Rice, limb broken; Alice Rice, bruised only; Clvde Rice, back sprained; Lawrence and Bertie Rice not injured. All buildings in distance in direct path of cyclone badly wrecked.

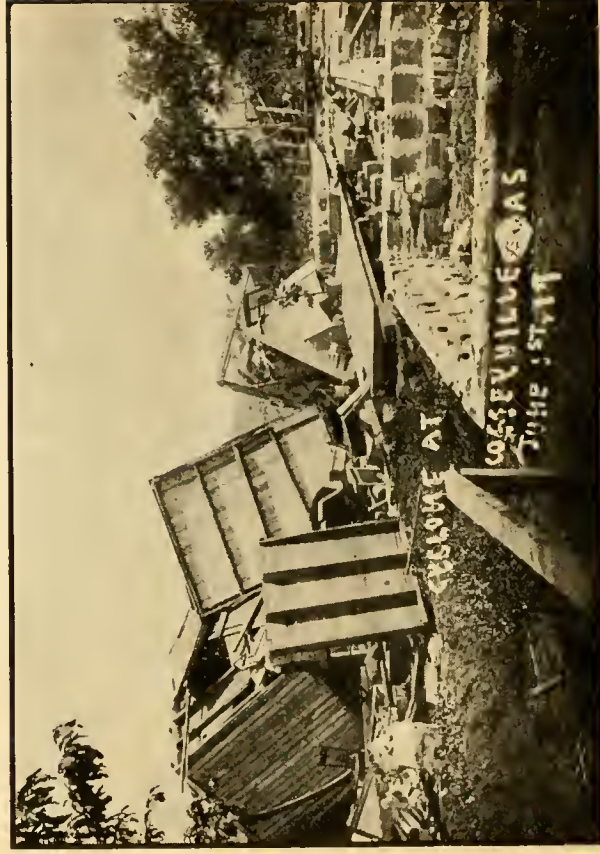
