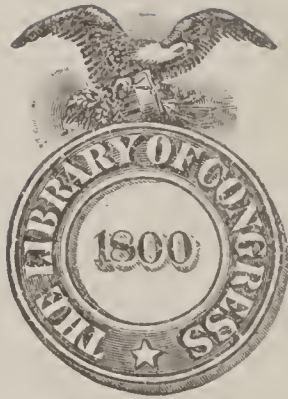

PREFACE

The Psi Upsilon Club of Cleveland submits this record with hopes that it will be of value to the Fraternity, the Executive Council, the Chapters, the Diamond, and particularly to the members of the fraternity in Ohio,—and that it will prove to be an inspiration and a means for organizing Alumni Clubs in other cities in the state.

The Directory records the names, chapters, classes, degrees, undergraduate societies and scholastic and athletic honors, positions of honor and trust, authorship, club and association membership, and occupations of the members, with business and resident addresses of the living, and the dates of the death of the deceased, so far as it has been possible to learn them.

Information was obtained entirely through correspondence, from the members themselves, the chapters, the Diamond, and the Twelfth General Catalogue of the Fraternity. All addresses appearing hereinafter and not enclosed in parentheses are therefore official. An address enclosed in parenthesis is, generally, one to which letters have been sent, without bringing the desired response and without being returned by the Post Office Department. Accordingly these addresses are good for mailing purposes at least.

The asterisk (*) preceding an address indicates that it is to be used for correspondence. The double asterisk (**) follows the name of the deceased member. In every case in which the year of the deceased is known it is indicated to the right at the bottom. The dagger (†) following a name signifies that the brother is a member of the Psi Upsilon Club of Toledo. Discarded names or portions thereof are enclosed in brackets []. Initial letters not followed by periods are names, not abbreviations. Initial letters followed by periods are abbreviations of names not ascertainable. Numerals (1), (2), (3), (4), after college honors and officers, denote freshman, sophomore, junior and senior years respectively. The name of the institution

by which it has been conferred follows the date of the degree. The omission of such name indicates that the degree was conferred by the institution containing the chapter of the fraternity into which the member was initiated.

Attention is called to the list of "Former Residents in Ohio", which will enable the chapters and those desiring the information to bring their Rolls up to date. As far as it has been possible to become posted the enclosed list of Songs are among the most popular in the Song Book and may be of service at Psi U. gatherings.

The Directory is published with the approval of the Executive Council who have granted permission for use of material copyrighted in the Twelfth General Catalogue and the Song Book. The Editor takes this opportunity to thank all members of the Executive Council, the Diamond, and other members of the fraternity. In this connection many be mentioned particularly, R(ober) Bourke Corcoran, Omega '15, Emmett Hay Naylor, Zeta '09, Theodore Leland Waugh, Pi '98, Leo Weldon Wertheimer, Iota '99, Earle Linus Rich, Xi '07, Donald Hubert Wattley, Iota '17, David James Robison, Delta Delta '14, and the Executive Committee of the Cleveland Club.

Conscious that the work is not perfect the Editor, however, believes it to be complete to a large degree. We hope that it will be of service, and that it will bind its members closer in the fraternal bonds.

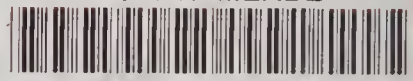
