In the Resident Magistrate's Court at Port Maria on Wednesday, E. T. Beck-ford was charged with embracery. Mr. D. A. Tucker, Clerk of Courts, prose-cuted, and Mr. S. Pickwick, solicitor, The first witness called was Herbert Theodore Thomas, who said: I am In spector of Police for the parish of St. spector of Police for the parish of St.
Mary. As such it was my duty to cause
all jurors to be warned for the Circuit
Court for the parish. The document now

Mr. Pickwick objected, saying the document spoke for itself. Witness continued: It was posted to the corporal in charge of Oracabessa police station.
The first document purports to be a list of names of persons whom I directed should be warned to attend at the Circuit court. On this list the name of Walter Webster was written. I know the defendant's writing. I have seen him write. The document shown me marked 'C' is in his writing in my opinion, and his signature, with which I am familiar. I saw him write another document. I know Walter Webster. I saw him word the 5th November.
