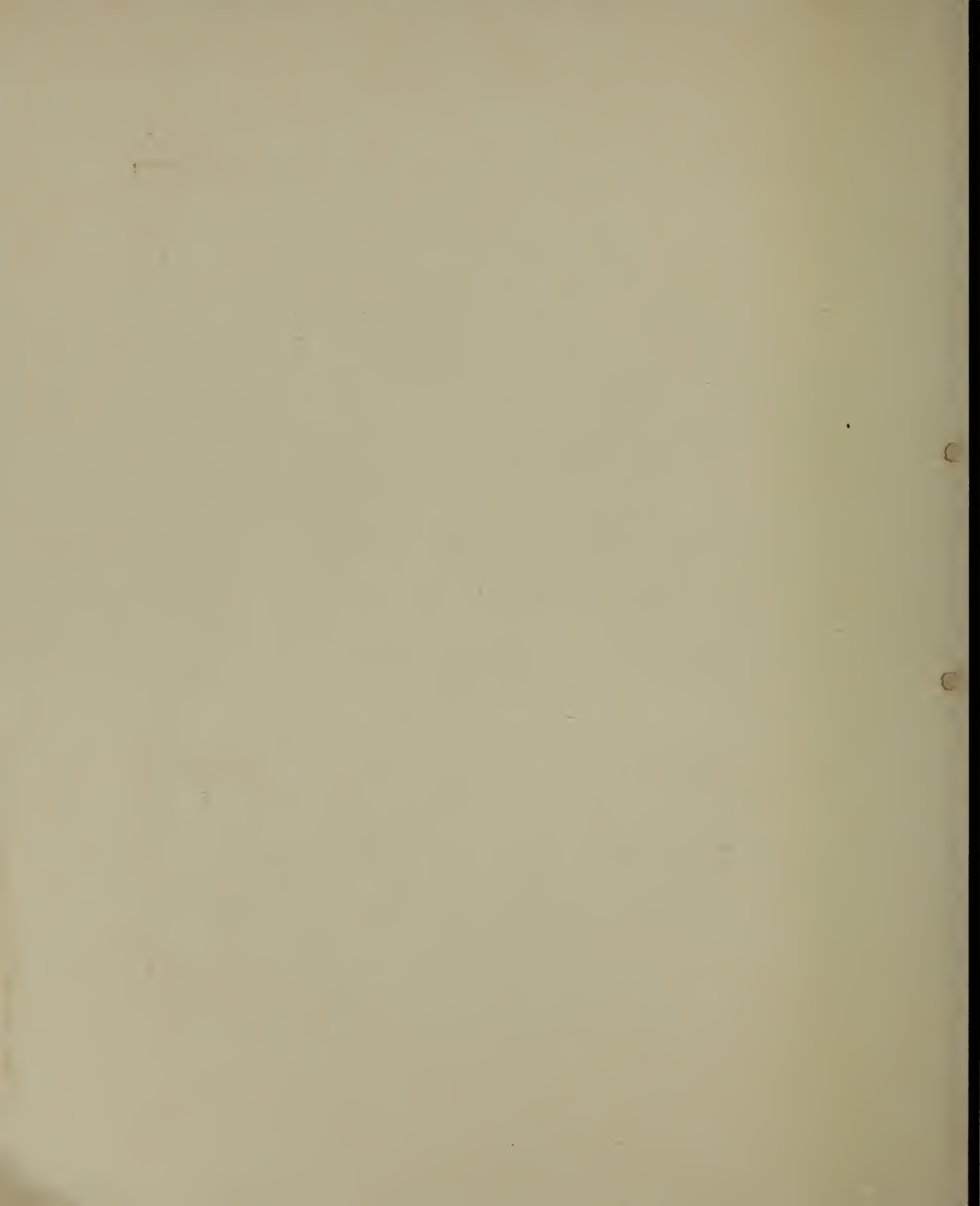


Rest comes at length, though life be long and dreary.

And heaven, the heart's true home, will come at last.

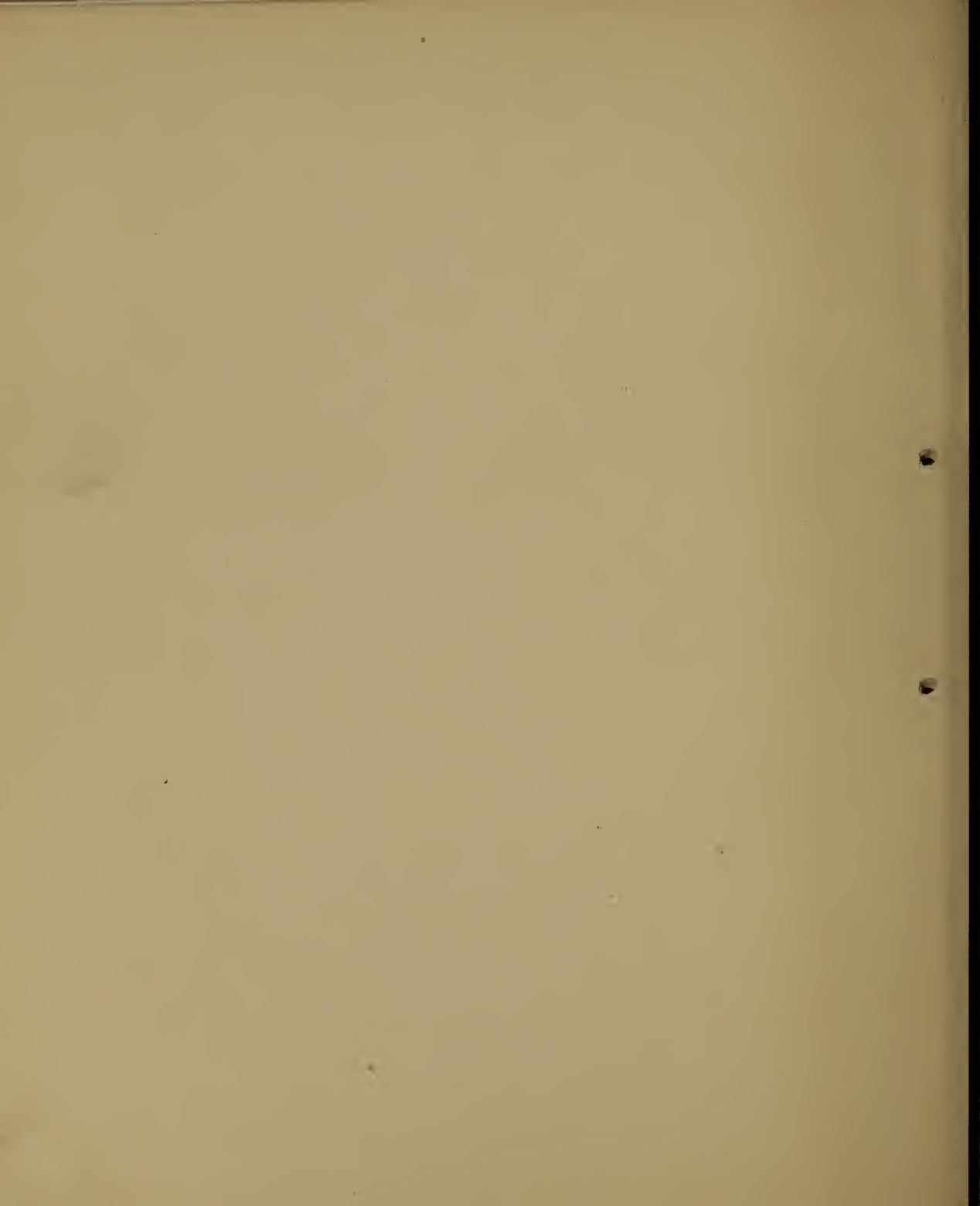

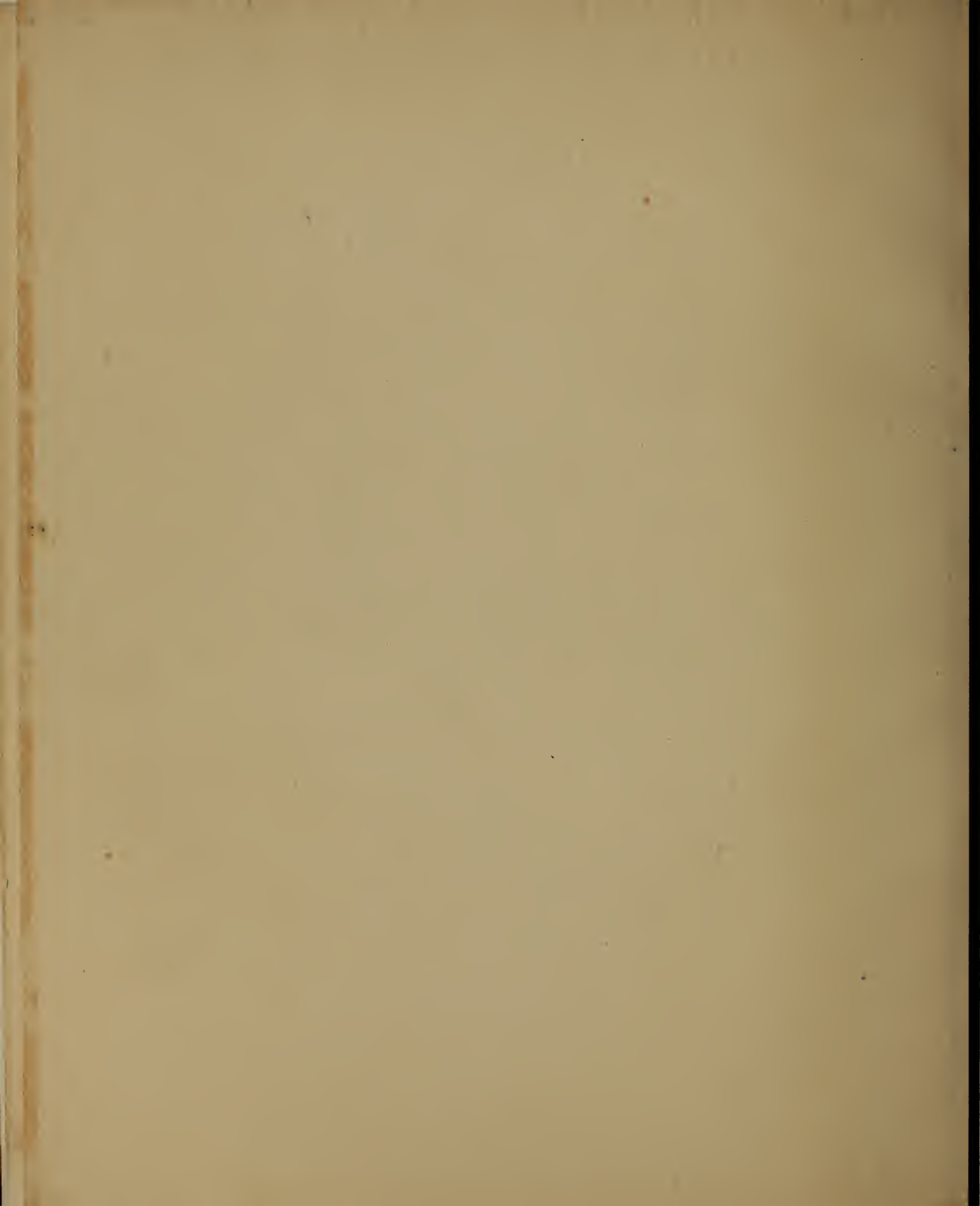

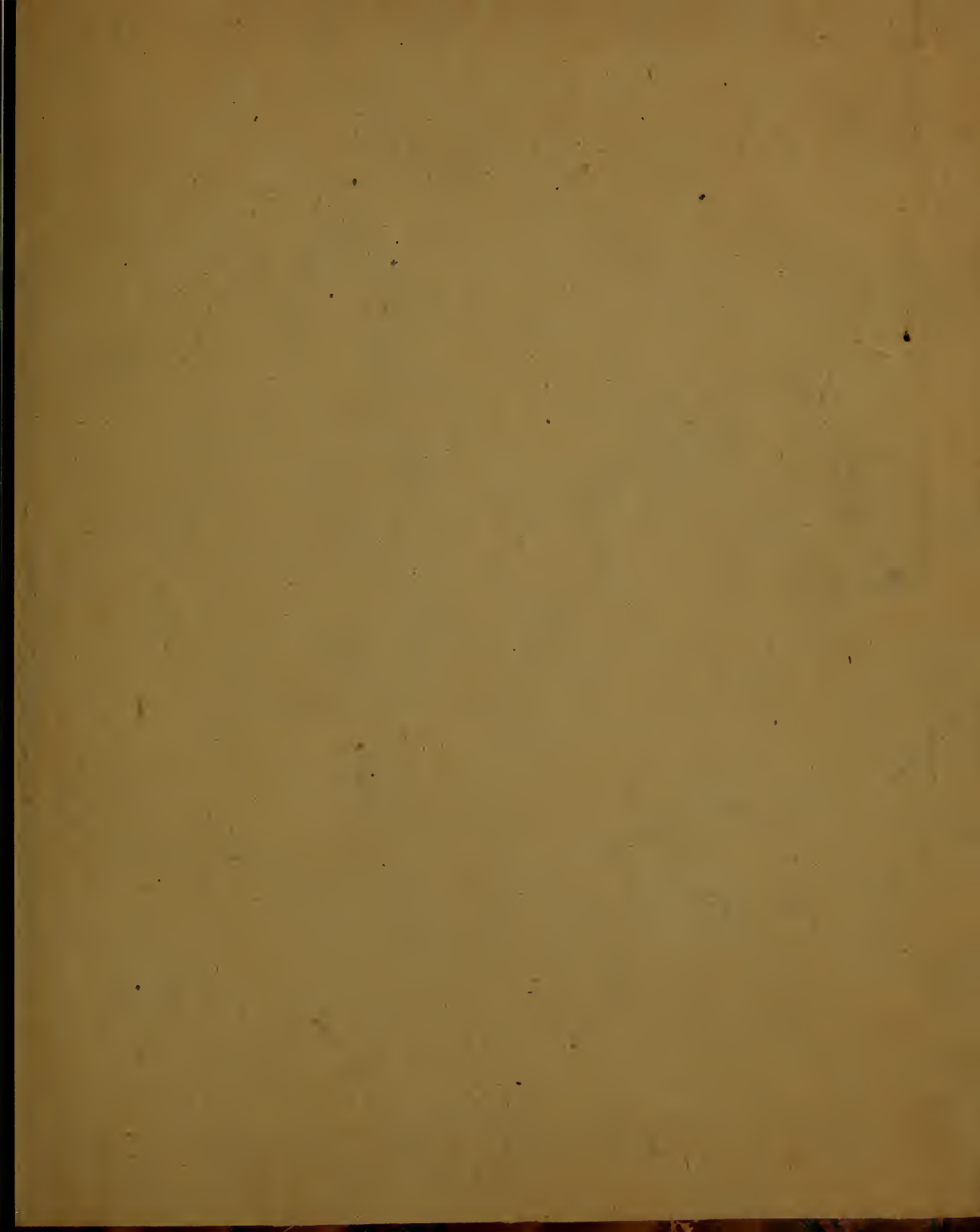


Angels, sing on! your faithful watches keeping;
