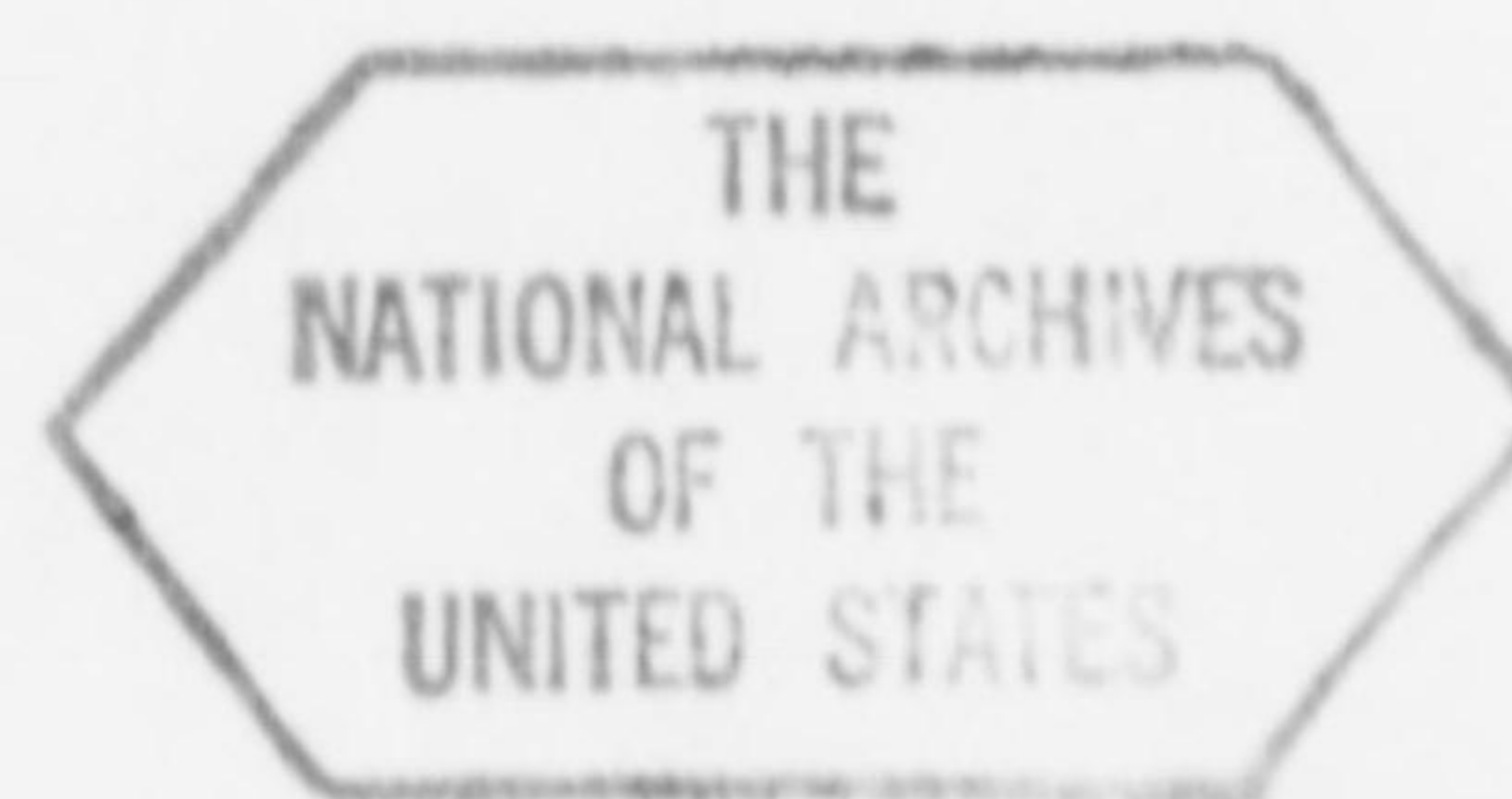

SUBJECT: Authorization to Requisition Refrigerators for
Military Personnel in NPR Camps

TO : Commanding General
Headquarters and Service Group
GHQ, FEC CAS
APO 500
ATTN: Logistics Section

1. It is requested that this headquarters be given authority to requisition refrigerators for the Messes operated for Military Personnel in NPR Camps in this region.
2. It is essential that these camps have refrigeration to store perishable foods and other food items. These camps receive rations once a week and at the present time have no refrigeration available to them.
3. This headquarters has requested refrigerators from Eta Jima School Command but was told that no authority was available for such issue and that authorization for issue must be received from Higher Headquarters.
4. This region has four NPR Camps in isolated areas that must have refrigeration to take care of their rations.
5. It is requested that this headquarters be given authority to requisition four (4) refrigerators for Messes operated for American Military Personnel in the Camp Cadres of these four NPR Camps.
