Know all Men by these Presents, That John Gregory

the undersigned, has, this ninth day of May 1891, located and claimed, and by these presents do locate and claim, by right of discovery and location, in compliance with the Mining Acts of Congress, approved May 10, 1872, and all subsequent acts, and with local customs, laws and regulations, 1500 linear feet and horizontal measurement on the Golden Eagle Lode, vein, ledge or deposit, along the vein thereof, with all its dips, angles and variations, as allowed by law, together with 150 feet on the Easterly side and 150 feet on the Westerly side of the middle of said vein at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments; and all veins, lodes, ledges or deposits and surface ground, within the lines of said claim, 450 feet running Southerly from center of discovery shaft, and 1050 feet running Northerly from center of discovery shaft; said discovery shaft being situate upon said lode, vein, ledge or deposit, and within the lines of said claim, in Consolidated Madgeuey Mining District, County of Park and State of Colorado, described by metes and bounds as follows, to wit:

Beginning at corner No. 1, thence S. 50° 20' W 300 ft to Cor. No. 2; thence S. 33° 40' E 750 ft to Centre side stake and on same course 1500 ft to Cor. No. 3; thence N. 50° 20' E 300 ft to Cor. No. 4; thence N. 30° 40' W. 750 ft to Centre side stake and on same course 1500 ft to Cor. No. 1 the place of beginning, containing 10.33 Acres more or less.

Cor. No. 4 of said Golden Eagle Lode is identical with Cor. No. 1 of the B.B.G. Lode U.S. Sur. 40,4316 and Cor. No. 3 of said Golden Eagle is identical with Cor. No. 2 of said B.B.G. Lode.
