SUBJECT: Responsibility of the Japanese Government for the
Packaging, Transfer, and Delivery of Equipment and
Records Allocated to Claimant Nations under the
Reparations Program


2. Paragraph b(2), Annex 9 of reference 1 above is rescinded and the following substituted therefor:
