WHAT IS WIKI LOVES EARTH?



- Annual photographic competition devoted to picturing natural heritage sites;
- Goal: to draw attention to protected areas & create a database of free photos of all natural heritage sites; spread awareness about nature protection;
- Second biggest Wikimedia photo contest after Wiki Loves Monuments;
- At the international level, it is coordinated by a team mostly from Ukraine, but conducted by teams from 40+ countries.







INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZING TEAM

5 people in the core team;
+ 5 international regional ambassadors
(French, Spanish, Arabic, etc.)

CHRONOLOGY OF THE CONTEST



- **2013** was founded in **Ukraine**;
- 2014 became an international, 16 countries-participants;
- 2015 over 100,000 photos on international contest;
- **2016** a **new nomination** was added: UNESCO biosphere reserves;
- 2017 the biggest number of uploads (over 129 000);
- **2020** contest successfully held after first year of **pandemic**;
- 2021 for the first time division into two nominations in an international contest (macro and landscapes);
- 2022 passed for the tenth time; a record number of countries participants 39;
- 2023 a record number of countries participants

DURING THE 10 YEARS OF WLE

- 88 countries and territories have joined;
- 78 350+ uploaders participated;
- 870 000+ uploads were submitted;
- 200 000+ images used in the wikis;
- Special nomination "Human rights and environment";
- Division into categories;

WHAT IS IT?

In 2023, Wiki Loves Earth international photo contest again supports the initiative **WikiForHumanRights** which partners with the Wikimedia Foundation (WMF) and the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR).

Its goal is to raise awareness of nature protection and human impacts on nature.

When we protect the environment, we also protect the fundamental human rights we all have — rights to water, life, food, housing, and other fundamental rights rely on a clean, healthy environment.

Special nomination photos could be used to illustrate Wikipedia articles, news media and other materials to better communicate the reliance of humans on the environment.









WLE IN 2023

- 53 countries and territories-participants;
- 11 countries joined for the first time;
- Uploaders 3 300+;
- Uploads 60 000+ images;
- Top countries with most images so far:
 Germany, Wales, Ukraine;
- Timeline of the contest May-July.
 Some countries prolonged to August;
- Most of the countries already finished their local contest;
- Now is the active stage of submitting local winning images for the international level (11 submissions so far);
- Expected month of the final results November.

WIKI LOVES EARTH 2023 in Ghana was such a great experience and a successful one.


WLE allowed us to explore Ghana, and we had new people happy to sign on. The Wikimedia movement and its sister projects were introduced to these new participants.

As for my experience in organizing the competition for the second time in Egypt, it was a very useful experience for me and also for those photographers who are interested in photographing landscapes in protected areas or macro photography, as it is an opportunity for them to know more details and search for places that may be within the protected areas in Egypt

Even that was vague to me as well until I researched and found out.

We also cooperated with the largest photography club in Egypt," Adasa" club for photography, which has a great position in the photographers' community, as we used it to publish and publicize the contest, as we do not have any funding to spend on making the necessary publicity for the competition or even presenting prizes to the winners, but we relied on motivating them to reach to the final stages of the contest
