

PERIODIC REPORTS OF THE AGRICULTURAL MARKETING SERVICE

This publication lists the periodic reports of the Agricultural Marketing Service, tells where and how you can get the ones you want, and approximately when most of them will be issued during 1960.

The crop and livestock group of reports and the market news group of reports publish new figures, with little or no economic analysis. The outlook and situation reports supply the economic analysis a little later, in terms of supplies of particular products, demand for those products, and the resulting outlook for prices and farm income.

Some of the situation reports also publish important statistics for the first time. Among these are The Farm Income Situation—first estimates of gross farm income, production expenses, net farm income, and cash receipts; The National Food Situation—per capita food consumption; and The Marketing and Transportation Situation—price spreads or marketing charges, and farmers' share of the consumers' food dollar. The Demand and Price Situation and the commodity situation reports are summarized in the Agricultural Outlook Digest. A few tables are published for the first time in the Statistical Summary, a round-up of current agricultural statistics. (See page 34).

If you need county figures you will usually have to get them from the Census of Agriculture taken every five years by the Bureau of the Census, U. S. Department of Commerce. In some States and for some subjects, the State Agricultural Statistician may be able to supply later county estimates.


The U. S. Department of Agriculture annually publishes Agricultural Statistics, containing current and historical data. A limited free distribution is made to agricultural libraries and members of Congress. Copies of Agricultural Statistics are sold by the Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington 25, D. C. The price of Agricultural Statistics, 1958, is \$1.75 a copy.

Three periodicals covering the statistical and economic findings and summarizing new developments in marketing research, marketing services, regulatory, and food distribution programs are issued. Agricultural Situation reviews this material in relation to its effect on farmers, Agricultural Marketing summarizes findings and developments in relation to their effect on farmers and industry, and Agricultural Economics Research publishes technical statistical and economic research and methodology. MARKET NEWS REPORTS

The Agricultural Marketing Service, in cooperation with many of the State Departments of Agriculture, gathers and distributes market news on supply, demand, quality, prices and movement of agricultural products. Through a nationwide network of more than 170 field offices, trading is reported at major terminal markets, as well as in important production and shipping areas. For a quick exchange of information most of the market news offices are connected by more than 13,000 miles of leased teletype lines.

Market reports are issued on all major farm commodities, including cotton, cotton-seed, dairy and poultry products, fruits and vegetables, grain and related products, feed molasses, livestock, meats, wool, tobacco, naval stores, honey, peanuts, and pecans.

Reports are prepared in the field under the direction of the AMS commodity divisions in Washington. Each field office, for the most part, covers only such products as are assigned to the division of which it is a part. It reports largely on the commodities in its own markets, although it may include a brief summary describing trading conditions, prices and trends at a few other markets that are significant to those patronizing the local market.

Nearly 1,500 radio stations and 160 television stations broadcast market news regularly. Market news also reaches the public by press, wire news services, telegraph, telephone, and by direct mail. However, some offices no longer mail reports, because distribution through other news media is more effective.

Following is a listing of the market news reports and the issuing offices. The reports are sent free upon request. If you wish to see sample copies of any of the reports, or be added to the mailing lists to receive copies regularly, you may address your request to the office issuing the report or to the proper commodity division of the Agricultural Marketing Service, U. S. Department of Agriculture, Washington 25, D. C.

SITUATION AND OUTLOOK REPORTS1

The Demand and Price Situation reviews the factors that affect the domestic and foreign demand for farm products including output, employment, income, commodity prices and other related factors. This is followed by a brief review of farm income and discussion of general trends in demand, supply, and prices of major farm products. The publication is issued about the 25th of each month.

The Farm Income Situation presents estimates of cash receipts from farm marketings, by commodity groups, and Government payments; index numbers of cash receipts and of physical volume of farm marketings for several preceding months; and estimates, by States, of cash receipts from sales of crops and livestock. During the year, annual State estimates are included which show Government payments to farmers, value of home consumption for crops and livestock, gross and net income of farm operators; cash receipts and home consumption by detailed commodities; and cash receipts from farm marketings by States, by major individual commodities. Table 1 in each issue gives quarterly estimates of gross and net farm income, seasonally adjusted at annual rates. Issued four times a year.

The Marketing and Transportation Situation contains statistics on the U. S. average retail cost of a market basket of farm foods, the payment received by farmers for these products and the spread between the retail cost and farm value or payment to the farmer. Similar data are given for seven groups of products and 47 individual food products, and also for a group of cotton clothing articles and housefurnishings and the principal tobacco products. Special articles concerning marketing and transportation of farm products are included in each issue. Issued four times a year.

The National Food Situation contains statistics on per capita consumption of major foods, nutrients available for civilian consumption, production of major food commodities, indexes of the annual supply and utilization of farm food commodities, and retail food price and total consumer price index numbers. Reviews of supply, production, marketing, retail prices, and consumption of major foods are included. There are included from time to time special analyses relating to food consumption in the United States or particular aspects thereof. Issued four times a year.

Commodity Situation Reports. The following commodity situation reports analyze the supply, demand, price, and outlook for each of the more important farm products for which adequate information is available. This information is provided as an aid in planning production and marketing. Tables and charts present current figures on acreage, yield, production, market movement, stocks, consumption, and prices, with comparisons with other significant periods. From time to time the results of special studies relating to the respective commodities are included.

The Situation reports listed above carry current outlook materials and an annual statement--published at the time of year when the farmer can make use of such data in preparing his production and marketing plans for the coming year. Every year one complete issue of each Situation report is devoted to outlook information for the coming year.

OTHER PERIODICALS

AGRICULTURAL MARKETING

Agricultural Marketing, monthly, is designed to keep publications, organizations, marketing firms, marketing specialists, and other officials and individuals who are concerned with the marketing of farm products informed about current activities in agricultural marketing. It brings together up-to-date information on marketing programs carried on by Federal, State, municipal, and commercial marketing agencies; reports on preliminary findings under authorized marketing research projects; carries summaries of reports issued on completed projects; and reports on activities in agricultural marketing such as the formulation of standards, inspection and grading, market news, administration of regulatory legislation, and the various food distribution programs.

Free distribution of Agricultural Marketing is limited to trade publications, the press, farm groups, members of State departments of Agriculture, Federal and State extension services, staff members of agricultural colleges, experiment stations, and other institutions, persons engaged in the dissemination of marketing information, and libraries. Subscriptions may be purchased at \$1.50 a year (foreign rate \$2.25). Single copies are 15 cents each. Make checks payable to the Superintendent of Documents and send order and remittance to the Government Printing Office, Washington 25, D. C.

AGRICULTURAL SITUATION

Agricultural Situation, a printed monthly periodical, contains brief reviews of current marketing and economic developments affecting farmers. Free distribution of Agricultural Situation is limited to voluntary unpaid crop, livestock and price reporters, county agents and other local agricultural workers, and to libraries, the press, and Government officials. Subscriptions may be purchased for 50 cents a year (foreign rate \$1.00). Make checks payable to the Superintendent of Documents and send orders to the Government Printing Office, Washington 25, D. C.

AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS RESEARCH

Agricultural Economics Research, a quarterly published jointly by the Agricultural Marketing Service and the Agricultural Research Service, contains technical articles which deal with methods, results, and findings of research in agricultural economics, statistics, and marketing. It is issued in January, April, July, and October.

Free distribution of Agricultural Economics Research is limited chiefly to professional workers. Subscriptions may be purchased for 75 cents a year (foreign rate \$1.00). Single copies are 20 cents each. Make checks payable to the Superintendent of Documents and send order and remittance to the Government Printing Office, Washington 25, D. C.

AGRICULTURAL OUTLOOK DIGEST

The Agricultural Outlook Digest is a two-page digest of current indications as to the outlook for production, farm employment, demand, exports, prices received by farmers, prices paid by farmers, and the outlook for various farm commodities. For the most part, it summarizes The Demand and Price Situation and the commodity situation reports. Issued the same day as The Demand and Price Situation.

STATISTICAL SUMMARY

Statistical Summary, prepared for ready-reference desk use, is a four-page round-up of current agricultural statistics. In addition to summaries of crop and live-stock production, certain tables are issued first in this publication. Among such tables are: cash receipts from marketings, by states; index of volume of farm marketings; farm-retail price spreads and farmer's share of the consumer's dollar; and (from Julythrough December) indexes of farm output, including both livestock and crops, acreage and per acre yields. It is issued each month as soon as possible following the release of the Crop Production report (usually about the 20th.)

CHECKLIST OF AMS REPORTS

The Checklist of Reports Issued by the Agricultural Marketing Service lists AMS publications issued during the previous month. Periodicals are not included, except for annual statistical compilations. As time permits, subject-matter reference lists of AMS publications on various phases of AMS programs are compiled and included as supplements to the Checklist. Numerical listings of AMS reports issued in the several publications series are also included as supplements. Issued about the 10th of each month.

AGRICULTURAL OUTLOOK CHARTS

Agricultural Outlook Charts, prepared in cooperation with the Agricultural Research Service, contains charts and maps with accompanying data and text that are likely to be especially useful to Extension workers and others in presenting the key factors in the economic situation and outlook for agriculture. The chartbook is issued each fall. (No mailing list is maintained. Availability is announced in the Checklist.)

ACREAGE-MARKETING GUIDES

Acreage-Marketing Guides, published seasonally, are designed to assist vegetable growers in balancing the supply of each vegetable with market requirements. They provide the best possible estimates of the acreage of individual vegetables needed in meeting these requirements. Five guides booklets are published each year, in advance of planting time. The following are scheduled for issue during 1960:

CONSUMER PURCHASES OF FRUITS AND JUICES, AND AVAILABILITY REPORTS

Consumer Purchases of Selected Fruits and Juices, issued monthly, presents estimated total consumer purchases of fresh citrus fruits, canned juices, and frozen concentrated juices and ades. These data represent projections to national totals based on reported purchases, and related information from a representative national sample of approximately 6,000 household consumers. Two annual reports are issued. One, entitled Consumer Purchases of Selected Fruits and Juices by Regions and Retail Outlets, gives data for the January - March quarter, and supplements the monthly information. The other, Consumer Purchases of Fruits and Juices by Family Characteristics, is developed from data appearing in the monthly reports and summarizes data during a 6-month period. It furnishes information concerning buying practices of families as related to geographic region and size of city in which they live, family income, family size and age of children, age of housewife, and occupation and education of family head.

Fruits and Juices, Availability in Retail Food Stores, issued for selected months, presents information on availability of fresh citrus fruits, canned and frozen juices, ades, and other selected products in retail food stores.

MILK DISTRIBUTORS' SALES AND COSTS

Milk Distributors' Sales and Costs, issued quarterly, is based on information obtained from distributors of fluid milk and cream products. It reports costs of raw milk, prices and quantities of dairy products sold, and operating costs of milk distributors.

FARM POPULATION, MANPOWER, AND LEVEL-OF-LIVING REPORTS

Farm Population Estimates, usually issued annually, contains current estimates of the distribution of the farm population by geographic regions and divisions and estimates of the components of annual change (birth, deaths, and migration) in the farm population for the United States and for the geographic areas. From time to time, special reports are issued that contain a historical array of estimates of this type for the years from 1910 on, or which contain estimates for States for intercensal dates.

The <u>Census-AMS Series</u>, prepared cooperatively with the Bureau of the Census, provides annual estimates of the distribution of the farm population by age, sex, and labor force status. Certain reports in this series contain information on related subjects such as farm dwellings and households, farm operators, etc. <u>Census-AMS Series</u> and Farm Population Estimates contain the same estimate of the total farm population of the United States for a given date but the distributions shown in each are obtained independently.

The Hired Farm Working Force, a summary report about agricultural workers in the United States, has been published for most years since 1945. The reports are based on data obtained for the Agricultural Marketing Service by the Bureau of the Census in one of its regular monthly Current Population Surveys. Information is reported for all persons 14 years of age and over in the civilian noninstitutional population of the United States who did any farm wage work during the year. The information reported includes time worked and wages earned at farm and nonfarm work by race, sex, age, duration of employment, migratory status, type of residence, and chief activities of the worker. In addition, special information was obtained in 1954 on children of migratory workers; and in 1956 on social security coverage of the hired farm working force.

Farm-Operator Family Level-of-Living Indexes for Counties of the United States is published every five years. The indexes are constructed from data available in the Censuses of Agriculture and are computed for the country as a whole, regions, geographic divisions, States, and State economic areas, as well as for the counties of the United States. Occasionally, as a result of national or regional surveys, special reports are prepared to show interim changes in farm-operator family levels of living and to report methodological experiments in the construction of level-of-living indexes.

FOOD PREVUE

Food Prevue provides a summary of the food outlook especially designed to give maximum advance information to food editors to help them plan food features. Distribution is limited to food editors and advertising agencies needing advance information on food supplies. For addition to the mailing list, write to the Marketing Information Division Area Office nearest you, stating your occupation and need for the information. Issued monthly about the 18th.

PLENTIFUL FOODS MONTHLY LIST

Plentiful Foods Monthly List is an advance listing of foods which are expected to be in plentiful supply during the succeeding month. A "Distributors" edition of the list is prepared especially for wholesalers, jobbers, retailers and others engaged in selling food to consumers for their use. A "Food Service" edition is prepared for such public and institutional feeders as restaurants, cafeterias, in-plant feeders, etc. Decisions on listings of plentiful foods are made in Washington by USDA food analysts, and national lists (Distributors and Food Service) are published showing foods expected to be in plentiful supply throughout the greater part of the United States. Marketing specialists in Area offices of the Food Distribution Division then adapt these national listings to their own area, and the two regionalized lists are published each month from each of the five Area offices. The lists are released about the middle of the month, covering the succeeding month. For addition to the mailing list, write to the Marketing Information Division Area

Office, stating your occupation and need for the information, and your preference as to which list will be most helpful to you - Distributors or Food Service.

Periodically, as supply situations warrant, Special Plentiful Foods Programs are conducted on foods in especially plentiful supply. Fact sheets of supply and background information are customarily prepared to support these campaigns—one for food distributors, one for the food service industry. Apply as above.

REPORTS ON REGULATORY ACTIVITIES

Prosecutions under the Federal Seed Act. Reports or notices on individual court actions under the Federal Seed Act are issued as cases are completed. A publication is issued annually summarizing the facts involved in all court actions taken during the preceding fiscal year. Reports on the import of agricultural and vegetable seeds are also issued. (See page 21).

P and S Docket reports action taken on formal cases arising under the Packers and Stockyards Act. Included are brief descriptions of cases on which action has been taken during the month preceding the date of issue; items of general interest, including a statement as to stockyards posted and deposted during the month; and a tabular statement showing new dockets issued and dockets on which some action has been taken. It is issued monthly.

Perishable Agricultural Commodities Act--Summaries of decisions of the Secretary of Agriculture under the Perishable Agricultural Commodities Act in which publication of facts has been ordered are reported in Agriculture Decisions, issued by the Department. Subscriptions to this monthly publication may be placed with the Superintendent of Documents, Government Printing Office, Washington 25, D. C., at \$3.50 a year (foreign rate \$4.50). Check or money order should be sent directly to the Superintendent of Documents.
