## Announcement.

Your attention is called to the following prices for growing my usual contract lines for 1902. Owing to the very high prices at which all kinds of farm produce are selling, and also to increased values in real estate and rents, it is necessary to ask a much increased price over rates that have prevailed for several years past. The only crops that have not paid the farmers for the last two years are the seed crops. A higher price must be paid or stocks cannot be produced.

An acreage will be planted of each variety to produce, under ordinary conditions, the various amounts required to fill all contract orders, and under no circumstances will an acreage be planted for the purpose of producing a surplus, except in the case of field corns. In case of shortages all orders will be filled by an equal pro rata division of the entire merchantable crop delivered to me by my various growers, all orders being treated alike.

Orders will be accepted for the growing of special stocks or new varieties at reasonable prices if planting stocks are furnished.
The telegraph code used is the same as adopted by the American Seed Traúe Association.

Orders for 25 pounds of a single variety of vine seeds will be filled at regular quotations; for orders of less than 25 pounds of a single kind, add 2 cents per pound.

Terms:-Field Corn, cash on receipt and examination; Sweet Corn and Vine Seed, 60 days acceptance, or if discounted, 1 per cent in 30 days from date of shipment. All prices are based on delivery f. o. b. Waterloo, Neb.

Both seed and corn to be true to name, of good sample, purity and vitality.

TERMS:-Field Corn, cash on receipt and examination; Sweet Corn and Vine Seed, by acceptance due in 60 days from date of shipment, or if discounted, 1 per cent for cash in 30 days from date of shipment.

It is mutually agreed that in case of a shortage on any of the within named quantities, that a full pro rata division shall be considered a satisfactory delivery on the order.
