It was decided at this meeting to effect distribution of ladies- and children-shoes, as well as peaches, chocolate and chewing gum (peaches 3 tins to each woman and chocolate and chewing gum 2 bars and 2 pkts. resp. to each child).-

RE: Distribution:

The distribution took place from the Sub-Committee's premises. The necessary receipts were obtained from total 117 persons, that is from 73 women and 44 children.-

RE: Various clothing:

17 cases of various clothing which Sub-Committee received in later part of July were not opened and checked yet.

RE: Applications:

Since the previous report was made 8 applicants departed from Karuizawa and 5 new applicants registered with Karuizawa Sub-Committee.
