





On 1 March 1945 at 0800 (K), 4 FM-2 were launched by USS MAKIN ISLAND for Target Combat Air Patrol over Iwo Jima. The division was composed of Lts.(jg) Donald E. Skowis, leader, James G. Babb, Rex S. McDaniel and Ensign Eric W. Kattwinkel. When relieved as TCAP they joined 4 FM-2 of VC-88 and 4 FM-2 of VC-96 in a strafing attack on an area (234 Man on local grid) Airfield No. 2. The area was reported to contain camouflaged tank positions but none were observed. Two individual round robin strafing runs were made, starting at 5000 feet and going down to 800. A building and a truck were hit and a crossroads area was thoroughly gone over. There were no observable results. The flight returned to base at 1105 (K).
