SECTION I
General

1. Mission - The Civil Affairs Section and Teams are established to advise the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers concerning civil affairs operations in the field and to report on the implementation by the Japanese of directives of the Supreme Commander.

2. Assignment - The Civil Affairs Section and Teams were assigned to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, per General Orders No. 24, 29 December 1949, GHQ, SCAP.

3. Capabilities - The Civil Affairs Section and Teams augmented by 415 Department of the Army civilians are capable of performing the assigned mission as indicated above.

SECTION II
Organization

See Table of Distribution No. 301-1051 for military personnel and applicable manning tables for Department of the Army civilians and indigenous personnel.

SECTION III
Equipment
General

1. General. This table is in accordance with WD Memo 310-60-1, TM 20-410 and AR 310-60, and will be the authority for requisitioning in accordance with pertinent Department of the Army directives, and for the issue of all items of equipment listed herein unless otherwise indicated.

2. Application.

a. This table prescribed the allowances of equipment and supplies for the following:

- (1) Persons authorized under bulk allotment and Department of the Army civilian personnel.
- (2) United States Army Occupation Forces in Japan, for use at posts, camps and stations.
- (3) Indigenous personnel employed by Occupation Forces in Japan (as authorized under current manning table).

b. Articles listed herein except those marked OBAP or OBAU will be considered post, camp and station equipment and will not be taken by troops upon permanent change of station unless such action is directed by the authority ordering the change of station.

c. When a standard item is authorized in the table and a suitable nonstandard item is on hand, the nonstandard item may be retained in lieu thereof until serviceable.

d. Replacement or maintenance parts and accessories for nonstandard items will be issued only if available in depots and until present stocks are exhausted.

e. Items of equipment authorized herein are the latest adopted type standard articles. Priorities of issue, issue of substitute items pending availability of later models, or in lieu thereof until exhausted, are established and authorized by current supply directives.

f. This table will not be used by depots as authority for requisitioning purposes on the Zone of Interior.

3. Changes may be submitted to this headquarters in accordance with existing directives when conditions warrant. Complete justification will accompany all recommended changes.

4. Allowances contained herein are in addition to allowances contained in the following:

a. Department of the Army Table of Allowances 20-4, 14 Jul 49, Equipment for Posts, Camps and Stations Outside the Continental United States.

b. WD Table of Allowances 20-2, 1 Aug 49, Equipment for Training Purposes.

5. Items of clothing and individual equipment, components of sets, kits, spare parts, accessories, special equipment, special tools and allowances of expendable items are contained in the following publications:

AR 775-10, Qualification in Arms and Ammunition Training Allowances.
