SUBJECT: Release of Real Estate

TO: Commanding General, I Corps, APO 301

1. Attached herewith application in triplicate for release of responsibility for real estate procured from the Japanese Government for use of Occupation Forces, in compliance with provisions of par 3, Operational Directive 28/12, Headquarters Eighth Army, dtd. 8 July 1946.

2. Subject real estate consists of the grounds, and buildings thereon, designated as the Kyoto Reserve Division Artillery Post, located at Fukakusa, Fushimi-Ku, Kyoto Shi, Kyoto-Fu. This area was originally procured on Demand No. 6A-30, by the 16th Signal Operations Battalion, under SIXTH ARMY, and was initially occupied by that unit on 25 September 1945. Change of occupancy took place on 26 January 1946, with the inactivation of the 16th Signal Operations Battalion, and the move of the 58th Signal Battalion from Osaka to Kyoto.

3. Area was vacated by 58th Signal Battalion during month of November 1946, on completion of move of Radio Transmitter Station to new site near Observatory Hill.

2. The release of subject installation from the procurement demand issued on it should have been accomplished under the provision of paragraph 9g, Operational Directive No. 33, Headquarters Eighth Army, dated 26 March 1946, as revised by Operational Directive No. 33/1, dated 11 October 1946. If this has not been done, it is desired that it be accomplished before the application for release is submitted by the Japanese.

MEMORANDUM:

TO : Commanding General
SUBJECT : Petition re FUGI Range

1. By letter dated 24 June 1946 this headquarters directed the Commanding Officer, 30th Military Government Company to inform the Shizuoka Branch, Central Liaison Committee that the Commanding General, 25th Infantry Division had agreed to the release of the Nishi-Fugi Maneuver Ground and the Junior Tank Corps School on the condition that the Fugi Artillery Range be cleared of all Japanese. Later correspondence stipulated that individuals who had crops planted west of a line demarking the densely populated area and the open range be notified that they would clear the area after present crops were harvested. The directives in this matter were made clear to the proper Japanese officials by the Commanding Officer, Shizuoka Military Government Team.

2. These directives will deny the use of the Fugi Artillery Range to the Japanese for any purpose, hence the petition. Another petition of similar pattern sent to this headquarters attention Military Government is in my possession. An indorsement to this one had been prepared to the Commanding General, 25th Infantry Division for comment and recommendation.

3. Briefly the petition sets forth the request that while the area is not being used by U. S. Military Forces, Japanese concerned be allowed:

To remain in the houses (247) now earmarked to be evacuated.

To cultivate the land now under cultivation.

To mow the grass lands.

To use the roads.

4. The Military Government people in Shizuoka recognize the vital economic value of this land to the local inhabitants and to the residents of the prefecture as a whole and are in sympathy with the aims of the petitioners.

5. In view of our present uncertain personnel picture and the improbable use of this land for some time to come it would appear that to exclude the Japanese from their present activities on the Fugi Range is not justified. However it is felt that this area should not be released from our control since it offers splendid opportunities for training.

6. The 25th Infantry Division has not been contacted in regard to the petition. It is recommended that the petition be forwarded to the Commanding General, 25th Infantry Division with the following indorsement:

"In view of our present limitations with respect to training, this headquarters is favorably inclined toward the request set forth in the attached petition. It is not intended that this area be released and turned back to the Home Ministry but rather to allow its use by present occupants when not occupied by our forces on terms consistent with our present and future training requirements.

Your comments and recommendations are desired."

SUBJECT: Fuji Artillery Range

Several times recently Japanese authorities have raised the question as to our future intentions with respect to the subject range. At present quite a number of Japanese live within the area of the range, and a great many are cultivating small tracts of land there.

In view of the present status of units of the Corps, it is not believed that it will be possible to make efficient use of this range until some date several months in the future.

It is requested, when you have determined the date on which the range should be made available to your artillery, you notify this headquarters, giving it the greatest amount possible of advance notice.

The Shizuoka Military Government Team is being notified of this general policy: that the present users of the land for agricultural or residence purposes will continue, subject to possibility of their having to vacate the area on relatively short notice.

All arrangements concerning the use of Fuji Artillery Range should be made through Hq I Corps.

The above building was procured by Procurement Demand Serial No. IC-44, dated 4 Oct. 1945, but the building was temporarily vacated in Feb., since then it has been unoccupied up to now. We request your kind consideration in releasing this building in its entirety.

The owner of the building is running a firm, manufacturing and distributing indispensable commodities for the public, also various materials for house-building. Parts of the spinning machine are being manufactured by them which are to be used for spinning the raw cotton imported from United States.

Moreover, this company have received an order from the Eighth Army to manufacture enormous quantity of dependent housing furnitures. Unless the above mentioned building is released in its entirety, the said company is afraid that manufacture of these furnitures will greatly be delayed behind the delivery schedule. They requests that your permission of temporary use would kindly be given even if this factory is not permanently released.

SUBJECT: Release of Nishihama Technical School

TO : CG, I Corps

1. On 15 April 46, the Nishihama Technical School was officially evacuated by the 544th EB & SR. The school, however, was not turned back to the Japanese inasmuch as the 4th Inf Regt, in a letter dated 14 April, indicated that the school was going to be used by that regiment for training purposes.

2. In Procurement Demand WKYE 25, dated 30 April 46, the Nishihama School was placed under procurement for the 4th Inf Regt.

3. Since the school was evacuated by the 544th EB & SR, there have been no troops quartered in the area with the exception of a platoon quartered temporarily there recently. The parade ground at the rear of the school has been used on occasion for the training of 3rd Bn troops and the school's auditorium has been used for the presentations of U.S.O. shows. Other than this, the school has not been used.

4. The school is one of two schools of this type in this area and at present, they are both under procurement by the Occupation Forces. The school could perform an important function in the re-education program of SCAP, and it is not, and has not been utilized to any extent by the Occupation Forces.

5. Major John H. Chambers, CO, 3rd Bn, Saturday, 20 July stated that Colonel Mergens, CO, 4th Inf Regt, has agreed to release the school. There are no other tactical units in this area that would have occasion to use the school.

6. Permission to release the Nishihama School is requested.

Enclosed herewith is an application from the Osaka Tobacco Manufacturing Monopoly Bureau, requesting permission to use a portion of the buildings of the Takatsuki factory of the Kawasaki Airplane Manufacturing Co. The Takatsuki plant is listed as Plant No. 6 on Inclosure 1 to Operational Directive No. 5/2, Headquarters Eighth Army, dated 6 June 1946.
2. The former buildings of this company were badly damaged as a result of the war and the Monopoly Bureau has been unable to secure an adequate location for their factory up to the present time. While admittedly the processing of tobacco cannot be considered a vital necessity, it is believed the operation of the factory would be of benefit to the area concerned.
3. The 109th Military Government Company has inspected the buildings which the Monopoly Bureau desires to use, and states no problem of equipment is involved. The machinery can be properly stored and cared for in other buildings on the ground, provided favorable consideration is given this request.
4. It is the recommendation of this headquarters that the Monopoly Bureau be allowed to use the buildings of the Takatsuki factory for which it is making application.

The Oguraike Laboratory of this Department (description: as per the enclosed copy) was occupied on the 17th October, 1945 by the 126th Signal Service Co. of the Occupation Troops. Since the said Signal Service Co. having moved therefrom, it has been guarded by the caretakers despatched by the Kyoto Labor Exchange.

The buildings of the Laboratory have been kept in good condition so far, except a small building attached to the Antenna Pole which is situating at about 950 metres apart from the Laboratory and is collapsing as being beyond the charge of the guards.

According to the request of the owner of the land on which the said collapsing building is installed, this Department is going to demolish it, and is hereby submitting the application for the permission of taking necessary actions to that effect.



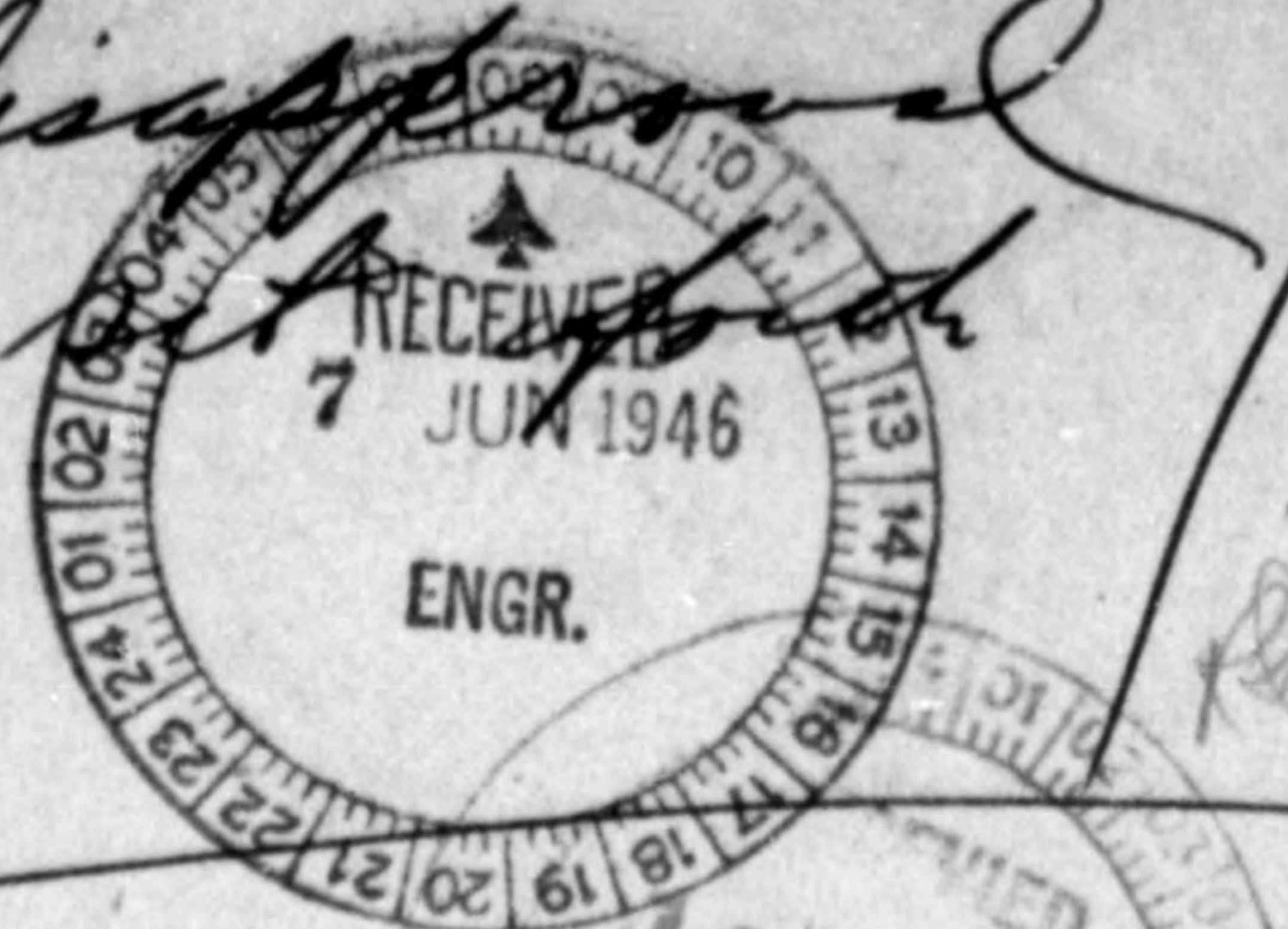

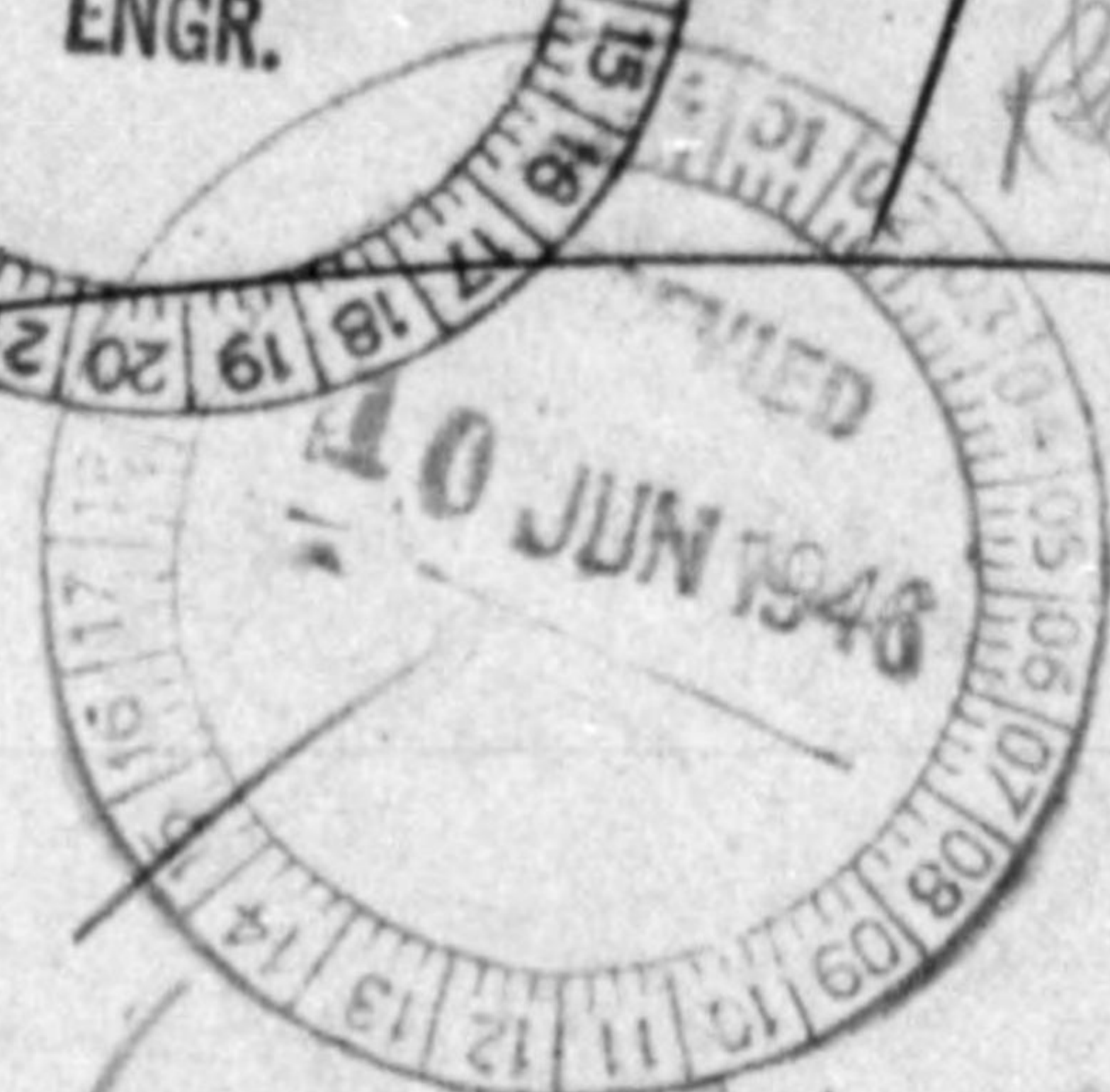

Our application for the release for usage of the land and buildings aforesaid, was submitted to your Excellency, to which a denial reply was received, causing a great surprise and trouble to the chief director of the said co-operation as well as the members concerned.

In case the land buildings aforesaid should be rejected, it would not only cause great hindrance in the training of leaders and executives in the land reclamation project, and the cultivation of 6,000 chobu of land, to relieve the most urgent problem of foodstuffs production in Japan, but also would be a fatal blow that turns adrift all the 650 families and the local farmers who have already at present been engaged in the cultivation work in this area, with our sincere petition, we hereby humbly beg for your Excellency's special favour to review upon this problem and give release to it.

The reason given in the refusal states none other than that the location should be retained for future use of the Occupation Troops. However, in view of deadlock food situations prevailing over this country, we greatly regret to leave the grounds as it is, and we cordially hope the Occupation troops would grant us permission to use the area not to be or until it be actually used for a certain period of time, or at least, to use the land already at present cultivated by the pioneers as means of their living under your Excellency's mercy.

1. We wish to present to you the petition placed in our hands for our good offices by Kyoto Fu Nogyo Kai (Agricultural Assoc. of Kyoto Prefecture) for your permission to be granted for the use of the former army barracks at Okubo.

2. The said Agricultural Assoc. of Kyoto Prefecture has recently secured your permission to use the former Army airfield at Okubo, which the association is planning to use for the purpose of establishing thereupon a special farm for the training of leaders in agriculture in practical operation of electrified husbandry in order to improve the percentage unit of production.

3. In order to attain the object as mentioned in par. 2 satisfactorily it is necessary that these leading members to be trained should be boarded, and for that purpose the Agricultural Assoc. is desirous, if there is no objection on your part, of obtaining your permission to use the former army barracks at the N.E. corner of the above mentioned airfield.

4. In view of the urgent necessity of improving our agriculture by encouraging throughgoing operation of scientific methods in order to relieve the stringent poor supply condition in our country the association has held frequently heretofore special training courses in scientific agriculture for the leading farmers.
