I shall depend upon you

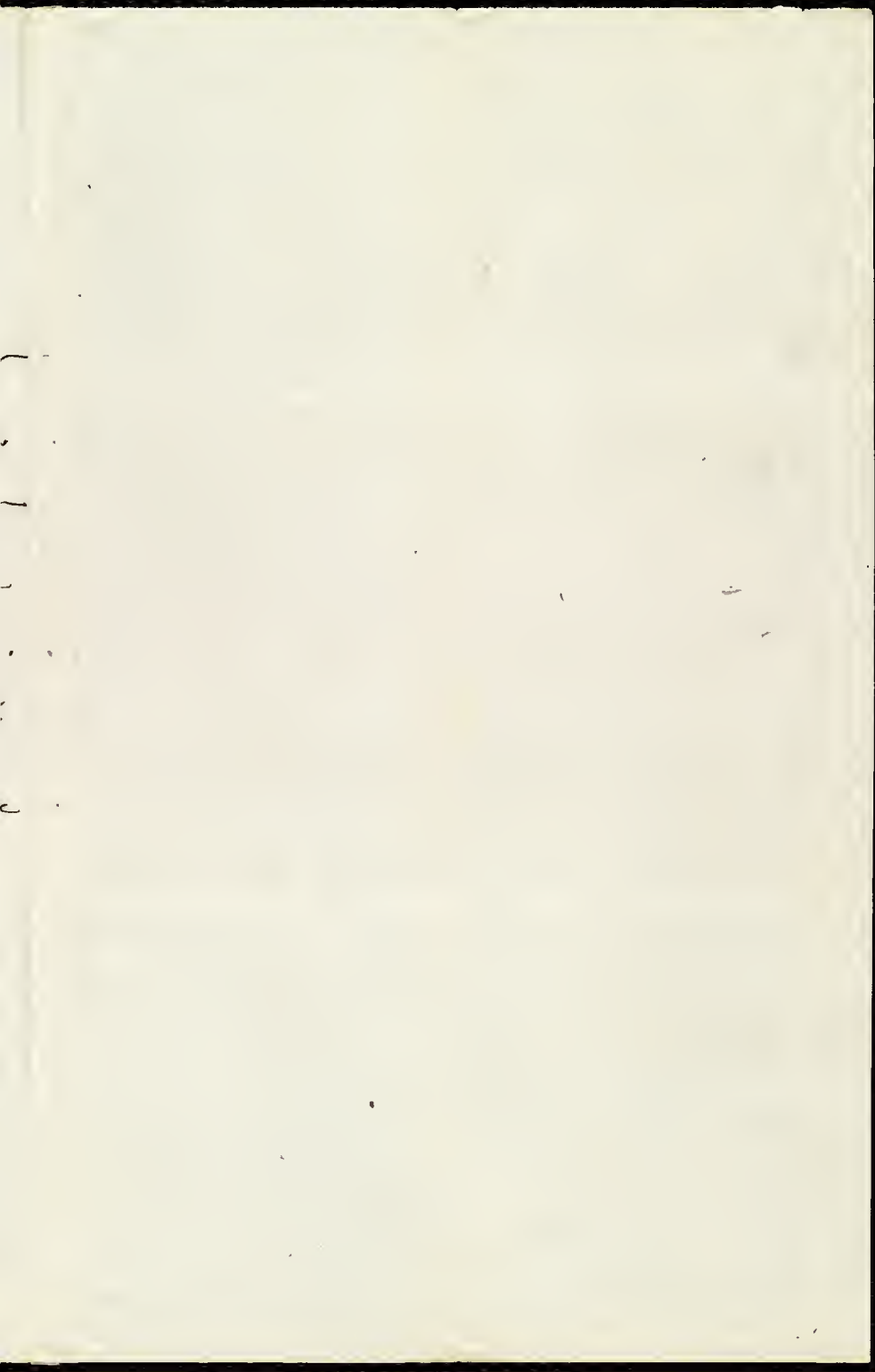
providing the editorial
