(d) Headquarters Battalion's Civil Action Program continues to support the Buddhist Orphanage in Hoa Phat Village (BT 988767). During the month of August, the following items were delivered to the orphanage; 6 boxes of toys, 300 school kits, 1,100 lbs. of bulgar, 500 lbs. of salt, 300 lbs. of clothes and one case of chewing gum. Classes are being held in the school and it is near completion. Prior to his detachment on 30Aug66, Captain HUNTER, Officer in Charge of the "I" Corps Security Detachment, had been teaching English to 35 Vietnamese students, two hours a night on Monday, Wednesday and Friday in downtown Danang.

(e) During the month of August, the Communications Company Civil Affairs NCO made two trips to Ap Da Lap and toys were given out to about 60 children and 250 pounds of clothing was given to the village chief.
