General Order, No. 92.

In order to carry into effect the foregoing orders of His Excellency, the Commander-in-Chief, the Commanding officer of each of the Volunteer Regiments of South Carolina, now in camp, will be provided with blank enrollments for each Company of their respective Regiments, upon which, each commissioned, and non-commissioned officer, and private, who may so desire, shall enroll his name.

The Commanding officers of Companies, to make returns of such Enrollments to the Commanding officers of Regiments—within three days after such Blank Enrollments shall be given to them, and the Commanding officers of Regiments, to transmit forthwith, the returns, through the Generals of Brigades, to this office
