The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee remains necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board noted the detainee's prior history with weapons training and combat experience over a prolonged period of time in Afghanistan. Further, the Board considered the frequency, specificity, and recent nature of the detainee's expressions of support for extremist behavior, available pathways to reengagement, limited record of compliance, and lack of candor.

The Board looks forward to reviewing the detainee's file in six months and encourages the detainee to continue his recent display of compliant behavior, to take advantage of educational and counseling opportunities, to work with his private counsel and personal representatives to further develop post-detention plans, and to be increasingly open in communications with the Board.
