### THE USE OF SODIUM BICARBONATE

It is often desired to remove the carbon dioxide from a system of gas, or to remove carbon dioxide from a system which has been exposed to air for a long time. This may be done by passing the gas through a solution of sodium bicarbonate. The amount of sodium bicarbonate required will depend upon the amount of carbon dioxide to be removed, and the pressure of the gas.

The following table gives the amount of sodium bicarbonate required to remove all the carbon dioxide from a given volume of gas at a given pressure.

For example, if one cubic meter of gas at 100 mm. Hg pressure contains 100 cubic centimeters of carbon dioxide, then 100 cubic centimeters of sodium bicarbonate will remove all the carbon dioxide.
