1. Shift of surveillance responsibilities and increase in operational personnel require the installation of additional telephone equipment in the Ishihara Building, Osaka City to facilitate communication with outlying prefectures of Kinki Region.

2. Additional Telephone Equipment needed is as follows:

a. Executive Section;

Telephones in Executive Office to be connected to that of Chief's Office. Three switches needed.

b. Legal and Government Section;

Switches needed to transfer calls on two telephones.

c. Civil Information Section;

Two additional telephones required.

d. Public Welfare Section;

Nine telephones needed with four outlets to switchboard.

e. Public Health Section;

Three additional phones and one outlet needed.

f. Civil Education Section;

Two additional telephones and two switches.

g. Economics Section;

Four additional telephones needed.

j. One additional line to Osaka Toll required.
