



Ever since the introduction of the Double Cosmos we have been working to get this valuable florists flower in the Early Type and have at last succeeded in obtaining it in three separate colors.

They grow to a height of about three feet, forming a perfect bush massed with bloom, bearing beautiful double flowers of good size on long stems.

This strain comes about seventy-five per cent double from seed. They bloom in seventy days from planting, so that seed sown the latter part of April will easily be in bloom by the Fourth of July and continue till cut down by frost.

The contrast of color combination in this variety is very startling.

- **ESCHSCHOLTZIA LOVELY**—We consider this Eschecholtzia well named, it being a lovely tone of bright rose pink suffused with salmon, the blooms having a satiny appearance which adds very much to the effect.
