On August 28, 1954, a source of known reliability made available to our San Francisco office a "List" (Black Book) used by officials of the Yugoslav Consulate in connection with their official duties.

According to our source, this "List" is of recent origin, being dated March 3, 1954. In connection with the use of the "List," informant advised that whenever any person included in the "List" applies for any type of visa for the Federative People's Republic of Yugoslavia, the diplomatic and consular posts of the FBI must seek prior approval from the Federal Secretariat of Foreign Affairs or the Federal Secretariat of Internal Affairs, noting that said persons are on the "List."

The basis for this "List" and the source for the information contained therein were unknown to our informant.

There is attached a copy of this "List" for your information and is not intended for public dissemination.

In the event additional information is obtained you will be advised.

1. * SPEER, Klara; born 3 May 1894 in SCHWEDT; husband former member of German army, deceased 1945; lives SCHWEDT, Oderstrasse 20. Ca. 165 cms. tall, of stocky build, has blue eyes and white hair.

2. * RUSCH, Herbert; born 1909 in ELBING, East Prussia; married with two children; living Berlin-Wilmersdorf, Wexstrasse 33. Prior to 1933 held for a short time a position in a bank; assigned 1933 to Reichs Labor Service (RAD) where his last rank corresponded to that of 1st Lt. (Feldmeister). Accepted in 1950 a job as bookkeeper in a socialized plant (VEB) in East Berlin. Subject, fearing arrest for having made disparaging remarks about Sovzone politics, fled to West Berlin in 1952. He has been unemployed since that time and has been assisted financially by his mother. RUSCH is ca. 175 cms. tall, of heavy build, and has blue eyes.

3. * BIEDERBICK, Andreas; born 12 March 1909 in Neuss, Rheinland; married with two children; lives Duesseldorf, Friedrichstrasse 87. Subject graduated from the Gymnasium and attended the University (place not given), where he studied philology and physical culture and passed his final examinations as Dr. phil. in 1936. He joined in 1935 the SD (SS Security Service) of the RFSS (Reichs leadership of SS troops) West DUESSELDORF as cultural adviser. In December 1936, BIEDERBICK was transferred to the SD-H Office Berlin (Scientific Research & Archives section, working on a history of political events following 1918). Was arrested by the Americans and handed over to the Belgians who held him until March 1948. After his release, subject earned his living as an assistant bookkeeper and as office worker. Partly unemployed between December 1951 and October 1952; since October 1953 subject has been working as independent translator for various firms, among them being the Duesseldorf branch of the Publishing House C.W. Leske, Darmstadt. Subject is ca. 191 cms. tall, of slender build and has blue eyes.

1. V-8774. Was tipped by V-1606 and recruited by V-1605 in October 1954 as a source on conditions in the German-Polish border area where she lives. Subject is the principal figure of the now Forschung WALKUERE of Dienststelle 161.

2. V-8776. Was tipped and recruited by V-1605 on 10 October 1954 as a letter-drop and cover address for Forschung WALKUERE.

3. V-4985. Was tipped and recruited by V-7630 on 15 September 1954. He is to establish, maintain, and exploit contacts to Institutes of Higher Learning (Universities, etc.) and graduates of such institutions. At the present time subject is trying to establish contacts to German engineers who are supervising in Upper Silesia the assembly of machinery delivered by West German firms.

1. Klara SPEER:

The Archives Section of Headquarters Registry contains several wartime reports on Clara de Adolfo SPERER (also spelt Klara SPERER and Clara SPEER), born in Istanbul, 10 April 1907, of Austrian parents. She is divorced from a German national, Karl JUNG, but has supposedly retained her German citizenship. She has lived in Naples since 1939. She speaks Italian, French, Spanish, German and English. She was known to have lived with a German officer during the German occupation, and it was stated that her house was amply supplied with all sorts of foodstuffs plundered by the Germans. Her father, Adolfo SPERER, is reported as living in Germany in one report; and, in another in Richmond Hill, New York. Since she was considered as a person of bad moral reputation and there was considerable question regarding her background, associations, and present activity (1944), it was felt that her presence in Naples represented a possible danger to Allied security.

The above is taken from reports dated around 1943-44 and is reported for your information. These are the only traces of the name SPERER or SPERER. If desired we shall forward more complete traces on the Klara SPERER mentioned above.

Andreas BIRDERBYCK:

In June 1945 SUBJECT, alias Andre BACH, was arrested by the US Forces in the area occupied by the Fourth Waffen SS Panzer Korps near EBERFING, Bavaria, after complaints had been made by the Waffen SS officers that SUBJECT's presence in the area was undesirable. (B-2) SUBJECT stated that he entered the National Socialist Student's Union in 1930 while he was a student at the University of BONN. In 1931 he joined the Allgemeine SS and the NSDAP. In 1935 while he was writing his thesis for his PHD, SUBJECT was approached by the Chief of the SD in DUESSELDORF, who offered him a position in the RSHA in BERLIN. SUBJECT accepted and commenced work for Abteilung I-32 in December 1936. During WW II SUBJECT attained the rank of Sturmabfuhrer in the Allgemeine SS, Major in the SD and Abteilungleiter in the RSHA. From June 1940 until the autumn of 1943 he served in Abt. III of the SD in France. In the autumn of 1943 he was transferred to the SD in BRUSSELS to work as Referent of Abt. III-C. In September 1944 his office was forced to close operations and he was transferred to SALZBURG, Austria. He was in charge of Section III-C and was given the job of creating Section III-C (Gesellschaftsnachrichten Dienst.) In May 1945 SUBJECT managed to be accepted by the Fourth Waffen SS Panzer Korps because he said that he feared being treated as a partisan if he were to be captured as a "stray" soldier. (F-6) SUBJECT was reported to be arrogant and a firm believer in the aims of the NSDAP. (B-3) In January 1946 it was reported that the Belgium government had made a request for extradition of SUBJECT. (B-2) (CONFIDENTIAL) No additional information available.

1. On 14 October, [] and [] met with ZIPPER Hqs. @WINTER, Karl, at [] apartment for a friendly get-together. Our experience has been that such informal meetings are conducive to a better FOB/ZIPPER liaison relationship and generally yield some information otherwise not obtainable. On this particular occasion, it was learned from @WINTER, on a confidential basis, that a reevaluation of potentialities and past performances has resulted in a number of organizational changes which involve the reshuffling of personnel and changes in the organizational structure of various Dienststellen. Some of these have already been carried out, while others are in the process of being implemented. The most important changes, in so far as the work of [] and [] is concerned, are the elimination of Dienststelle 9 and the creation of two new Dienststellen, namely Dienststellen 6 and 7. The new set-up, according to @WINTER, is now as follows:

I. Dienststelle 5 -

The Berlin Office of Dienststelle 5 will be eliminated and its staff will be transferred to Munich. Dienststelle 5 will move its Hqs. to some other location in Munich, but has not yet found a suitable location. V-22 005, @WEISNER, has been relieved of his position as Deputy leader of Dienststelle 5 following a grave security incident. (Subject lost his briefcase, containing a pistol and operational/personal material while traveling from Munich to Cologne). His transfer to Hqs. section 900 (Wellman) is under consideration. V-22 005 will be replaced by @LUDWIG as deputy leader of Dienststelle 5 (for true name see para 1 of attachment) who has been assigned the number V-22 154; @LUDWIG will work on III/e matters. V-14 404, @DOPPLER, Karl, will also become a member of Dienststelle 5; his assignment will be the exploitation of correspondence with persons living in Satellite countries. (Briefaufklaerung @ BA)

Dienststelle 5 will have three sub-agencies, namely

a. Anwesenstelle V-14 178, @LANZGRAF who will be assisted by V-21 634, his wife. (V-21 517, @RAAB, the former deputy of V-14 178, is being transferred, see below.)

Dienststelle 6 is located in FRANKFURT/M; Its chief is V-7048, OSWENRICH; target: Tiefenauflklärung. Dienststelle 6 has three sub agencies, namely

a. Ausconstelle LAMON, located in Bad HOENSBURG; Exploitation of M. V-7601, Leader and Agent Leader; V-14 231; V-21 305, GRAAB, Otto; V-14 222, OSWENRICH, Walter; V-14 221; and V-14 225.

b. Ausconstelle DEFOY, DUESSELDORF, with V-4985, OSWENRICH, Andre; V-21 641, OSWENRICH, Walter; and V-16 475 (see Identity 2 of attachment)

c. MAGAZIN, located in BOCHUM, with V-7630 OSWENRICH, Kurt, and V-9627, OSWENRICH, Karl.

IV. Dienststelle 7 -

BACKGROUND

Subject attended the Volkshule in Neuss and Gymnasium in Krefeld from which he graduated in 1928. He attended the Marburg and Bonn Universities and finished his studies at Bonn in 1936. While in the two universities he studied philology and physical culture, and received the degree of doctor of philosophy. He joined the SD in 1935 in West Duesseldorf and was made a cultural advisor. In December 1936, he was transferred to the SD-H office in Berlin (Scientific Research and Archives Section which worked on a history of political events following 1918).

During World War II he attained the rank of Sturmbahnfuhrer in the Allgemeine SS, Major in the SD and Abteilungsleiter in the RHSA. From June 1940 until the autumn of 1943 he served in Abt. VII of the SD in France. He was then transferred to the SD in Brussels to work as Referent of Abt. III-C. In September 1944 his office was forced to close operations and he was transferred to Salzburg, Austria. He was in charge of Section III-C and was given the job of creating an Amt. III-G (Gesellschaftennachrichten Dienst). In May 1945 he managed to get himself accepted by the Fourth Waffen SS Panzer Korps because he allegedly feared being treated as a partisan if he were to be captured as a "stray" soldier. Following the end of the war he found himself at large near Eberfing, Bavaria, and was subsequently arrested in June 1945 upon the complaints of captured Waffen SS officers.

Following his arrest, he was handed over to the Belgians by the Americans and was finally repatriated in 1948. After returning to Germany, Subject earned his living as an assistant bookkeeper and as an office worker. Partly unemployed between December 1951 and October 1952, Subject finally obtained steady employment and since October 1953 worked as an independent translator for a number of firms in the Duesseldorf area.

In 1958 Subject was reported to have his own translation bureau in Duesseldorf which functioned also as an UPSWING cover firm.

Subject was transferred from Dienststelle 161 to Dienststelle 6 in 1955 prior to the organization of Dienststelle 24.
