Headquarters to CAMP KOKURA - Former salvage warehouse offered and letter requesting rehabilitation of building has been approved by SW Command and forwarded to JLC. Will be adequate when renovated. New Kokura Hotel, District Hq billet, and Jackson Hotel, sub-area office of Fukuoka Area, will be released when District Headquarters moves, probably about 1 June.

Submitted herewith in accordance with CINCPAC message 282137 Z, dated 28 August 1952, is monthly activities report of this headquarters.

PART A - ARMY

1. Intelligence

a. The HMB Situation.

(1) During the month of November, the HMBs conducted three ambushes of troops, one raid on a small barrio, and four kidnappings which included one soldier in civilian clothes. These actions denote an increase in HMB aggressiveness during November, since no raids or ambushes were reported in October.

(2) G-2, IV Military Area, reports an increase in the number of HMBs in Mindanao in the past six months. There are an estimated 270 HMBs, active sympathizers and supporters in Mindanao, the majority of whom are in Cotabato and Davao provinces, with expansionist efforts being directed toward Agusan province. There has been a small expansionist force in Mindanao for more than a year but only during recent months has it had any success in organizational work.

2. Operations, Organization, and Training.

a. Operations.

(1) Tactical Disposition of Troops. The tactical organization and disposition of major tactical units of the Philippine Army remain unchanged from that shown in the report for October, except that the 1st Field Artillery Battalion has been moved from an assigned sector in the vicinity of Mt. Arayat, Pampanga province, to Camp Murphy, Quezon City, and placed in GHQ Reserve. The 17th BCT has been withdrawn from GHQ Reserve, Camp Murphy, and assigned the sector in the vicinity of Mt. Arayat formerly occupied by the 1st FA Battalion.

**SECRET** SECURITY INFORMATION(2) Summary of Operations During Period(a) I Military Area.

1. General. Operations in the I Military Area were confined to those directed by Sector and lower commanders, reflecting the general break-up and scattering of large HMB concentrations in this area.

2. PAMBUL Sector. The main effort in this Sector was continued in the Candaba Swamps, especially in the northern portions, by the 20th and 22nd BCTs, where Luis Taruc was reported seen. A secondary effort was made in the Magalang and Porac areas by the 6th BCT. The time required to effect a change of battalion sector responsibility, involving the relief of the 1st FA Battalion by the 17th BCT, reduced the operational efforts in this Sector during this period. Temporary Police units of Bulacan province were assembled and oriented.

3. NETAR Sector conducted battalion and company operations in the valley of the Chico River, from Guimba to Cabiao in Nueva Ecija province, employing elements of the 12th, 5th, and 1st BCTs. The situation in the vicinity of Aliaga and Zaragoza, Nueva Ecija, was improved by the elimination of the notorious HMB leader Commander Reyes. Some Temporary Police in Nueva Ecija were assembled and oriented during the month.

4. BATZAM Sector conducted an operation in areas north and south of the Olongapo-Dinalupihan road, employing elements of the 18th, 25th, and 27th BCTs, against the HMB basic military training school. Other operations were carried out in the mountainous area east of Santa Cruz, Zambales province, by the 25th BCT, and east of Botolan, Zambales, by the 27th BCT.

5. PAGAN Sector coordinated operations by small units in the mountains west of Mangatarem, Pangasinan province. Coordination with adjacent units along the Sector boundary is being established.

6. ALUMPINIS Sector employed Military-Civilian Commando Units in small groups, particularly in the Mountain Province, against a few small bands of HMBs.

7. VIZCAISA Sector maintained routine patrols and executed small company operations in Cagayan and Isabela provinces. Military-Civilian Commando Units operating under Philippine Army directives contacted small bands of HMBs, particularly in Isabela province.

(b) II Military Area1. General. No change from last report.

2. LIGHTNING Sector coordinated a number of battalion operations in Laguna province, and conducted one Sector operation in western Batangas and Cavite provinces. These operations produced generally negative results. Small patrols and Scout-Ranger Teams were more frequently successful. The collection of firearms in the province of Cavite continued.

3. RAINBOW Sector continued operations on the Albay-Sorsogon border. During this period, Commander Caballero, Commanding Officer of HMB Field Command #54, was captured, and Commander Dante of HMB Regional Command #5 surrendered.

4. THUNDER Sector terminated operations on the Jala-Jala peninsula, Rizal province, and continued operations in north-eastern Laguna province. A large operation was conducted in Quezon province, in coordination with LIGHTNING Sector. This operation terminated in the vicinity of Mauban, Quezon province, with negative results. The showboat, a converted LCM, which had been operating on Laguna de Bay in connection with peace rallies, was turned over to LIGHTNING Sector with an impressive ceremony at Sta. Cruz, Laguna province. The Secretary of National Defense, Mr. Ramon Magsaysay, was the principal speaker.

(c) III Military Area. No change from last report.

(d) IV Military Area. Operations against the Moro bandits on Jolo Island continued until bandit leader Hadji Kamlon and a group of followers surrendered. Military operations have been suspended during negotiations aimed toward effecting the surrender of the remaining bandits. Results of the operations against the Moro bandits, as reported by GHQ, AFP, follow:

b. Organization and Training.

(1) On request of GHQ, AFP, arrangements were made by JUSMAG for the loan of one multiple caliber .50 anti-aircraft machine gun and two non-commissioned officer instructors from Clark Air Force Base, for training assistance to the 14th BCT for a period of 30 days, beginning 13 November. The 14th BCT expects to be issued similar equipment upon arrival in Korea, early in 1953.

(2) The 1,650 twenty-year-old Trainees undergoing training at Fort Wm. McKinley completed 11 weeks basic training on 29 November, and prepared for a two-week field exercise in the vicinity of Magalang, Pampanga province, beginning 2 December.

(3) Four Philippine Constabulary companies completed the eight-week retraining course at Fort Wm. McKinley on 5 November, and 5 companies began the course on 10 November. The units are:

3. Personnel and Administration.

a. (1) On 15 November 1952, the President of the Republic of the Philippines sent a memorandum to the Secretary of National Defense notifying him that, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 602 fixing the minimum wage for employees in the government service at ₱1440.00 per annum, the base pay of corporals (₱780.00), first class privates (₱660.00), and privates (₱600.00), would be adjusted to ₱810.00 per annum each, effective 16 November 1952.

(2) According to GHQ, AFP, the above executive order is an interim measure designed to provide for immediate compliance with the above cited Republic Act, commonly known as the "Minimum Wage Law."

(3) It should be noted that this pay increase provides for the same base pay for corporals, first class privates, and privates, and no increase in base pay for the higher grades. Since only the Philippine Congress, which presently is not in session, can increase the pay and allowances of AFP enlisted personnel, the above Presidential Memorandum was the only means of immediately increasing the pay and allowances of enlisted personnel to comply with Republic Act No. 602.

(4) GHQ, AFP, has under preparation a proposed career compensation act which, if passed by the next session of the Philippine Congress, will comply not only with the Minimum Wage Law but will also provide pay and allowances commensurate with the grade occupied by an enlisted man.

## b. Arrivals and departures of MDAP trainees during November.

(1) Eight officers and six enlisted men departed to attend courses at U. S. Army Service Schools. This makes a total of 51 officers and 18 enlisted men who have departed under the Fiscal Year 1953 MDA Training Program.

(2) Two officers returned from the United States after completion of courses at U. S. Army Service Schools under the Fiscal Year 1953 MDA Training Program. These officers are the first AFP personnel to complete their U. S. training under this program.

(3) There were no arrivals from the United States under the Fiscal Year 1952 MDA Training Program. Three AFP personnel are still due to return under this program.

4. PC Activities.

a. The 2nd Tarlac PC Company was transferred from San Manuel, Tarlac, to Paniqui, Tarlac.

(1) The 1,650 trainees, see paragraph 2 b (2), who just completed their basic training will receive 10-months training organized as 3 battalions of Construction Engineers. Their last 5 months will be spent at on-the-job training constructing a 3,000-man housing unit at Fort Wm. McKinley, runways at various airfields, and another EDCOR Farm.

(2) Construction progressed in all areas, especially at the Philippine Military Academy. A headquarters building at PATC was complete except for painting.

(3) The Engineer Base Shop received, during November, 24 items for major repair and completed 17. Forty other jobs of 3rd echelon status were performed. Most of these were accomplished in the field at unit areas. This procedure shortened deadline time and saved transportation.

(4) Eighty thousand (80,000) sheets of map reproductions were run by the Map Reproduction Unit, in addition to other printing for GHQ, AFP.

(5) The Nichols Hangar Roofing Project bid was opened on 11 November. The award was approved by GHQ, AFP, and was sent to the low bidder for signature on 29 November.

f. Medical. The Armed Forces Medical Service School commenced preparation of material for various medical extension courses. The U.S. Army extension course material furnished by JUSMAG is being utilized as a guide.

g. Ordnance.

(1) A total of 232 vehicles of various types were repaired and returned to using units by the MM and MAM Companies of the AFP.

(2) The Ordnance Service, AFP, contracted with local civilian concerns for batteries in the amount of ¥14,882.00, and for target cloth in the amount of ¥4,800.00.

(3) The Ordnance Inspection Section of the AFP General Depot inspected a total of 4,167 items of material for local purchase and rejected 1,280. This indicates a definite improvement in inspection procedures.

(4) The Ordnance Service, AFP, prepared and forwarded for approval purchase orders in the amount of ¥102,143 for local purchase of tires and tubes of various sizes.

(5) The Ordnance Ammunition Company renovated 365,000 rounds of small arms ammunition.

h. Quartermaster.

(1) Contracts were made by the Quartermaster General, AFP, with local concerns for production of the following footwear and clothing items by the end of January 1953:

- 50,000 pairs of Service Shoes at ₱10.00 a pair
- 25,000 pairs of Rubber Combat Boots at ₱3.50 a pair
- 25,000 suits of Herringbone Twill (Jackets and Trousers) at ₱11.54 a suit
- 220,000 yards of Khaki Cloth at ₱1.50 a yard. (Khaki Cloth is issued to units for fabrication of uniforms locally.)

Also on procurement, or to be procured, from local concerns are Cotton Drawers and Undershirts, Bath Towels, Laundry Bags, and Tennis Shoes.

(2) The 1st QM Truck Battalion celebrated its fourth anniversary on 11 November 1952. It has grown from a platoon to a battalion with a Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, a Heavy Truck Platoon, two Truck Companies, and a Service Company. During the period 1 July 1951 to 31 May 1952, a total of 28,132 tons of supply, including 14,507 tons of MDAP supplies, were moved. To date, the vehicles of this unit have travelled a distance of 1,606,135 kilometers.

(3) On 21 October 1952, Executive Order No. 524 was issued by the President of the Philippines, requiring all departments, bureaus, offices, agencies, instrumentalities, and political subdivisions of the government, the Armed Forces, and other agencies, to buy from the National Rice and Corn Corporation, whenever available, all their requirements for rice.

(4) The Secretary of National Defense approved the increase of the clothing allowance for 20-year old trainees from ₱75.00 to ₱85.00 each, for the 5-1/2 month training period, and an additional ₱50.00 each, for the next 4-1/2 month training period for those whose training is extended to a total of ten months.

i. Signal

(1) Radio relay telephone and teletypewriter service were initiated between GHQ, AFP, and Headquarters II Military Area. Installation of a similar circuit to I Military Area was begun.

(2) The Signal Depot initiated a program for salvaging parts from unrepairable equipment. These parts were previously considered junk and scheduled for sale as scrap metal.
