i. Reference B sent only to HQS I forwarded the results of CDURGE debriefing of the subject. Pertinent information from the debriefing ..... is given in Paragraphs 2 through 7 of this dispatch. It is pointed out that this information is from the subject himself.

6. Filend of subject: Eusebio ASCUE (or AZCUE) Lopez was employed by the Cuban Phassy in Mexico City in 1961. Despite this employment, CASAS 04 trusted ASCUE's friendship to the extent that CASAS confided in him concerning drubts about CASTAG and about the subject's own possible defection. In connection with the latter, CASAS consulted ASCUE about the chances of requesting political asylum in Mexico.

10. Eusebic ASCUE (or AZCUE) Lopez: (See paragraph 6 above). It is noted that little information was obtained from [CASAS] about ASCUE other than that [CASAS] trusted him as a personal friend. Information from other sources in Beadquarters files indicates that ASCUE was an attache in the Cuban Esbassy in Hexico; that he was involved in subversion and espionage; that he has been in contact with student groups in Micaragua, Quatamala, and the Dominican Republic; and that he has provided information to LIMASK-1. The Station at MEXICO is being asked for field traces and comment on ASCUE.
