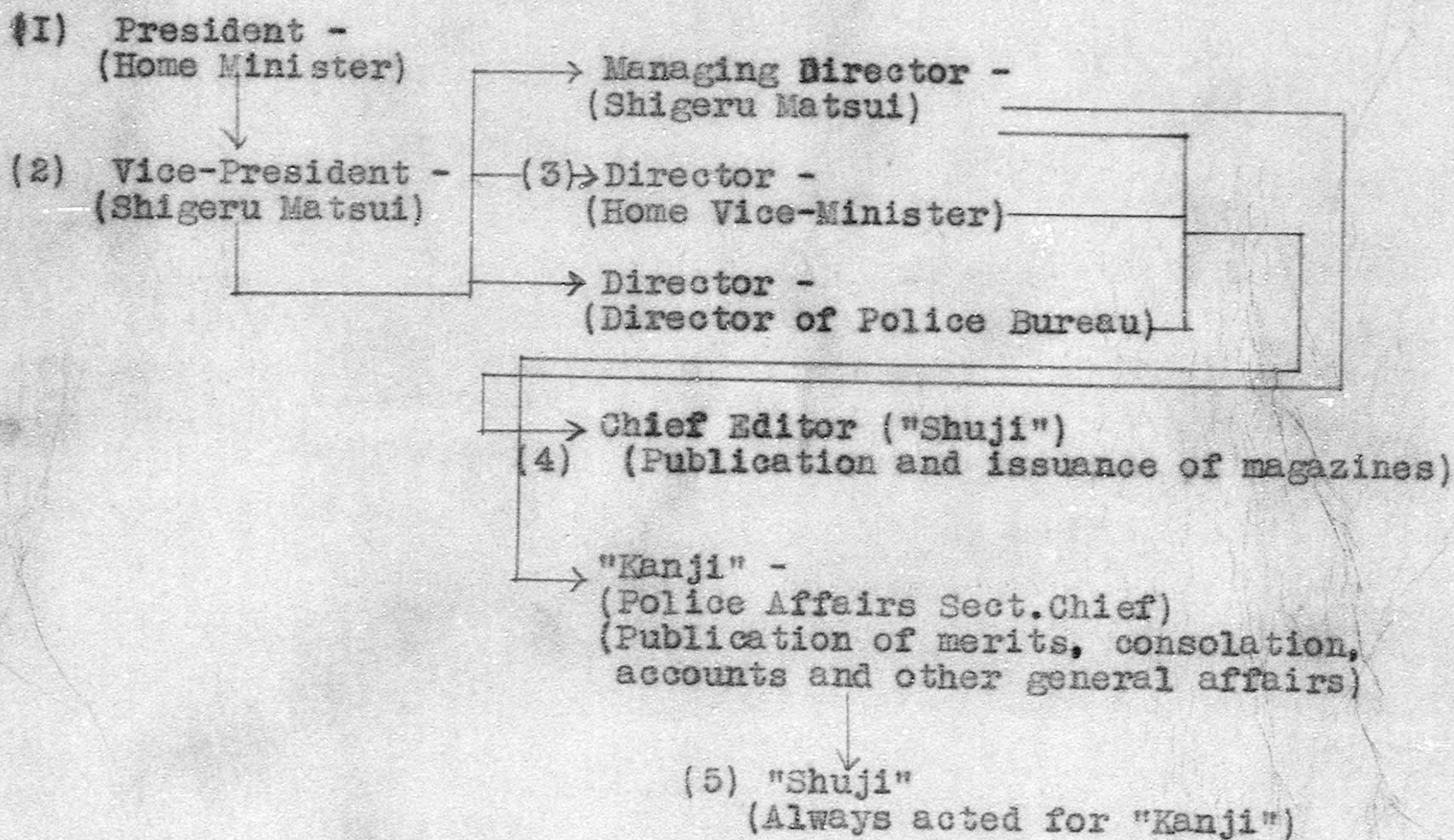

1. The officers of the Association, holding the Government positions including Home Minister, were always nothing but of a nominal existence. Their services were, of course, free.
2. Management or operation of the Association was carried out, as a rule, by "Shuji" who acted for Managing Director and "Kanji" (for publication and issuance of magazines, a full-time "Shuji" was placed).

REGULATIONS FOR ORGANIZATION AND ASSIGNMENT OF
WORK OF THE POLICE ASSOCIATION.

1. As president, a person holding the position of Home Minister shall be nominated. He shall manage the whole affairs of the Association.
2. As vice-president, a person of learning and experience shall be nominated. He shall assist the president, and act for him when the president can not attend to duties on account of unavoidable reasons.
3. As directors, persons holding the positions of Home Vice-Minister, Director of Police Bureau of Home Ministry, and those of learning and experience shall be nominated. They shall manage the affairs of the Association. From the directors, one shall be elected as Managing director who represents the Association and attend to all regular business. (The directors holding the positions of Home Vice-Minister and Director of Police Bureau of Home Ministry were so-called "ought-to-be directors", and were nothing but of nominal existence. As the Managing Director, a person of learning and experience was specially chosen, and he was an actual experienced person of the Association.)
4. As "Kanji", those persons holding the "Kotokan" rank of the Home Ministry and others shall be engaged, and deal with the business of the Association under the instructions of the President. (As "Kanji" holding the "Kotokan" rank of the Home Ministry, Police Affairs Section Chief of Police Bureau was customary engaged. However, it was only of a nominal existence as in the case of the aforesaid directors holding the Government positions. As other "Kanji", it was planned to place salaried and full-time officers, but the same was not materialized for the economy of the expenses. As to publication and issuance of magazines, however, a full-time "Shuji" was specially placed. For such matters as publication of merits, consolation and other affairs, "Kanji" was placed to assume responsibility in formality. In actual, however, a full-time "Shuji" was specially placed for it.)
5. "Shuji" shall attend to general affairs under the instructions of the Managing Director. (As already stated, there were two "Shuji" - one was exclusively for editing, and other for general affairs. The latter is to act under the instructions of "Kanji" in formality. In those days, however, he used to act for "Kanji" and dealt with business on account of the circumstances of the office.)
