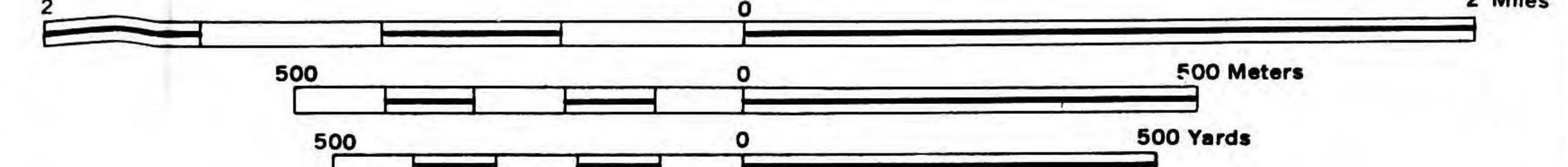


# TAKADA NIGATA PREFECTURE, HONSHU, JAPAN

CONTOUR INTERVAL 10 METERS

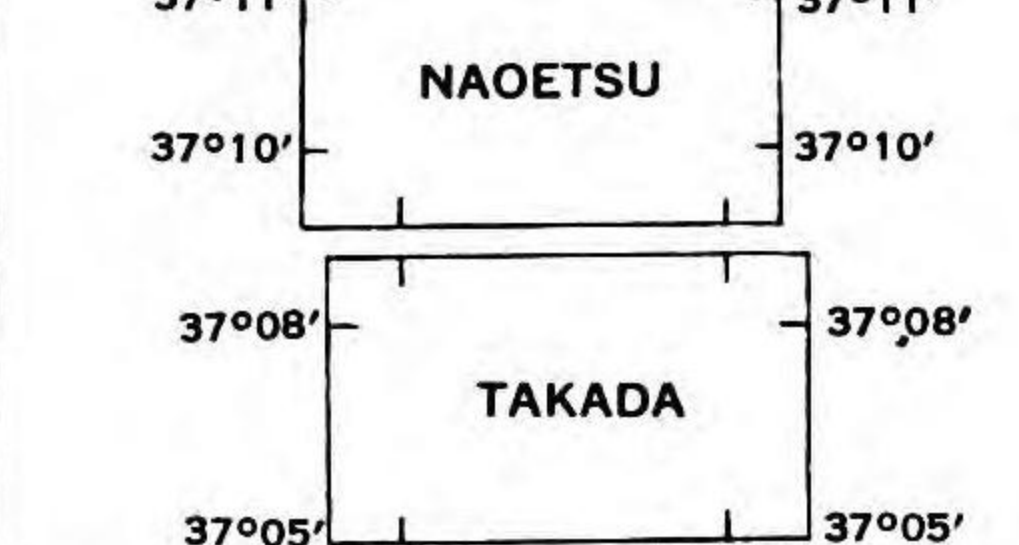




