# There's over 14 million data items in Wikidata.

How can we make sense of it all?

How can we *let our users* make sense of it all?

# The **Wikidata Query Service** lets users ask Wikidata complex questions, and find out the answers.

Wikidata Query Service uses a query language called **SPARQL** to write these complex questions.

**SPARQL** lets users precisely define their question so that the Wikidata Query Service understands how to answer it.

#### **Example:**

What were some of the fields of work of physicists who worked at institutions where Richard Feynman also worked?



This is what they get.


