The governmental regulation of the State Council

(1st. April, Daido 1
The Ordinance No. 1)

Reformed in March of Keitoku 1st, by the Imperial
decree No. 4 and No. 11; in June by No. 51;
in June of 4th by No. 145; in May
of 7th by No. 117; in March of 8th by No. 13;
in March of 10th by No. 43.

We now enact and promulgate the ^{governmental} regulation of the State
Council.

Governmental regulation of ^{the} State Council.

Provision 1 : The State Council is composed of some
number of councillors.

Provision 2 : The State Council has one chairman
and one vice-chairman and they are appointed
by the Emperor among ^{the} councillors.

The chairman directs all the matters in the State
Council and signs on official letters issued
from the State Council.

The vice-chairman assists the chairman, and

takes the chairman's place when he cannot attend ^{No. 2} for some reason.

When both the chairman and the vice-chairman cannot attend for some reason, a member of ^{the} councillors appointed takes the place.

Provision 3: Opinions of ^{the} State Council are depend on the decisions of conferences of ^{the} State Council.

Provision 4: Conferences of ^{the} State Council can not be opened unless over half members of the State Council.

Provision 5: Proceedings in the conferences of the State Council are adopted by over half of present members. The chairman has a casting-vote in case of a tie.

Provision 6: The chairman is able to let the imperial prime minister, the minister of the Imperial Household and each minister or their representatives attend the conference and speak their opinions in case of need.

Provision 7: The chairman can appoint some juries among ^{the} members and let them judge some special affairs.

Provision 8. : The State Council has a secretary office and arranges the following staff.

Chief of the office,	1,	directly appointed by the Emperor
Adviser,	2,	appointed by the Emperor's approval,
Commissioner	1,	same as above
Secretary	3,	same as above
Chancellor	2,	same as above
Subordinate official	9,	junior official

Provision 9 : The chief directs officials attached to him and manages ordinary affairs by orders of chairman. Advisers participate with ordinary affairs by their superiors' order and manages matters that they are ordered ^{to do} especially.

Commissioners and chancellors manage their business by their superiors' order.

Secretaries manage secret matters by their superiors' order.

Subordinate officials are engaged in business by their superiors' order.

Provision 10 : The chairman asks ^{the Emperor through the prime minister} for approval with the appointment and dismissions, and reward

and punishment of ^{the} staff ^{directly} appointed by the Emperor
and appointed by the Emperor's approval, and
about junior officials, he decides by himself.

Provision 11: This governmental regulation will be
enforced on 9th March of Daido 1st.
