Introduction

What is Wiki Loves Earth?

- Wiki Loves Earth (WLE) is an annual international photographic competition held throughout May and July, organized worldwide by Wikimedia chapters, groups, and local Wikipedia volunteers.
 Participants take pictures of local natural heritage and scenic landscapes in their countries and upload them to Wikimedia Commons.
- This year is the 11th edition of the contest and the international winning photos will represent two categories — landscapes (including individual trees, if it's a nature monument) and macro/close-up (animals, plants, fungi).





What is Wikimedia Foundation?

- The Wikimedia Foundation, Inc. (WMF) is an American 501 (c) (3) nonprofit organization headquartered in San Francisco, California, and registered as a charitable foundation under local laws. Best known as the hosting platform for Wikipedia, a crowdsourced online encyclopedia, it also hosts other related projects and MediaWiki, a wiki software.
- The Wikimedia Foundation was established in 2003 in St. Petersburg, Florida, by Jimmy Wales to fund Wikipedia, Wiktionary, and other crowdsourced wiki projects.





Who is Jimmy Wale?

Jimmy Donal Wales (born August 7, 1966), also known on Wikipedia by the nickname Jimbo Wales, is an American–British Internet entrepreneur, webmaster, and former financial trader. He is a co-founder of the online non-profit encyclopedia Wikipedia and the for-profit wiki hosting service Fandom (formerly Wikia). He has worked on other online projects, including Bomis, Nupedia, WikiTribune, and WT Social.



• What is Wikimedia Commons?

- Wikimedia Commons (or simply Wiki Commons) is a media repository of free-touse images, sounds, videos and other media. It is a project of the Wikimedia Foundation.
- Files from Wikimedia Commons can be used across all of the Wikimedia projects in all languages, including Wikipedia, Wikivoyage, Wikisource, Wikiquote, Wiktionary, Wikinews, Wikibooks, and Wikispecies, or downloaded for offsite use.





Commons Milestones


- November 30, 2006: 1 million media files

Wikimedia Commons is a repository of free-use images, sound, and other media files that are used by Wikipedia and other Wikimedia Foundation projects. Here's a step-by-step guide on how to upload files to Wikimedia Commons:
 - Create an Account
 - Prepare Your File
 - Navigate to Upload Page
 - Select the File
 - ► File Information
 - Add Categories
 - Upload
